

BSF hands over seven trafficked girls to BDR

6 held by BDR while crossing border illegally

Seven trafficked girls were handed over to BDR members by Indian Border Security Force (BSF) through Benapole check post on Tuesday evening and yesterday morning on expiry of their jail terms.

BDR sources said two girls - Sumi Jol Das, 16, of Rangamati and Nisha Jesmin, 17, -- of Mymensingh district were taken to India by a gang of human traffickers alluring them of giving good jobs in 2006.

Later, Kolkata police arrested them and sent them to jail.

A court sentenced them to four years imprisonment each for entering India illegally.

They were handed over to the border guards yesterday morning.

Another report said BSF handed over another five trafficked girls through Benapole check post on Tuesday evening.

The victims were identified as Shilpi Begum alias Vonita, 22, Munni Khanam alias Kajol, 20, Nasrin Sultana alias Sonia,

22, of Narail district, Khadiza Khatun alias Sabina, 23, of Khulna and Sirajum Munira alias Shila, 24, of Satkhira district.

BDR sources said the five girls were trafficked to Bombay by human traffickers and later arrested by Chennai Detective Branch of police in 2008.

All the seven girls were handed over to the BDR by BSF on completion of official formalities.

Later, BDR members handed them over to Benapole port police station.

In Satkhira, six people were held at Laxmidari border in Sadar upazila on charge of illegally going to India on Tuesday.

The arrestees were identified as Babul Gazi, Al-Amin Gazi, Al Amin's wife Rabeya Khatun and child Abdur Rahman, and Musa Sarder and Mujibor Sarder. They all hailed from different villages in Dakope upazila of Khulna.

A patrol team of BDR held them while they were illegally going to India at about 11 at night.

HUMAN CHAIN, RALLY IN C'NAWABGANJ Punish stalkers for killing Hannan, demand protesters

A human chain was formed in Chapainawabganj town yesterday demanding arrest and exemplary punishment of the stalkers who killed Abdul Hannan, a guard of the district office of the Roads and Highways Department, on September 7.

Leaders and activists of different social organisations,

guardians, teachers and students of girls' schools join the programme organised by Jago Nari Bonhi Shikha, a women's organisation, in front of Shaheed Satu Hall.

The protesters also held a rally at the venue and later submitted a memorandum to the deputy commissioner demanding immediate arrest of the killers of Abdul Hannan.

Gori Chand Situ, convener of Jago Nari Bonhi Shikha, Monimud Dowla Chowdhury, vice president of Red Crescent society, Dr Jobeda, joint convener of Sachetan Nagorik Committee, Chapainawabganj Government Girls' High School teacher Sharif Azam, and Roads and Highways Sramik Union leader Motiur Rahman spoke at the rally.

Abdul Hannan, 45, was beaten up to death by a gang of stalkers for protesting their immoral acts at Rehaichar under Chapainawabganj municipality on September 7.

Israil Hossain, 24, Saiful Islam, 28, and Anwarul Islam, 45, of Rehaichar area of the town used to stalk Fatema Akhter Bristy, a class ten student of Kamal Uddin Girls' High School, on way to school.

When Bristy and her mother Mahmuda Khatun were returning home after taking bath in the Mohananda River at around 2:30pm on September 7, Israil, Saiful and Anwarul started teasing them. At this, Mohammad Ali, father of Bristy and also a peon of the Roads and Highway Department, came to protest it and was assaulted by the stalkers.

As Hannan came forward to help Mohammad Ali, the gang took him to a salon and beat him dead.

Though a murder case was filed with Sadar Police Station immediately after the incident, police could not arrest any of the accused as of yesterday.

Bodies of 4 young men, teenage girl recovered

Bodies of four youths and a teenage girl, allegedly murdered in separate incidents in five districts, were recovered on Tuesday.

In Kurigram, body of a youth was recovered from a paddy field near Pairadanga Bazar in Nageshwari upazila, reports our correspondent.

