Fortifying diplomatic relations through cultural exchange

Photography exhibition and film screening on China's 61st anniversary

 Diplomatic relationship between countries is fortified through several means -- culture, tourism etc. Culture of a cosmopolitan city like Shanghai gets a close look as diplomatic relationship between People's Republic of China and People's Republic of Bangladesh is in focus.

Marking the 61st anniversary of People's Republic of China and 35 years of diplomatic relationship between China and Bangladesh, the Chinese Embassy in Dhaka has arranged a photography exhibition, titled "Experience Shanghai, Embrace the World".

The historic meeting of Bangabandhu with Mao Zedong, founder of modern China, as well as visits of other Bangladeshi leaders like Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina and Hussain Mohammad Ershad are also on display.

Prior to the inauguration, Councillor of the Chinese Embassy, Qian Kaifu welcomed all the guests and dignitaries at Poet Sufia Kamal Auditorium of the museum. Secretary-in-charge, Ministry of Cultural Affairs, Suraiya Begum and director general of National Museum Prokash Chandra Das spoke at a discussion presided over by

economy, arts, science and infrastructure is incredible. I believe and hope that the auspicious relationship between the two countries will get further boost in the days ahead through exchange of cultures, knowledge and more."

"We want China to enhance scholarships for Bangladeshi students," was a request from the cultural secretary of Bangladesh. In response to that, the Chinese Ambassador said, "Aside from providing regular scholarships, the Governor of Yunan province will offer 25 additional scholarships, and we will increase our scholarships to 100 in total, from next year. Besides education, we want to focus on other fields like arts, culture and strategic issues. I think people to people contact is very important in diplomatic relationship."

A 'Chinese Film Week' was also inaugurated at the same venue. Everyday two films will be screened at 11:30 am and 3 pm respectively, except Thursday. Two films -- "Tibet Today" and "Angel Vera" -- were screened yesterday. "The Ancient Chinese Treasures" and "Baseball Boys" will be screened today.

Performers in the costume of a Chinese dragon dancing to the rhythm of traditional percussions welcomed the guests.



Renowned Bangladeshi artists Syed Jahangir and Professor Rafiqun Nabi jointly inaugurated an installation exhibition, titled "Human Tower", yesterday at the Faculty of Fine Arts (FFA) premises on Dhaka University campus.
