Suu Kyi can vote in Myanmar poll

Say officials

Myanmar officials said yesterday that detained opposition leader Aung San Suu Kyi would be entitled to vote in the upcoming election, despite earlier statements that she would be barred from taking part.

Raising confusion over the Nobel Peace laureate's rights and the interpretation of the electoral laws, an official told AFP: "Aung San Suu Kyi and her two live-in maids will get the right to vote.

"But they will not get permission to go outside on election day." The official, who asked not to be named, suggested: "The authorities might ask them to vote in advance."

Later yesterday an AFP correspondent saw Suu Kyi's name on the electoral roll at the Election Commission office in Bahan Township in Yangon, where the 64-year-old lives under house arrest in her lakeside mansion.

On Monday officials had said Suu Kyi did not appear on the voting list because serving prisoners have no right to vote under Myanmar's 2008 constitution. But another official yesterday confirmed her right to vote in the

first election in two decades, due on November 7, saying the rele-

vant authorities "are likely to inform her soon". He said she had the right to vote on the basis that she is under house arrest rather than in prison.

Suu Kyi was, however, earlier this year barred from standing as a candidate in the elections on the grounds that she is a serving

Aung Naing Oo, a Thailand-based Myanmar analyst, said the country's electoral laws were "quite elastic... so they may be differently interpreted according to the need, the politics on the day".

He expressed doubt that Suu Kyi would exercise her right to participate. "On the part of the military it's best for them to let her vote," he

said. "It's not that important an issue because she has already boycotted (the election).' Suu Kyi's National League for Democracy (NLD) party decided to boycott the upcoming polls, saying the rules were unfair, and

has subsequently been disbanded by the ruling generals. The party won the last election in 1990 by a landslide but was never allowed to take office, and Suu Kyi has spent most of the past

20 years in detention. Her incarceration was lengthened by 18 months in August last year for breaching the terms of her detention after an American man swam to her home.

The opposition leader's current house arrest term is due to expire just days after the November election, which has been widely condemned by activists and the West as a charade aimed at legitimising military rule with a civilian face.

Pakistan wants jailed scientist repatriated

Pakistan said yesterday it would petition the United States to repatriate a Pakistani mother of three sentenced to 86 years in jail for attempted murder whose fate sparked furious protests.

A New York court found Aafia Siddiqui, the once brilliant scientist dubbed "Lady Qaeda" by the US tabloids, guilty of the attempted murder of US military officers in Afghanistan in a case that sparked outrage in Pakistan.

"We will use every means to bring her back. Doctor Aafia is the daughter of the nation. We fought for her and we will fight politically to bring her back," Prime Minister Yousuf Raza Gilani told parliaThe tough jail term sparked immediate outrage among Islamic activists in Pakistani cities, who took to the streets chanting anti-US slogans and burnt an effigy of President Barack Obama, AFP reporters said.

Interior Minister Rehman Malik said the government would petition the US administration to review the sentence on a "humanitarian basis" and request that Siddiqui be handed over to Pakistan and dealt with under Pakistani law.

Asked under what circumstances Siddiqui could return home, the foreign ministry said Obama could pardon her, or an agreement could be reached for her to serve at least part of her sentence in Pakistan.

Siddiqui, 38, who as a student excelled at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology, was found guilty of grabbing a rifle at an Afghan police station where she was being

interrogated in July 2008 and of trying to shoot US servicemen.

Prosecutors said she picked up the weapon and opened fire on US servicemen and FBI representatives trying to take her into detention. She missed and in a struggle was herself shot by one of the US soldiers.

Defence lawyers argued there was no physical evidence, such as finger prints or gunpowder traces, to show Siddiqui even grabbed the rifle.

The Human Rights Commission of Pakistan expressed "dismay" over the "unusually harsh sentence" and called on Islamabad and Washington to negotiate urgently for her repatriation on humanitarian grounds.

US wants to expand military ties with India

Ahead of Indian Defence Minister AK Antony's visit here next week, the US has said it wants to expand its military ties with India in 'mutually beneficial' ways with more exchanges and exercises.

'I had a very good visit to India last year, and met with the defence minister and met the prime minister (Manmohan Singh),' Defence Secretary Robert Gates told reporters Wednesday when asked about what would be on the table during Antony's Sep 27-28 visit.

'We are looking to expand this relationship in ways that are mutually beneficial,' he said. 'But I think we'll also be looking at ways in which we can expand our exchanges, exercises, and strengthen-further strengthen the relationship that we

Gates also indicated that he would talk with Antony about the \$9.11 billion deal for the purchase of 126 multi-role combat aircraft for the Indian Air Force through an open competition. Two American fighter planes, F-16IN and F/A-18IN, a

version of the Super Hornet, are among six aircraft on offer in what has been touted as India's single largest defence deal ever. The Saab Gripen, Eurofighter Typhoon, Dassault Rafale and Mikoyan MiG-35 are the others in the running. 'I'm sure that we'll - they have a big competition going on

for a new modern fighter. We'll probably have some conversations about that,' he said referring to the deal. Asked about India's concerns about US restrictions on

export of dual use high-technology items to India, Gates said it was high on on his list and he would like to see those restrictions eased. 'I think that, that is certainly high on our list, particularly

in the context of export-import, or export controls, and my view of the importance of changing those export controls in ways that better protect the things that are really important and open up trade and allow US companies to sell abroad those things that technologies that are not critical,' he said.

'So, I think India certainly is high on our list in terms of a country that we would like, I would like to see those restrictions eased,' Gates said.

Chairman of the US Joint Chiefs of Staff, Admiral Mike Mullen, who jointly addressed the press conference with Gates, said 'just the military-to-military relationship with India is exceptionally strong and growing'.

'We are very committed to that, and with all of our services. I was recently there and it has taken on a significance that is equal to so many other historic relationships for us, and we know that,' he said.

'The Indian Ocean, we also know, is an incredibly important body of water; not just now, but also in the future. So we recognise the importance of keeping that relationship as strong as it is, and also making it grow,' Mullen added.
