Sweden ready

to help fight

King of Sweden Carl Gustaf Folke Hubertus said his country is ready to support Bangladesh in its battle against climate change.

The King told the newly appointed Bangladesh Ambassador to Sweden AFM Gousal Azam Sarker who called on His Majesty to present his credentials on 27 October, says a foreign ministry press release.

King Gustaf said Sweden encouraged its ambassador to work for enhancing and widening bilateral cooperation. He also expressed happiness at the commercial presence and investment of his country in Bangladesh and at the steady growth in trade.

Culture and identities of over 46 indigenous communities in Bangladesh should be recognised through amending the constitution, said speakers at a discussion yesterday.

They said members of the indigenous communities have been living on this land for centuries, enhancing its beauty and developing their own culture, rules and identities.

So, the indigenous communities deserve the constitutional recognition to their own culture, identities and land where they have been living for years, they added.

They told this at the discussion on Conventional rights of members of indigenous communities on lands, Chittagong Hill Tracts (CHT) Treaty and constitutional recognition of indigenous communities at the Jatiya Press Club auditorium in the city.

Barrister Sara Hossain said the word Adivasi should be written clearly in the

constitution in the case of identifying members of the indigenous communities. The matter of receiving equal opportunities from the society by the indigenous people should be mentioned in the constitution too.

She said law should be enforced in proper way in Chittagong Hill Tracts area for upholding the rights of indigenous communities.

General Secretary of Bangladesh Adivasi Odhikar Andolan Prof Mesbah Kamal said it should be written clearly in the constitution that Bangladesh is a land of people of multi-diversity and plurality.

The matter of diversity in culture and communities should also be mentioned in the preamble of the constitution as the preamble sets the tone of an entire constitution, said Mesbah, also a teacher of Dhaka University.

He demanded a list of communities having own culture, tradition and identities for attaching to the constitution and avert problems in future.

Member of International Commission for Chittagong Hill Tracts Dr Shawpan Adnan said the conventional law of indigenous communities on land should be prepared in written form and rules should be made considering the conventional law.

He said the process of grabbing lands from the members of indigenous communities is going on though the CHT Peace Treaty was signed to stop the process. He expressed concerns as a good number of indigenous community members are leaving their houses following grabbing of land by settlers and different companies.

Presenting the keynote paper, Information and Publicity Secretary of Parbartya Chattagram Jana Sanghati Samity demanded reserve seats in the parliament for the members of indigenous communities and constitutional recognition of indigenous people's rights on land and natural resources.




