

## KAPASIA CITIZEN CHARTER PLACED

## Correct me if I am wrong: Sohel Taj

Setting an example, Awami League (AL) lawmaker Tanjim Ahmad Sohel Taj placed a citizen charter at his Kapasia constituency urging the people to correct him if he commits any wrong.

In the charter, he specified the roles of every individual, police, local administration, leaders of AL and its different associated bodies and elected representatives to build a Sonar Bangla as dreamt by Father of the Nation Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman.

Sohel Taj, who resigned from the post of state minister for home last year, on Saturday placed the charter and a presentation on the country's political scenario from 1952 to 2008 through a big LED screen at Shaheed Tajuddin Ahmed Degree College at Kapasia.

Several thousand people of the constituency, including deputy commissioner of Gazipur district and senior police officers

and officials of local administration were present at the programme titled "Evaluation Meeting 2010."

Amidst huge claps from the audiences, Taj, only son of first prime minister of Bangladesh Tajuddin Ahmed, said, "You carry out your responsibilities and correct me if I commit any wrong."

The ex-state minister directed the police administration not to engage in politics and warned that any negligence in duty and allegation of corruption would be dealt with an iron hand.

Taj called upon the activists of AL and its different associated bodies to work for the well being of the people whatever political ideology they belong to.

He asked all to submit a report to him every month containing people's hopes and aspiration, allegation against anyone, misdeeds or anything. "I will rule the constituency based on the reports," he said in his five-hour presentation.

## 5 NCTB officials suspended

The government yesterday suspended five officials of National Curriculum and Textbook Board (NCTB) for printing and other errors in Islamic history (Dakhil) book of class IX and X of the next academic year.

The suspension came after a three-member probe committee, formed to look into the errors, submitted its report to the education ministry, accusing the five officials.

The suspended officials are print ordering official Ohid Alam Lashkar and press monitoring officials Asgar Ali Hawlader, Ferdaous-Ur Rahman, Abul Hashem Khan and Nargis Siddika.

The probe committee recommended the return of all copies, already sent to different district education offices, to the NCTB office. Sources said around 1.65 lakh copies of the book have been sent to the district level.

Education ministry sources said the committee was formed on October 26 and directed by Education Minister Nurul Islam Nahid, who was abroad at the time when the errors were noticed.

## Suspected killer held

Police yesterday arrested a suspected killer who had allegedly hacked his brother and his sister-in-law to death on October 12 at their residence in city's Sabujbagh.

Officer-in-Charge (OC) Mohammad Asaduzzaman of Sabujbagh Police Station said they arrested Mohammad Shaheen when he was roaming in the area around 6:00am.

On the other hand, locals claimed that Shaheen, who was on the run after the incident, came out of his hideout to surrender to the law enforcers.

On October 12, Mohammad Shaheen allegedly hacked indiscriminately his brother's wife Rabeya Khatun and his brother Mostafizur Rahman over a family feud leaving Rabeya dead on the spot and his brother critically injured.

## Bangla-Myanmar maritime boundary case milestone

Says Int'l tribunal president

President of the International Tribunal for the Law of the Sea (ITLOS) Judge José Luis Jesus has termed the case over the dispute concerning delimitation of the maritime boundary between Bangladesh and Myanmar in the Bay a milestone for the tribunal.

Judge José Luis Jesus told this at a meeting of legal advisors of ministries of foreign affairs at the United Nations in New York on October 25.

He noted that the request for an advisory opinion from the International Seabed Authority is a significant development in the tribunal's work since it is the first case brought before the Seabed Disputes Chamber, the body with exclusive competence over matters concerning the area.

Bangladesh has maritime boundary dispute with both India and Myanmar and registered its objections with UN in this connection to get legal solution.

Bangladesh already placed its claims before ITLOS, based in Hamburg in Germany,

in last June and Myanmar is due to file its counter-memorial by December 1.

After Myanmar's submission, the ITLOS again set time for reply and rejoinder by the two countries. As per that schedule, Bangladesh will reply Myanmar's counter-memorial by March 15 next year and then again rejoinder to be given by Myanmar on July 1 next year.

The tribunal will then start proceedings and justify the demands made by the two countries regarding the delimitation of the maritime boundary in the Bay of Bengal.

With India, Bangladesh's deadline to submit its claim is by May 31 next year and India will submit its memorial by May 31, 2012.

The foreign ministry, which is dealing with the case, has already hired experts from abroad, who surveyed the Bay and assisting Bangladesh to put its demand.

The foreign experts are also assisting Bangladesh in preparing report to place its demand of continental shelf at the UN by early next year.

## OVERHEAD CABLES TO UNDERGROUND ISPs, cable operators get one month

The deadline given to internet service providers (ISP) and cable operators to reroute their overhead cables to underground has been extended by one month.

Power ministry officials, at a meeting yesterday, took the decision to give the service mongers time until November 31 for removing the overhead cables from the main roads between Uttara and Shahbagh.

Deputy Secretary (Coordination) Maksuda Khatun of the ministry said the organisations requested additional time to make preparations to connect to the underground network.

She, however, said, "The underground infrastructure to house the cables is all set."

The ISP owners said it is taking time to get connected with the subterranean network due to financial and technical reasons.

As the charges are quite high, many smaller ISPs and cable operators would need more time to prepare logistics and finances for the conversion, said Akhteruzzaman Manju, president of Internet Service Providers Association of Bangladesh (ISPAB).

In March, the government gave deadline until October 31 to rid the poles between Uttara and Shahbagh from overhead cables. It is the first phase of a plan that aims to remove all overhead 'non utility' cables from city thoroughfares.

In the second phase, overhead cables on the main road between Shahbagh and Motijheel will be removed. The third phase will target the cables from Motijheel to Mogbazar.
