Asian FMs' meet in **Tehran from Nov 8**

Iran will host the 9th meeting of the foreign ministers of the Asia Cooperation Dialogue (ACD) in Tehran on November 8-9.

Bangladesh is one of the founder members of the 31-nation organisation, which was founded in Cha-Am in Thailand in 2002 aimed to further promote interdependence among Asian countries, expand trade and financial market within Asia, serve as the missing link in Asian cooperation and transform the Asian continent into an Asian community.

Foreign Minister Dipu Moni will depart Dhaka on Saturday to attend the meeting and will deliver Bangladesh's statement. The two-day meeting will be held at Summit Conference Centre in Tehran.

The ACD was founded by 18 members and currently comprises the 31 states.

The founding members are: Bangladesh, Bahrain, Brunei Darussalam, Cambodia, China, India, Indonesia, Japan, Republic of Korea, Lao PDR, Malaysia, Myanmar, Pakistan, the Philippines, Qatar, Singapore, Thailand and Vietnam.

Later, Kazakhstan, Bhutan, Russia, Tajikistan, Kuwait, Kyrgyzstan, Iran, Saudi Arabia, Uzbekistan, Oman, Mongolia, Sri Lanka and the UAE became members.

Iranian Foreign Minister Manouchehr Mottaki will chair the meeting, which will be concluded with adopting of Tehran Declaration.

bail to Paban again

A Dhaka court yesterday extended the bail till November 22 to Khandaker Akhter Hamid Paban, son of BNP Secretary General Khandaker Delwar Hossain, in a cracker blast case.

The case was filed with Gulshan Police Station against Paban and five others on charge of exploding crackers in front of BNP Chairperson Khaleda Zia's Gulshan office on February 23 this year.

Judge Mohammad Zohurul Hoque of the Metropolitan Sessions Judge's Court passed the order after Paban along with his lawyers appeared before it and submitted a petition seeking extension of bail term on grounds of illness.

The court also directed officer-in-charge of Chatkhil Police Station to submit a report by November 22 on execution of arrest warrant issued earlier against Omar Faruk, former Jatiyatabadi Chhatradal (JCD) president of Chatkhil thana unit.

ACC files case against six **EPB** officials

The Anti-Corruption Commission (ACC) yesterday filed a case against six officials of Export Promotion Bureau (EPB) on charge of allocating "Mukta quota" for fake garments factories, created

through forging documents. ACC investigation revealed in the period between 1989 and 1999 the six officials through mutual collaboration allocated 13,136 dozen Mukta Quota under different categories to 14 fake garments factories.

Mukta Quota is system through which the government used to allocate cotton, received from foreign countries to garment factories. The accused are former director KM Salehin, former deputy director M Atikullah, former investigator Mosharaf Hossain, current director Omar Faruk, assistant director AKM Golam Mostafa and inspection officer Nazrul Islam Zamali.

The case was filed with Tejgaon police station.






