

# Brutal attack on college principal by AL men

Victim of brutality by local Awami League (AL) activists on September 20, Principal of Tabalchhari Green Hill College Prof Md Abu Taher is groaning in pain in Khagrachhari Sadar Adhunik Hospital.

As the principal was returning home from the college, AL men allegedly led by Taindong union AL member Ershad Ali attacked him at Taindong Bazar in Matiranga upazila of Khagrachhari district, said locals and police.

The attackers severely beat him up, breaking his left leg, and looted cash Tk 50 thousand and a mobile set from him.

Locals took him to nearby Panchhari Upazila Health Complex from where he was transferred to Khagrachhari Sadar Adhunik Hospital as his condition worsened.

On September 24, a case was filed with Matiranga

police station accusing Ershad Ali, his associates ruling party men Nowab Ali, Abul Kalam Azad, Malon Mia, Monir Ahmed, Jasim Uddin, Hanif Moishan, Akhtar Hossen, Gias Uddin, Pear Ali and Abu Taher

councillor of Khagrachhari Hill District Council," Prof Abu Taher told this correspondent.

Asked about the matter, Taindong union Awami League member Ershad Ali admitted that some AL men attacked and injured the principal.

"I witnessed the incident but I was not involved in the act. I did not go there to attack the principal," he said.

Matiranga upazila Awami League Secretary Mohammad Tazul Islam, who was also near the scene, said the incident happened due to personal reasons.

Matiranga upazila Awami League President Mohammad Shamsul Islam said he asked police to arrest the criminals responsible for the attack.

Officer in charge of Matiranga police station said a case was filed in this connection but no one was arrested so far due to political pressure.

He, however, expressed his determination to arrest the culprits.

## Storm injures 15, destroys 50 houses

At least 15 people were injured and 50 houses destroyed as a storm lashed Kuthurikona village under Madan upazila of the district yesterday afternoon.

Of the injured, five were admitted to the upazila health complex in a critical condition.

The five injured were identified as Abdul Hamid, 42, P h o o l B a n u, 35, Fazilatunnesa, 57, Kais Mia, 27 and Rahmat Ali, 45. All hail from Kuthurikona village.

Villagers said at around 3:00pm, a 15-minute storm hit the village, injuring 15 people and destroying at least 50 houses.

Electricity supply remained suspended till filing of this report in the evening.

## Jubo Dal activists held on rape charge

A schoolgirl was abducted and raped by a gang of six at Namuri village under Aditmari upazila of Lalmonirhat district on Sunday night.

Police rescued the girl, raiding the village early yesterday and arrested two of the gang while the rest four managed to flee.

The arrestees are former president of Jubo Dal Namuri Union unit Habibur Rahman Liton, 32, and Jubo Dal activist Mohammad Alim, 34.

Police said the victim, a class seven student of

Chaparhat High School, was going to her uncle's residence at Aditmari upazila headquarters in a rickshaw along with her cousin, also a class ten student of the school, on Sunday night.

When they reached Namuri village, the gang waylaid them, beat up the victim's cousin and the rickshaw-puller. They took her to a house at the village and raped her.

As the two sought help of the villagers, they informed Aditmari police of the matter. Police raided the village early yesterday and rescued the girl from a house. They also arrested the Jubo Dal

men on the spot while the rest four, including an auto-rickshaw driver, managed to flee.

Namuri Union Parishad Chairman Nuruzzaman took the schoolgirl into his custody and informed her family members who reached the village yesterday noon. The UP chairman handed over the girl to her family in presence of police.

Victim's family yesterday filed a case with Aditmari Police Station against six people including the arrested Jubo Dal men Habib and Alim. Police drive is going on to arrest the rest four.

## Seven charge-sheeted in Satkhira Palash abduction, murder case

The Criminal Investigation Department (CID) yesterday pressed charges against seven people in the sensational case for abduction and murder of Palash of Shibnagar village in Satkhira Sadar upazila.

The investigation officer (IO) of the case, CID Sub-Inspector (SI) Momtaz Ahmed submitted the charge sheet to the judicial magistrate's court yesterday, more than four years after the abduction.

26, Rejaul Karim, 50, his son Manirul Islam, 26, Rejaul's brother Shahidul Islam, 46, Abdul Wadood, 37, and Abdus Samad, 48, of Shibnagar village and Ashraf Ali Montu, 50, of Agaroani village in Sadar upazila.

Palash, 16, son of Abdur Rahim of Shibnagar village, worked as a guard at a shrimp enclosure owned by Rejaul Islam of the same village at Agardari area in Sadar upazila.

Palash went missing on June 29 in 2006, police said.

The victim's mother Monowara Begum filed a case with a court that ordered the

officer in charge of Sadar police station to take action after investigation.

Police on March 7 in 2007 recorded a case with Sadar police station accusing Yakub Ali, son of Jasor Ali of the same village for killing Palash.

Yakub Ali surrendered before the court on February 12 in 2008.

On June 21 in 2008, police recovered a skeleton from the safety tank of Agaroani Primary School in Sadar upazila and a DNA test ascertained that it was of Palash.