Victim Faruq Hossain, 32, was son of Abul Hossain of village Shinger Bhitia of Hasnabad union under the upazila.

According to police and locals Faruk worked as a mason at a welding-shop at the Pairadanga Bazar. At about 8:00am on Tuesday, a local found his body in a paddy field.

Police suspect Faruk was strangled and dumped into the paddy field.

OC of Nageshwari police station Md. Manjur Rahman said the victim's father filled a

case in this connection.

Faridpur Kotwali police recovered the body of a young man, aged about 30, from the town protection embankment at Gopalkhar village of Char Madhabdia union under Sadar upazila on Tuesday, reports our correspondent.

Local saw the body in the morning and informed police. Criminals slit the throat of the young man with sharp weapon, SI of Kotwali PS Abul Bashar Miah said.

Another body of an unidentified young man, aged about 30, was recovered from Medibill water body under Kalmakanda upazila in Netrakona Tuesday morning, reports our correspondent.

Kalmakanda police said, local people saw the floating body, packed in a bag, in the pond and informed the police at noon.

Police suspected that criminals killed her elsewhere after rape and later dumped the body into the local Hijaltola Lake on Monday night.

The victim was identified as Nayan, 25, son of Shamsul Alam, a resident of Shuvadda.

Police said criminals abducted Nayan on the night of September 13 from his house and since then he remained missing.

Locals found his floating body, packed in a bag, in the pond and informed the police at noon.

In Khulna, local people found the floating body of a young girl in a lake in Dighalia upazila on Tuesday morning.

On information, police recovered the body of the unidentified girl, aged about 18. They sent the body that bore some injury marks to Khulna Medical College Hospital morgue for autopsy.

Police suspected that criminals killed her elsewhere after rape and later dumped the body into the local Hijaltola Lake on Monday night.

Prime accused sent to jail

District & Sessions Judge of Sylhet Md. Momin Ullah yesterday sent Moyezuddin Jewel, the charge sheeted accused in the case for killing police inspector Syed Monayemul Islam, also the then officer-in-charge of Beanibazar PS of Sylhet to the jail. Jubo League activist, Moyezuddin Jewel, also a US expatriate had absconded after the killing of the police officer. On 16 June of 2009, agitated locals raided the house of Moyezuddin at village Kalaiaura over a dispute between locals groups. On information the OC, alongwith a contingent, reached the spot and he was injured in a gunshots fired from Moyez's house. He later succumbed to injuries at hospital. Detective police of Sylhet on 3 March this year submitted charge sheet against Moyezuddin and 21 others for the killing. The district judge court yesterday cancelled his bail and ordered for sending him to the jail hajat.

Toxic liquor kills 4

Four men have died after taking homemade liquor at Manirampur Bagdipara in Shahjadpur upazila. Locals and police said Adivasi Samobay Samity president Tapan Das, secretary Chandu Das and their associates Joytish Das, Mono Das and Wajed Ali, all in 40s, fell ill after taking toxic liquor on upazila parishad premises on Monday night. Their families took them to different hospitals. But Tapan Das and Chandu Das died on way to Sirajganj General Hospital at about 9pm Tuesday and Wajed Ali died at about 11pm after admission to the hospital. Joytish Das died in Pabna General Hospital where Mono Das was still in a serious condition.

Rab recovers firearms

Rapid Action Battalion (Rab) recovered five firearms and 21 bullets and cartridges from Agrabad area early yesterday. On a tip-off that an armed gang was taking preparation for committing crime at a place near Agrabad Samity Commerce College, a team from Rab-7 rushed there at around 4.00am and raided the area. Sensing presence of law enforcers the criminals fled the area leaving the arms and ammunition, said Senior Assistant Director of Rab-7 Captain Tamzid Abdur Rahman. Rab members recovered four locally made single-barrel gun, one light gun (LG), 13 bullets of Chinese rifle and eight cartridges from the spot. None could be arrested in this connection while a case was filed with Double Mooring Police Station, said Captain Tamzid.
