Swadhin Bangla Betar Kendra artiste Bipul Bhattacharya critically ill

Swadhin Bangla Betar Kendra artiste Bipul Bhattacharya is fighting for his life at Delta Hospital, Dhaka.

Bhattacharya, a renowned folk singer, has lung cancer. As his condition worsened last Saturday, he was moved to the Intensive Care Unit of Delta Hospital where he has been undergoing treatment since September 27.

Bhattacharya was among those who used their creative abilities to inspire the nation during the Liberation War. He was a member of the troupe Bangladesh Mukti Shangrami Shilpi Shangstha' which travelled to and performed at refugee and freedom fighter camps during the war. Artistes like him were able to keep the dream of independence alive through their songs.

About the ailing artiste, fellow singer Rafiqul Alam said, "Artistes, litterateurs, intellectuals took shelter with the refugees at borders during the war. Litterateur Dipen Bandopadhyay was the chairman of International Peace Commission. He along with singers Konika Bandopadhyay, Suchitra Mitra, Kaifi Azmi (father of Shabana Azmi) and others formed a musical squad that was led by noted Tagore exponent Sanjida Khatun. Bipul joined the troupe later in August, 1971 and had been with the team till the end. The troupe's main intention was to raise funds for the guerrillas and alleviate the misery of the countless refugees who lived in camps set up in India.

throughout the mission. We would render one of my songs 'Saat Koti Aaj Prohori Prodip' in West Bengal. Sarwar Jahan Chowdhury, Probal Chowdhury, Rathindra Nath Roy, Shaheen Samad were there with us at Balughat, West Bengal. I have lots of memories with Bipul of that time. We recorded songs for 'Muktir Gaan' under Samar Das' direction. We would sing a Nazrul song 'Eki Oporup Roopey Ma Tomaye' where Bipul stood out in the folk portion while I rendered kirtan. Later we worked together at both Betar (radio) and TV. His current physical state breaks my heart," the

singer added. The troupe's journey was documented on film by American filmmaker Lear Levin. Twenty-five years later, Tareque and Catherine Masud recovered the footage from Levin's basement and used it in their award-

winning Film "Muktir Gaan". The success of the documentary once more put Bipul Bhattacharya and his comrades in the limelight.

Tareque and Catherine "Bipul was very active Masud on Bipul Bhattacharya: Bipul Bhattacharya is the soul of "Muktir Gaan". His voice, singing uplifting folk songs about the Liberation War, infuses the film with power and grace. Without Bipul Bhattacharya, there would be no "Muktir Gaan". First we lost Dulal Chandra

Shil, the talented dotara

player who died before "Muktir Gaan" was finished. Then we lost Moshad Ali, the songwriter whose contribution behind the scenes cannot be underestimated. But we don't want to lose our beloved Bipul da. We appeal to the Prime Minister, who has done so much to help other artistes of the country in their times of need, to lend her generous hand to save Bipul da, the shining light of "Muktir Gaan", the film which has helped to preserve the spirit of the Liberation War for

generations to come.

Singer Shaheen Samad who was a member of the 'Bangladesh Mukti Shangrami Shilpi Shangstha', had this to say about her former team-mate: "An artiste always dedicates himself/herself for the people and the country. But who ensures the security of an artiste at his/her times of need? As an artiste of 'Bangladesh Mukti Shangrami Shilpi Shangstha', I along with other artistes like Sudhin Das, Sujeyo Shyam, Dalia Nawshim, Bulbul Maholanbish, Rupa Khan, Mala Khan, Nashid Kamal, Sharmin Morshed, Tareque Masud, Mst. Mazharul Islam, Firoj Mahmud and organisations like Chhayanaut, Liberation War Museum and Sammilito Shangskritik Jote have stood beside 'Shabda Shainik' Bipul Bhattarchya. But is it enough? A large sum of money is required to carry out his treatment. Immediate help from the government is needed as his contributions towards

the country are endless." "Bipul joined 'Bangladesh Mukti Shangrami Shilpi Shangstha' and led many choruses like 'Shonen Shonen Bhai Shobey Satyo E Je Ghatona,' 'Bolo Bolo Rey Bolo Shobey Bolo Rey Bangalir Joy,' 'Ei Na Bangladyasher Gaan Gaitey Rey Amar Dukhey Poran Kandey,' 'O Rey Bishom Doirar Dheu,' 'Nao Chhariya Dey Paal Uraiya Dey' and many more. His renditions emboldened Freedom Fighters in the battlefield. We worked together during our Liberation War. When I see his current state, I can't help but cry," she added.

Alicia Keys teams up with Professor Yunus and social business

Nobel laureate Professor Muhammad Yunus and twelve-time Grammy Award winner singer Alicia Keys met late September at the Clinton Global Initiative, according to a press release. She has been an admirer of Professor Yunus' work and expressed her interest in collaborating with him to promote social business around the world, focusing particularly in Africa. She met Professor Yunus to discuss her possible role in the social business movement. Professor Yunus suggested that she could be a social business ambassador and the artiste readily agreed. As part of the agreement, she will introduce the concept of social business to her audience during her performances.

Keys' debut album, "Songs in A Minor", earned her five Grammy Awards in 2002, including Best New Artist and Song of the Year for "Fallin." Her second studio album, "The Diary of Alicia Keys" fetched her additional four Grammy Awards in 2005. Her third studio album,




Alicia Keys (right) with Professor Yunus.

"As I Am", was released in the same year and sold six million copies worldwide, earning Keys three more Grammy Awards. Throughout her career, Keys has won numerous awards and has sold over 30 million albums worldwide. Billboard magazine named her the top R&B artist of the 2000-2009 decade, establishing herself as one of the best-selling artistes of her time. In 2010, VH1 included Keys on its list of the 100 Greatest Artistes of

All Time. Alicia Keys is active in Africa in combating HIV/AIDS. She offered to work with Professor Yunus to launch social business programmes to help the AIDS victims, design and operate special villages for HIV/AIDS patients and their families. These programmes will be launched next year in South Africa and gradually expand in other African countries and India.

Professor Yunus invited Keys to visit Bangladesh. She assured him that she would come to Bangladesh as soon as her schedule permits.


