

Radius Centre in Gulshan has organised a group art exhibition featuring the works of three painters: Tarikat Islam, Rajat Sen and Dipak Kundu. Of the three, Rajat and Dipak are from India, although their family roots go back to Bangladesh. Rajat is the son of noted Indian poet Samarendra Sengupta and his family hails from Purana Paltan in Dhaka. Dipak's ancestral roots are in Bogra. Due to the Partition (1947) both families

migrated to India.

The participating artists acquired their Master's degrees from Rabindra Bharati University.

At the exhibition, Tarikat reveals himself as a figurative painter and most of his works feature female forms, styles in cubism. The painter was inspired by Wassily Kandinsky, particularly his semi-curved and straight line based works. Tarikat's style of painting combines freely composed, purely abstract forms and geometric elements such as triangles and straight broad

composition. He firstly draws solid forms, and then experiments with them. His figures are more stylised as he continues the analysis. The painter feels his female figures are symbols of liberation. Dipak emphasises female faces,

capturing their various moods. The theme is very familiar and most upcoming painters start off with such subjects. At times, the painter highlights specific parts of the face and seeks to explore emotions and inner visions. His acrylic-based works are seemingly polished, yet uncomplicated. The works exude glee, and at the same time demonstrate the agony of loneliness. Use of light also causes the figures in red, blue, orange and brown to gleam in the darker interior. Waves and dotted forms add conceptual touches to his works.

Rajat is a lecturer at Rabindra Bharati University and developed his style with smooth colours and tones. His non-objective works delineate a serene space. His works have no title. Different textures and contrasts of light and colours create a layer that can be interpreted as pure abstract. The base looks soft for his meticulous brush strokes and limited texture.

Drama staged to create awareness on disease management

A play with a message was staged on the premises of Pankhaiya Para Marma Unnayan Sangsad under Sadar upazila in Khagrachhari district last Tuesday night. The aim was to create awareness about various diseases, especially malaria.

Artistes of Bangladesh Marma Unnayan Sangsad (a cultural forum of the indigenous Marma community) staged the play titled "Baidder Parinoti" while non-government organisation BRAC and the Upazila Health Complex jointly sponsored the programme.

The play features people of a remote hilly village who depend on the Almighty and quacks (locally known as Baidda) to provide them succour during an epidemic. Many people in the area consequently die from malaria and other diseases due to wrong treatment but the ancient practice continues -- until a health worker appears on the scene.

Though the health worker faces difficulty, she finally manages to bring the headman, village chief and other leaders around. She then engages them in discussions about health education, different diseases and their possible

cure. She succeeds in bringing the villagers on a common platform and making them aware of the need for primary health education.

Hundreds of Marmas, including children, watched and enjoyed the drama, which was staged in their village

using the native Marma language.

Sadar Upazila Health and Family Planning Officer Dr. Shahid Talukder; Upazila Manager of BRAC Health Programme Fazlul Hoque and its District Manager Rupom Chakma were present at the programme.


