

## Meet 13-point demand for dev of greater Khulna

*Demands human chain*

Greater Khulna Development Action Co-ordination Committee (GKDACC) yesterday formed a human chain at Picture Palace Cinema Hall intersection in the city yesterday to press for its 13-point demand for development of greater Khulna.

The demands are construction of embankments in the Aila affected areas and rehabilitation of the homeless people, completion of the project for supply of gas through pipelines, modernisation of Mongla seaport, construction of a modern rail station in Khulna, implementation of the project for installation of a 300 megawatt power plant in Khulna, reopening of all closed jute mills and Khulna Newsprint Mill,

development of Sundarbans-based tourism, installation of second submarine cable landing station at Mongla, supply of safe drinking water in the south-western region, construction of IT village, reopening of Dada Match Factory, construction of Shilpakala Academy in Khulna and modernisation of Bhomra land port of Satkhira district.

Leaders and activists of BNP, Juba League, Workers Party, Jatiya Party, socio-cultural and non-governmental organisations and leaders of business community joined the human chain programme. The programme was followed by a rally at the venue with President of GKDACC Alhaj Liakat Ali in the chair.

Speakers urged the government to complete construction of embankments in the Aila

affected upazilas of Khulna, Bagerhat and Satkhira districts on top priority basis to redress sufferings of the homeless people and to implement the projects for their rehabilitation.

Liakat Ali in his speech urged the prime minister to meet the demands for development of greater Khulna.

The rally was addressed, among others, by Editor of The Daily Tribune Begum Ferdousi Ali, Executive Director of Rupantar Swapan Guha, Chairperson of Khulna Nagorik Forum Sheikh Abdul Quaiyum, jute exporter Sheikh Abdul Mannan, former BNP lawmaker M Nurul Islam Dadu, workers Party leader Mozammel Hossain, National Awami Party (Bhasani) leader Kaikobad Ali and Juba League leader Shafiqul Islam Palash.

## 350 chocolate bombs found in passenger bus in Moulvibazar

*Two pipe guns seized from Meherpur*

Police recovered 350 chocolate bombs and explosives in a passenger bus in Juri upazila of Moulvibazar district yesterday while Rab seized two firearms from a bus counter on Wednesday night in Kushtia.

In Moulvibazar, police recovered the bombs from a bus on Juri-Fultola road in the morning and arrested two passengers named Ustaz Ali, 58, and Younus Ali, 45, on charge of carrying the bombs and explosives, reports our correspondent.

Acting on a tip-off, a police team from Juri Police Station conducted a search on the bus

at around 8:00am in South Sagornal area and found the bombs and explosives kept in 13 packets. A case has been filed with Juri Police Station.

Our Kushtia correspondent reported that Rapid Action Battalion (Rab) recovered two firearms from a bus counter in Meherpur on Wednesday night.

Acting on a tip-off, a team of Rab-6, led by Assistant Police Superintendent (ASP) Sheikh Jahidul Islam raided the counter of GR Paribahad in Meherpur town at around 9:00 pm and found a box there.

After opening the box, they found two Indian made pipe guns in it.

Rab picked up the staff of the bus counter for interrogation.

## MONGLA POURA CHAIRMAN MURDER

### All three accused acquitted

A court here yesterday acquitted all the three accused in Mongla Pourasava chairman MA Baten murder case.

Judge Md Sekandar Ali of Khulna Divisional Speedy Trial Tribunal pronounced the verdict, acquitting Ziaur Rahman Zia, Rakib Munshi and Sheikh Shahid as charges brought against them could not be proved due to lack of evidence.

MA Baten, also the president of BNP Mongla upazila

unit, was shot dead at Shalebonia under Mongla upazila of Bagerhat district at 8:00pm on March 18, 2004.

Md Mahe Ali, elder brother of the deceased, filed a case with Mongla Police Station on March 20, naming none as accused.

During investigation, Sub-Inspector of M A Matin arrested the three in connection with the murder and pressed charges against them on November 27, 2005. The court recorded statements of 25 out of 32 prosecution witnesses during the trial.