After investigation police submitted charge sheet against Yakub Ali to a Satkhira

court on December 11, 2007.

Following a naraji (non-acceptance) petition submitted by the complainant, the court asked the CID to investigate the case on August 28 in 2008.

SI Enamul Haque of the CID was made the IO.

Accused Yakub Ali, who gave a confessional statement before a court, mentioned the names of six other accused and narrated how they killed Palash on November 3 in 2008.

Later IO Enamul Haque was transferred and SI Momtaz Ahmed of the CID was made the new IO of the case.

## Rejoinder and our reply

The Daily Star correspondent in Khulna was present on the campus on September 17 night when a section of Kuet students were staging demonstration, vandalising several dormitories demanding shifting of their exam schedules. At one stage they also kept the VC confined for some time and asked for his removal unless the exam dates are deferred.

Regarding misspelling of VC's name, The Daily Star expresses sincere regret and it was unintended.

## Sedition case against Sayedee's lawyer

A sedition case was filed against Jamaat leader Delwar Hossain Sayedee's lawyer Barrister Fakhru Islam here yesterday for his remarks about the country's Liberation War.

Mohammad Fazlul Haque Bir Protik, commander of Tangail Zila Muktiyoddha Sangsad, filed the case with the Chief Judicial Magistrate Court. Judge Kawsar Ahmed after hearing of the case issued summons against the accused, court sources said.

The plaintiff alleged in his case that the accused, as the lawyer of Jamaat leader Sayedee and others, during a hearing of the International Crime Tribunal on September 22 degraded the Independence, Liberation War and Constitution of Bangladesh and said that the 1971 war took place between Pakistan and India.

The remarks of the accused was published in all newspapers on the next day and his views indicate that the accused is involved in the conspiracy to oust the present democratic government.

After filing the case, the freedom fighters as well as lawyers in the district held a briefly rally on the court premises. They later burnt the effigy of Barrister Fakhru Islam.

In Lalmonirhat, a human chain was held on Sunday protesting the remarks. The protesters demanded exemplary punishment of Barrister Fakhru and urgent trial of war criminals.

The human chain was formed at Mogholhat Railway gate in the town. District Awami League (AL) and its front organisation leaders, workers, freedom fighters and general public took part in the programme.

## JCD man stabbed at Sust 4 sent to jail in police assault case

An activist of Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) was stabbed allegedly by a group of Bangladesh Chhatra League men on the campus of Shahjalal University of Science and Technology (Sust) yesterday.

Critically injured Ashique Rahman Ayon has been admitted to the Sylhet MAG Osmani Medical College and Hospital.

Witnesses said, Ashique was attacked by the BCL group numbering about 7 to 8 at about 11:45am as he came out of the class at the E building on the campus.

They stabbed Ashique with sharp weapons inflicting serious injuries on his shoulder and head. He was immediately rushed to the hospital.

The incident was a sequel to a previous enmity, according to sources. Ashique is a student of final semester, Honours fourth year at Petroleum and Geo Resource Department.

Meanwhile, Chief Judicial Magistrate of

Sylhet Md Amir Uddin yesterday afternoon rejected the bail prayers of two JCD leaders and ordered to send them to jail *hajaj* after they surrendered in a police assault case.

They are former president of Sylhet Government College unit JCD Abdur Rakib Chowdhury and district JCD member Anwar Hossain Manik alias Kala Manik.

Court sources said the case was filed on May 6 after rival factions of JCD and BNP in the city locked in an armed clash and police lobbed tear shells to bring the situation under control.

Several gunshots were fired during the clash that turned the city's Zindabazar and adjoining areas into a battlefield for hours. Businessmen put their shutters down while ten policemen sustained injuries on the day.

Later, police filed a case accusing over a hundred BNP and JCD men.

The district and city JCD took out a procession in the city immediately after the two JCD leaders were sent to jail yesterday.

## Extortionists stab 3 students

Extortionists stabbed three students of Barisal Polytechnic Institute at Nabogram Road in the city early yesterday.

The injured are Abdur Rahim, 22, fourth semester student of computer technology, and Munir, 20, and Masud Rana alias Kawsar, 22, fourth semester students of civil engineering.

They are undergoing treatment at Barisal Sher-e-Bangla Medical College Hospital. They came under attack while returning to their mess at Nabogram Road from Oxford Mission Road crossing at around 12:30am.

Sources said the three students went to Harun's tea stall at Oxford Mission Road cross-

ing at around 11:45pm to take tea. While they were returning to their mess at Nabogram Road, a gang stabbed them.

The injured students alleged that a gang led by local ruling party cadres Jewel, Milon and Amin asked them to give money. "As we refused to oblige, they stabbed us and left the scene," they alleged.

Mir Mosharraf Hossain, principal of the institute, said he heard about the incident and was verifying the identity of the victims as it (incident) happened outside the campus at midnight.

No case was lodged with Kotwali Police Station in connection with the incident as of filing of this report at 6:00pm yesterday.
