



The exhibition has been dedicated to the artist's parents' 100th wedding anniversary. It should be mentioned that Baseer is the son of

renowned educationist, philologist and linguist Dr. Muhammad Shahidullah.

Baseer is one of the senior-most painters of Bangladesh. The exhibition at Kaya will highlight the series "The Wings" which includes 37 works. Baseer started the series in July 1998. It's considered one of his most memorable series of paintings.

Works from the series feature parts of butterfly wings of different shapes and patterns, from many aspects. The most significant trait of the series is that all of the works have a profound connection but each denotes an individual splendour.

Adviser to the Prime Minister, HT Imam, will inaugurate the exhibition. Noted poet and architect Rabiul Hussain will also be present to facilitate the inaugural session.

J-Lo, Steven Tyler new "American Idol" judges

Jennifer Lopez and Steven Tyler will join Randy Jackson as "American Idol" judges next season, after months of turnover and speculation about the future of the popuar show.

With pomp rivalling that of a U.S. Supreme Court appointment, Fox finally assembled the new pieces of the "Idol" panel that will be returned to its original three-member format for season 10.

Actress-singer-dancer Lopez and Aerosmith frontman Tyler will have the job of trying to match the offbeat chemistry of former judges Simon Cowell and Paula Abdul.

"This is 'American Idol'!" host Ryan

Seacrest said after the new judges joined him on stage at the Forum arena, where the final national audition for next season's singing contest was held Wednesday.

The announcement was made before a crowd of several thousand who had gathered to try out, some cheering loudly for the cameras and all hoping to make it to the next round, when they'll be judged by the revamped panel. The mini-show was streamed live online by Fox.

Tyler said he wanted to join the show because "it's being a part of something much bigger than yourself. ... I want to bring some rock to this roller coaster and show if you've got the heart, the talent, the

American Idol." "I'm so excited," said Lopez, who scored a reported \$12 million to join the show.

over a contract dispute. Jackson will be the only original judge when "American Idol" returns in January.

Though gone, Cowell wasn't forgotten at the news conference that followed the judges' unveiling.

"Simon is irreplaceable, no question about that," said executive producer Nigel Lythgoe. But he and fellow producer Ken Warwick said that the new judges will bring their own personalities to the mix.

Lopez made it clear she has no plans to become the new Simon.

"I believe in tough love, but I'm an artiste myself," she said. "I could never be cruel to another artiste."

Of course, Lopez and Tyler loom as the biggest changes, and the pressure is on them to help "American Idol" reinvent itself for the new season, when it will try to stem a ratings slide and bring in younger viewers. The show's audience has been gradually aging, and advertisers prefer to pitch to young adults.



The event will be held today at the Shilpakala Academy, according to a press release.


