

China warns West envoys off Nobel ceremony

China has warned other countries against attending the award ceremony in Oslo for Nobel peace laureate Liu Xiaobo, diplomats said yesterday, in the latest sign of Beijing's irritation at the Norwegian Nobel Committee's pick this year.

Diplomats from several countries said China's embassy in Oslo had sent letters to Western missions implicitly cautioning them not to attend the prize ceremony on December 10 in the Norwegian capital.

The decision to award the prize to Liu, a veteran Chinese dissident currently serving an 11-year prison sentence for subversion against the state, has enraged the Communist government in Beijing.

In Beijing, Vice Foreign Minister Cui Tiankai said governments would have to "take responsibility for the consequences" if they showed support for Liu, according to Dow Jones Newswires.

Indonesia's most active volcano killed 77 people yesterday in its biggest eruption in over a century, incinerating homes, grounding flights and driving thousands into shelters.

Ash, deadly heat clouds and molten debris gushed from the mouth of Mount Merapi and shot high into the sky for most of the night and into the morning, triggering panic and chaos on the roads as people fled in the darkness.

The latest deaths bring the overall toll to 120 since the volcano started erupting on Java island on October 26, a day after a tsunami killed more than 400 people in a remote area off Sumatra island to the west.

The mountain spewed ash over a vast area including the Central Java provincial capital of Yogyakarta, about 28 kilometres (17 miles) to the south.

"The death toll from last night's eruption rose to 77 and the total number since the first eruption on October 26 has become 120 people killed," National Disaster Management spokesman Sutopo Purwo Nugroho told AFP.

Many of the dead were from Argomulyo village, 18 kilometres from the crater, according to emergency response officials and witnesses, with several children under the age of 10 killed.

There were at least 156 people injured in the latest eruption, the spokesman said, "most suffered burn injuries".

Rescuer Utha told AFP as he delivered 10 bodies to the hospital: "I found three bodies: a child, mother and father, still in their bed. They must have been sleeping when the hot ash struck their house."

"We also found a dead man with a phone still in his hand."

Yogyakarta police force Teguh Dwi Santyosarta told AFP: "Argomulyo village has been burned down to the ground by the heat clouds. Many children have died there. When I was in the village the ground was still hot."

A river running through the village overflowed with a thick mixture of mud and ash, and several bodies lay unclaimed in the debris, witnesses said.

The ranks of evacuees increased to 166,556 people after officials widened the danger zone from 15 to 20 kilometres early Friday. Everyone living in the area was ordered to evacuate their homes and shelters immediately.

The international airport at Yogyakarta was closed as ash clouds billowed from the 2,914-metre (9,616-foot) mountain to the altitude of cruising jetliners and the runway was covered in grey soot.

Officials said the airport would remain closed until Saturday.

Merapi killed around 1,300 people in 1930 but even though the total death toll from its latest series of eruptions is only about 100, experts say they are the biggest convulsions since 1872.

Military proxies prepare to sweep rare Myanmar poll

Myanmar votes for the first time in 20 years tomorrow in a scripted election where military-backed parties are assured victory, but the poll is also stirring faint hopes of change in one of the world's most isolated states.

The carefully choreographed end of direct army rule, marred by complex rules that stifled major pro-democracy forces, enters its final stage in a largely two-horse race between two powerful army-backed parties running virtually unopposed.

The ballot, the first since a 1990 poll ignored by the military after its proxies were trounced, has been dubbed an "election of generals" and panned as the reclusive junta's formal transfer of power to itself.

"They will maintain the status quo and need only a small majority to do it," said Win Min, an exiled Burmese academic and expert on Myanmar's military. "Be sure that the generals want to win, and they want to win big."

The Union Solidarity and Development Party (USDP) is the military's political juggernaut, fielding 27 incumbent ministers, top-heavy with recently retired generals and boasting 18 million members among the estimated 28 million eligible voters.

The USDP has dominated the campaign and will contest all 1,158 seats up for grabs. Its only real challenge comes from the National Unity Party (NUP), another vehicle for the military, running for 980 seats.

Twenty-five percent of seats in all chambers are reserved for serving generals. That means an army-backed party needs to win only 26 percent of the remaining seats for the junta's allies to have a controlling stake in the country's national legislature.

83 pilgrims die as Indian ferry sinks

Dozens still missing

At least 83 Muslim pilgrims drowned and 44 are still missing after an overcrowded ferry sank in a river in eastern India six days ago, officials said Friday.

Senior local official G.D.Gautam said the sunken ferry was also found in a joint navy, coast guard and police operation off West Bengal state, where the accident occurred last week.

The ferry, which had a capacity for 60 passengers, was carrying 220 people when it overturned on the Murriganga river after a Muslim religious event.

"Ninety-three passengers were rescued while fishermen and rescuers have so far retrieved 83 bodies," state home secretary Gautam said in the regional capital Kolkata.

"Forty-four others are still missing," he added as other state government officials said chances of finding more survivors were remote.

Navy vessels, a helicopter and fishermen have been involved in searching the area, which is in a tidal part of the Sundarbans mangrove forest.

The boat went down after hitting a sandbank in rough weather, police said.

Boat accidents are common in the South Asian subcontinent due to lax safety standards and overloading.

A similar ferry sinking occurred in the same river in September, leaving two dozen people dead.
