KARNAPHULI INSURANCE
The new face value of the insurer's shares, following the change of denomination and market lot with effect from yesterday (the record date), will be Tk 10 instead of Tk 100, market lot will be 100 shares instead of 20 and the new adjusted open price for each share will be Tk 113.20.

PHOENIX INSURANCE

The Board of Directors of the insurer has decided: (a) to change the denomination of its shares from Tk 100 each to Tk 10 and determine the market lot of shares from 20 to 200, (b) to enhance the insurer's authorised capital from Tk 50 crore to Tk 100 crore and (c) to amend the relevant clause(s) of Memorandum And Articles of Association for effecting the changes. The above decisions will be executed, subject to the approval of shareholders in the forthcoming EGM and consent from the regulatory authority. The notice of the EGM will be notified later.

PUBALIBANK

Following the change of denomination of shares and market lot with effect from yesterday (the record date), the new face value of the bank's shares will be Tk 10 instead of Tk 100, market lot will be 25 shares instead of 5 and the new adjusted open price of shares will be Tk 73.30 per share.

AL-ARAFAH ISLAMIC BANK

The bank has decided that: (1) the authorised capital of AIBL Capital Market Services (a subsidiary of the bank) will be at Tk 1,000 crore and (2) the memberships of

DSE and CSE will be transferred from the bank to its subsidiary company at the prevailing market price, which will be determined through appointment of an independent valuer.

JAMUNA BANK

Share trading of the bank will be allowed only on the spot market and block/odd lot transactions will also be settled as per spot settlement cycle with the entitlement of rights shares from Sunday to Tuesday. The trade will remain suspended on Wednesday, the record date.

CMCKAMAL

Normal trading of the company's shares resumes Sunday, after a record date for EGM. Another record date for entitlement of the proposed rights share will be notified after obtaining approval from the SEC.

Oil down

Oil prices were down in Asian trade Thursday but a drawback in US crude inventories and strong data from the Chinese manufacturing sector ensured prices were well-supported, analysts said. New York's main contract, light sweet crude for November delivery, slipped five cents to 77.81 dollars a barrel in the afternoon.

Brent North Sea crude for delivery in November, fell 27 cents to 80.50 dollars.

Crude prices were taking a breather as markets digested gains made late Wednesday, said Ben Westmore, a minerals and energy economist of the National Australia Bank in Melbourne.
