Over 100 school children from different educational institutions participated in three groups in the competition titled 'Our School' and 'Child Rights'. Children of 'Ka' group were free to improvise, while 'Kha' group was given the subject of 'Our School' and 'Ga' group, 'Child Rights'. Judges Khademul Islam, Ujjal Chowdhury and Mohammad Alam selected nine children from three groups for awards. There was more for children at World Children's Day and Child Rights' Week 2010. Apart from the painting competition, Thakurgaon District Administration and district unit of Bangladesh Shishu Academy had organised a weeklong programme including a rally, competitions on hand writing, essay, debate, songs, recitation and athletics for unprivileged and differently children; cultural programmes and a play. Play on eve teasing

Weeding out a social evil

A play that aimed to generate awareness about 'eve teasing', domestic violence and child abuse, was staged in a village under Biral upazila of Dinajpur on Monday afternoon to mark World Children's Day 2010. Society for Uddog, an NGO from Dinajpur, in association with Manusher Jonno Foundation, organised the programme at the premises of Kasidanga High School of Dharmoir Union. A discussion was also held at the same venue. Mohammad Golam Rabbani, Upazila Nirbahi Officer (UNO) of Biral upazila, was present as chief guest. A discussion, prior to the play, was chaired by the former headmaster of Kasidanga High School. Speakers at the discussion pointed out that women are feeling increasingly unsafe due to the rising incidents of eve-teasing. In fact in extreme situations, unable to cope with harassment, several girls and women have been driven to suicide. After the discussion, a procession was taken out through the village streets. The play was performed by the artistes trained by the Society for Uddog. The play emphasised that eve teasing is a crime,

which is difficult to prove. The social evil has become a common phenomenon at public places, even educational institutions. Such harassment cuts across all barriers of age, appearance, educational, professional and marital status. To counter this, women should be on their guard and fearlessly file complaints against the culprits. Moreover, it is necessary to eradicate the social evil from its very roots, an uphill task when films often go so far as to glorify the evil. The police should step up their vigil at schools and colleges and remote areas. Changing mindsets is the only solution to this problem.

Several of the Philippine airline's flight attendants do the "safety dance" in choreographed moves in a YouTube video that has gone viral. "The safety demo dance rendition is just another way to bring out our fun culture and showcase our home-grown talents. We plan to roll this out onto more flights after receiving great commendations from the global

"We do not compromise safety in anything we do, and it will remain our primary concern. We just really know how to have fun too," Iyog said.
