Transport worker murdered

A transport worker was murdered at Cowripara in the town on Tuesday night. The dead was identified as Zakir Hossain, 30, son of Moti Miah of the same area. Renu Begum, 28, sister of the deceased, said a gang of local criminals led by Rana called her brother out of their house at around 9:30pm. They took him to a field near Alijan Jute Mills and slit his throat. On information, police rushed to the spot, recovered the body and sent it to Narsingdi Sadar Hospital morgue for autopsy.

Criminal arrested

UNB, Benapole

Police arrested a criminal at his house in Navaran Bazar area of Sharsha upazila early Tuesday. The arrestee is Dalimur Rahman Dalim, son of Jamal Uddin. Acting on a tip-off, law enforcers from Shasha Police Station raided the house at around 4:00am and arrested Dalim. Officer-in-charge of the police Aslam Hossain said Dalim was wanted in a number of cases including one for murder.

Robbers loot house

Robbers took away gold ornaments and other valuables from a journalist's house in Manikganj town yesterday. Monirul Islam Mihir, Manikganj correspondent of the UNB, and his wife went to their relative's house in the town at around 11:00am. Taking advantage of their absence, a gang of robbers entered Mihir's residence at Sewta in the town by breaking lock of the door and looted seven tolas of gold ornaments and Tk 30,000. A case was filed with Manikganj Sadar Police Station. No one was arrested in connection with the robbery as of filing of this report at 6:00pm yesterday.

One held with bombs

A joint team of Rab and police arrested a man in Gangni upazila of Meherpur district on Tuesday night and recovered four bombs from his possession. The arrestee Billal Hossain, 55, of Thanapara village in the upazila, used to supply bombs to outlawed parties and criminal gangs, Rab sources said. Acting on a tip-off, a joint team of Rab-6 and Gangni police raided a tea stall owned by Billal at Thanapara at around 8:00pm. They recovered four bombs from the tea shop and arrested him. Gangni police said Billal was accused in two cases filed with the police station under Explosive Substances Act. He was arrested along with bomb-making materials in September this year and released on bail a few days ago, said Officer-in-Charge Motiar Rahman of Gangni Police Station.

Dubai expat strangled

A Dubai expatriate was strangled at village Loraighata in Moheshpur upazila on Tuesday night. The dead was identified as Hasanur Rahman, 32, son of Jalu Uddin of Kadamtali village in the same upazila. Locals and police said Hasanur went missing on Monday. Locals found his body in a ditch yesterday morning. Being informed, police rushed to the spot, recovered the body and sent to Sadar Hospital for autopsy. Enmity over land dispute might be the cause of the incident, police said.

Mobile court fines 6 shops

A mobile court fined six shops of CD-VCD at Taltola in the city yesterday and seized a large number of porno CDs. The court led by magistrate Sadia Jaman conducted the drive in the area and fined the shop owners Tk 45,000 and seized 346 CDs from the shops. The court realised Tk 10,000 as fine each from Mahin Electronics, Rima CD Bazar, Sangeeta CD Complex and Tk 5,000 from New Prodi CD Bazar, Concert Corner and Fahiza CD Bazar each. The seized porno CDs were later damaged.

BDR mutineers' trial

The Special Court-14 took into its cognizance the charges against 29 BDR mutineers of 1 Rifles Battalion at Kalikatcha in Sarail upazila of Brahmanbaria district yesterday. Witness Subedar Major Md.Nurul Karim brought the charges against the accused during the trial that began at around 11:00 am and continued until 12:25 pm. The Special Court adjourned the trial proceedings of the mutineers until 9:00 am today. Col SM Farhad of Comilla sector commander, chaired the four-member special court at the battalion headquarters of 1 Rifles Battalion. The other members are Deputy Attorney General Farhad Ahmed, BDR officials Lieutenant Colonel Akhteruzzaman and Major Md Maksudul Alam. Lieutenant Col Abu Saleh Md.Gulam Ambia, the commanding officer of 1 Rifles Battalion, is the prosecutor while Gazi Zillur Rahman and Dewan Mohiuddin are the special prosecutors. The special court asked the authorities concerned to arrest 12 fugitive accused in the case and produce them before the court. The rest 17 accused are now in Brahmanbaria jail. In a press briefing yesterday, Lieutenant Col Abu Saleh Md.Gulam Ambia said 29 members of the battalion revolted against their officer on February 26 in 2009, expressing their solidarity with the mutineers of BDR headquarter in Pilkahna, Dhaka.

10-yr-old girl saved from early marriage

An attempt of early marriage of a ten-year-old girl was foiled in Dumuria upazila on Monday evening due to timely intervention of upazila chairman Gazi Abdul Hadi and upazila women affairs officer Nazmun Nahar.

