Oil edges up

Crude prices rebounded slightly in Asian trade on Wednesday, mirroring a small hop in the euro's value as cautious traders kept their eyes on tensions on the Korean peninsula, analysts said.
New York's main contract, light sweet crude for January, gained 46 cents to \$1.71 dollars.
Brent North Sea crude for delivery in January added 50 cents to \$3.75 dollars.
Slight gains in the euro's value were providing some cheer for crude dealers, said Tony Nunan, risk manager for Mitsubishi Corp in Tokyo.
'It could be just a bounce in the euro is causing a price back in crude oil bubbles,' he told AFP.
