One killed, 50 hurt as villagers clash with fish farm goons

At least 50 people were injured, including seven by bullets, in clashes between villagers and hired goons of a private fish farm at Chatra beel (water body) under Mithapukur and Pirganj upazilas yesterday.

The clash ensued over illegal construction of a dam on the water body by a private fish farm, villagers claimed.

The farm grabbed around 70 acres of the water body for fish cultivation, they said.

Upon receipt of complaints

from the locals of Chatra and its adjoining villages, land administration recently conducted an enquiry and found that the water body belongs to the government.

The enquiry also found that the fish farm illegally constructed the dam across the beel for fish cultivation.

The land department and district administration asked the farm to remove the dam and stop fish cultivation. The management of the farm did not pay heed to the notices of the authorities concerned, police sources said.

On Sunday, about 500 villagers removed the dam from the water body. But, the farm authority again started construction work of the dam yesterday afternoon, police

When the locals put up resistance against the construction of the dam, a series of clashes took place between villagers and hired goons of the fish farm that left at least 50 villagers injured. At one stage, the miscreants opened fire leaving seven people bullet-hit.

Locals alleged the proprietor of the farm grabbed the water body in 2004 for fish cultivation despite protests from locals.

Moinul Hoque, a villager of Chatra, said local administration backed the illegal grabbing during that period.

A schoolgirl was killed after rape in Habiganj on Sunday while another abducted in Thakurgaon was rescued by police the day before.

girl after rape at Baniagaon village in Bahubal upazila of Habiganj Sunday night. The deceased was identi-

fied as Shumi Akhter, 15, a JSC examinee of Mirpur Faizunnessa Girls' High School and daughter of Iman Ali of the village, reports our staff correspondent in Sylhet.

Police quoting family sources said Sumi went missing in the evening when she was returning to her house from a neighbour's house.

Later, locals found her body lying beside a graveyard only 100 yards of her house at night.

On information, police recovered the body and sent it to the upazila health complex

for autopsy.

Police later arrested four people including the son of Mirpur UP chairman in connection with the incident.

The arrestees are UP chairman's son Ruhel, Saddam, Jasimuddin and Sohel.

In Thakurgaon, a schoolgirl, who was kidnapped from her house at Jagannathpur village in Sadar upazila on November 14, was rescued on Saturday.

The victim was identified as Laboni Akter, 14, a student of class eight of RK State High School of the village. Police said Yusuf Ali, son of

Razzak Ali and his accomplice Dulu of nearby Khagarabari village coming in a motorbike kidnapped Laboni while she was alone at her house. On secret information,

police raided the house of Yusuf early Saturday morning and rescued the girl. Police later managed to arrest Yusuf.

A case was filed on this connection.

One person was beaten to death and another injured by locals at Char Shibrampur under Pabna Sadar upazila vesterday morning on charge of raping a girl after abduction.

The dead is Azibor Rahman, 40, while the injured is Abul Hasnat of Char Shibrampur.

Locals alleged that Azibor and his accomplices picked up the girl from their house at the village at around 8:00am. They took the girl to the sluice gate area, violated her and left the scene leaving the girl there, they added.

"Hearing the news, we caught Azibor and Hasnat and severely beat them up", locals said, adding that other members of the gang fled the village.

On information, police went to Char Shibrampur village and rescued Azibor and Hasnat. They took the two to Pabna General Hospital where

Azibor succumbed to his injuries. The law enforcers also rescued the girl and took her to the hospital.

The girl told officer-incharge of Pabna Sadar Police Station Md Mohosinuzzaman that a gang of four led by Azibor kidnapped her from their house at gunpoint, took her to the sluice gate area and raped her. A case was filed with the police station.

Refusing the allegation of rape of the girl, Azibor family said it was a pre-planed murder.

Azibor's father Md Wayez Sardar said Nurul and his men beat his son dead as he tried to prevent them from steeling trees from the embankment at the village a few days ago.

Police Pabna Superintendent Jahangir Hossain Matobbar said, "Different sources informed me that the murder was a sequel to a long standing feud between Azibor and Nurul." The matter is under investigation, he added.

BOMBING OF KUSHTIA MP'S HOUSE

Prime accused on 4-day remand

A Kushtia court yesterday granted four days' remand to Zahidul Islam Zahid, the prime accused of bomb attack inside the house of Awami League lawmaker Afaz Uddin Ahmed on the night of November 13.

Police produced Zahid in the Chief Judicial Magistrate's Court, seeking a seven-day remand. Judge Abdullah Al Mamun granted four days.

The bomb attack inside the house at Taragunia under Daulatpur upazila of Kushtia left three people killed and two others injured.

After the incident, Afaz Uddin's son Ejaz Ahmed filed two cases with Daulatpur Police Station---one under the Explosives Substances Act and the other for murder-accusing eight people, including Siddiqur Rahman and Ahadul Islam, who carried bombs to the lawmaker's house and were also killed in the blasts.

Police arrested Zahidul soon after the incident. Two other accused in the cases--Jamirul Islam Moru alias Boma Moru and Azharul Islam Mintu-- were later arrested.

Moru was arrested on Friday night at Walia village under Lalpur upazila of Natore district while Mitu on Saturday on

the confessional statement of Moru. During preliminary interrogation, Moru admitted to his involvement in the bomb attack, police said.

A BCL activist was killed and around 150 people were injured in the clashes.