The girl was identified as Jony Akhter, daughter of Mahatab Sheikh, a butcher by profession at Katakhal village under the upazila. She is also a class five student of Dumuria Non-government Primary School.

Parents arranged the early marriage of the girl with a 22-year-old man of Jamira village under Phultala upazila whose identity could not be known.

On a secret information, Dumuria Upazila Chairman Gazi Abdul Hadi, also joint secretary of Khulna district

Awami League, and women affairs officer Nazmun Nahar rushed to Katakhal village and foiled the early marriage of the girl.

Nazmun Nahar said including police could not know the name of the man with whom marriage of the girl was supposed to take place.

As all guests invited to the marriage ceremony, including the marriage registrar and the matchmaker, left the place before we reached there, none at the village could tell the name of the groom, upazila chairman Gazi Abdul Hadi said.

According to the women affairs officer, the girl was shifted elsewhere from her parents' house early yesterday. 'We are closely watching movement of her parents to locate the girl's whereabouts', Nazmun Nahar said.

Drug peddler gets life, 3 others held

A Chapainawabganj court yesterday sentenced a drug peddler to life imprisonment in a case filed under Narcotics Control Act while law enforcers arrested three others with illegal drugs in Mymensingh the same day.

In Chapainawabganj, District and Sessions Judge's Court awarded life imprisonment to Osman Gani, 27, son of Abdul Mannan of Raninagar village under Alatali union of Chapainawabganj Sadar upazila, reports our correspondent.

Judge Anwar Hossain pronounced the verdict in presence of the accused. The judge acquitted another accused Alam Ali, 38, of the same village as charges brought against him could not be proved.

According to the prosecution, BDR team of Hakimpur border outpost arrested Osman in front of a house at Harishpur village in the upazila at around 7:10pm on December, 26, 2007 and recovered 80 grams heroin from his possession.

The BDR team handed him over to Sadar Police Station the following day and filed a case against Osman and his accomplice Alam under Narcotics Control Act.

After investigation, Sub-Inspector Liakot Ali pressed charges against the two on January 23, 2008.

After examining the prosecution witnesses and other relevant documents, the court handed down the verdict.

In Mymensingh, Rab personnel in separate drives arrested three drug peddlers in the town and Dhubaria upazila early yesterday and on Monday.

According to our correspondent, A team of Rab-9 arrested drug trader Rokon, son of Rajab Ali of Dakshin Ranipur village in the upazila at around 1:00am and recovered 96 bottles of foreign wine from his possession.

Acting on a tip-off, Rab personnel raided Satariapara village in the upazila and arrested Rokon. Following his confessional statement, the Rab team later recovered the wine and a motorcycle from his house.

Rokon was later handed over to Dhubaria police. On Monday, the elite force conducted a drive in Raghurampur rail gate area in the town and arrested Siraj Mia, 32, and Ishak Uddin, 60, along with illegal drugs.

The arrestees were later handed over to the police. A case filed against them under Narcotics Control Act.

Fresh probe into Sunamganj grenade attack case ordered

Sylhet Divisional Speedy Trial Tribunal Judge Muhammad Mahubb-Ul-Islam on Tuesday ordered further investigation into two cases filed after the grenade attack on a rally of Awami League leader Suranjit Sengupta MP in Sunamganj in 2004.

The judge passed the order following a petition submitted by Special Public Prosecutor Kishore Kumar Kar, seeking further investigation into the cases.

The cases, one for murder and the other under Explosive Substances Act, were filed after grenade attack on the rally at Derai upazila headquarters on June 21, 2004. AL activist Abdul Wahid, 45, was killed and 30 others were injured in the attack.

Suranjit Sengupta and other AL leaders escaped unhurt as they got down from the dais just moments ahead of the attack.

CID Inspector Shafiqur Rahman on December 14, 2008 submitted charge sheets in the two cases with the Judicial Magistrate's Court in Sunamganj against Huji chief Mufti Abdul Hannan and six others, court sources said.

The other accused are Mufti Abdul Hannan's younger brother Moftizul Islam alias Mohibullah, Shariful Alam Bipul, Delwar Hossain Ripon, Hafiz Nayeem Ahmed, Mufti Main Uddin and Naziur Rahman Nazu.

Considering the impor-

tance of the two cases, the home ministry transferred the cases to the speedy trial tribunal through a gazette notification in October last year.

The tribunal on 30 June this year framed charges against

the accused and started recording depositions of the witnesses July 13.

Earlier on 15 September, the judge of the tribunal recorded deposition of seven police inspectors, who had served as

investigation officers of the cases. The prosecution witnesses include the then inspector of CID Shafiqur Rahman who had filed the charge sheets in the sensational cases.
