

# Trial of 93 BDR mutineers begin at Rajshahi tomorrow

## Witnesses start giving deposition before Ctg special court

The special court will start trial proceedings against 93 BDR mutineers of 37 Rifles Battalion at Rajshahi battalion headquarters tomorrow. Rajshahi BDR Sector Commander Col Md Aheya Azam Khan will chair the three-member court, said the 37 Rifles Battalion Commander Lt Col M Zahid Hasan who will act as prosecutor, according to our staff correspondent.

Other members of the court are Lt Col Gazi Khalid Hossain and Maj Towhidul Islam. A representative of the attorney general and a civil lawyer will be present during the trial proceedings.

Ninety-three members of 37 Rajshahi Rifles Battalion revolted against

their officers in February 25 and 26 in 2009, expressing solidarity with the mutineers in BDR headquarters in Pikhana.

The BDR members were arrested on May 18 after Ramjan Ali, the then officer-in-charge of Boalia Police Station, filed a case with Rajshahi CMM's Court against them the day before. The arrested BDR men are now in jail.

Our staff correspondent from Chittagong adds: The special court in Chittagong yesterday started taking deposition against 35 mutineers of 10 Rifles Battalion's Bolipara camp.

The Special Court-16, set up at Rifles Training Centre and School at Baitul Izzat in Satkania, took deposition of three witnesses yester-

day. They are plaintiff Subedar Sultan Ahmed, former battalion commander Lt Col Abdullah Ali Zayed and Lt Col Mosharrif Hossain.

The accused BDR men told the court that the witnesses were giving false information against them. At one stage, accused signalman Wahidur Rahman admitted to his guilt and sought apology to the court.

The court adjourned the proceedings until 9.30am today. On Sunday, the special court headed by Rangamati BDR Sector Commander Col Bashirul Islam framed charges 35 jawans of 10 Rifles Battalion's Bolipara camp for their involvement in 2009 BDR mutiny.

# 5 bombs found in Benapole

BDR Subedar Siddikur Rahman said, acting on a tip-off, they conducted a drive at Baropota village and recovered the bombs hidden in a polythene bag at an abandoned place.

Later, explosives experts of BDR defused the bombs.

# Thief dies in mob beating

A thief died in mob beating at Lochangor village under Natore Sadar upazila on Sunday night.

The victim was identified as Hannan Shah, 45, of Kasharighasha village under the upazila.

Natore police station SI Nabir Uddin said Hannan is a notorious thief. Locals beat him mercilessly on an allegation that he tried to steal two cows from Dulal's house at Lochangor village on Sunday night. Police sent the body to Natore Sadar Hospital morgue for autopsy.

# Covered-van driver killed by muggers

A covered-van driver was strangled by a gang of muggers in Sonaimuri upazila on Sunday night.

The deceased was identified as Yasin, 35, of Feni district. Police said the gang intercepted the cotton-laden covered-van on Feni bypass road on its way to Gazipur from Chittagong at around 10:00pm.

They tied hands and legs of helper Monir and left him in Bogadia area on Begumganj-Sonaimuri road. Later, the criminals took control of the van at gunpoint, snatched Tk 10,000 from Yasin and strangled him.

Locals found the body of Yasin inside the van yesterday morning and informed the police who went to the spot, recovered the body and sent it to Sadar Hospital morgue for autopsy.

# 366 puja mandops in Kishoreganj

Preparations for observance of Durgapuja, the greatest religious festival of Hindu community is going on in full swing.

A total of 366 mandops will be erected in 13 upazilas of Kishoreganj district this year.

Of the total, 46 mandaps will be in Sadar upazila, 10 mandaps in Karimganj upazila, 19 in Pakundia, 18 in Hossainpur, 16 in Katiadi, 39 in Bazitpur, 76 in Kuliarchar, 27 in Bhairab, 21 in Itna, 24 in Mithamoin, 15 in Austagram, 45 in Nikli and 10 in Tarail upazila, sources in district puja observance committee said.

Police sources said, tight security measures will be taken in the puja mandops. Additional police, ansar and security personnel will also be deployed, they said.

# PUST starts online admission system

# All spillway gates opened as Kaptai dam overflows

Authorities of Karnaphuli Hydro Station (KHS), the lone hydro-electric plant of the country, on Saturday opened all the 16 gates of its spillway to protect the dam as water in the reservoir has been flowing at danger level following four days of incessant rain coupled with flash flood.

KHS has been discharging 45,000 cusec of water through the spillway in addition to 30,000 - 35,000 cusec of water

through the generation units commissioning its all five units to produce electricity round the clock, manager of KHS, engineer Ferdows Ali told BSS yesterday.

The 230 MW capacity hydro-electricity plant under Bangladesh Power Development Board provided 226 MW of electricity to the national grid on Sunday, he said.

A vast area in six upazilas in the upstream of the dam at Kaptai of Rangamati district

went under water due to incessant rainfall that caused flash flood while areas with standing crops and dwellings in large areas of four upazilas under Chittagong district remained inundated in the downstream of the dam for continued discharge of about 80,000 cusec of water daily, observed affected people of the two districts.

Hundreds of dwellings on the banks of the lake, even in Rangamati town, are also inundated.

KHS Manager Ferdows, however, said, "There is nothing to be worried about as there is no rainfall today [Monday] and we are discharging sufficient water."

Meantime, Kathaltali dam that connects one part of Rangamati town with other part is under threat due to onrush of water while the hanging bridge of Holiday Complex of Bangladesh Parjaton Corporation (BPC) went under chest-deep water last week, said sources in BPC.
