44 Dinajpur mutineers arrested on court order

Forty-four of the 61 mutineers of Dinajpur-2 Rifles Battalion were yesterday arrested as per order of the special court-13 while charges against 42 rebels of Mymensingh Sector headquarters and 45 Rifles Battalion under the sector will be framed on January 15 next year.

Our Dinajpur correspondent reported that the special court, headed by Dinajpur Sector Commander Col Saleh Ahmad, started trial proceedings against 75 mutineers, including 17 of the sector headquarters, yesterday morning. Other members of the court are Lt Col Mahaful Alam and Major Didar Al Latif.

At the beginning, the complainant, Subedar Major Shamsul Alam of Dinajpur 2 Battalion, urged the court to issue arrest warrants against 44 other accused in the mutiny case that he filed in May last year. The court then ordered arrest of the accused.

After filing of the case in May last year, police arrested 31 mutineers of Dinajpur sector and 2 Rifles Battalion under the sector and sent them to jail. Of them, 17 are from the battalion while the rest 14 from the sector headquarters.

During the trial, JCO Enamul Haque of Pilkhana in the capital.

Dinajpur sector headquarters, pressed mutiny charges against 13 out of 14 accused. Five of the 75 accused, including one from the sector headquarters, will face trial at civil court.

Subedar Major Shamsul Alam told the court that 61 BDR members of Rifles Battalion-2 revolted against their officers on February 26 last year. They looted firearms and ammunition from armoury and fired blank shots.

The special court, set up at Dinajpur sector headquarters, adjourned trial proceedings until 10:00am today. Prosecutor Lt Col Ershad Hossain and Deputy Attorney General Biswajit Roy

In Mymensingh, the special-17 yesterday fixed January 15 next year to frame charges against 42 mutineers of Mymensingh Sector headquarters and 45 Rifles Battalion under the sector, reports our correspondent.

Prosecutors Major Ahmed Yusuf Jamil and Major Shakir Ahmed read out charges against the accused in the court.

They alleged that the accused BDR members took part in the mutiny on February 26, expressing solidarity with cognisance and asked the authorities the mutineers of BDR headquarters at

They took control of the sector and battalion headquarters, looted firearms and ammunition from armouries and fired blank shots, the prosecutors said.

The three-member court headed by Col Md Nazrul Islam Sarker, Kushtia sector commander, adjourned the trial proceedings of the case until January 15. Two other members are Lt Col Gazi Md Salah Uddin and Maj Mohammad Ashfaq Hossain.

Our Netrakona correspondent adds: The special court-17 yesterday read out the charge against 53 mutineers of 16 Rifles Battalion headquarters.

Headed by Kushtia Sector Commander Col Md Nazrul Islam Sarker, the court, set up at the battalion headquarters in Netrakona, started trial proceedings at noon. Two others members are Lt Col Gazi Md Salah Uddin and Major Ashfaq Hossain.

At the beginning, Major Mohammad Kamruzzaman Milon of the battalion brought charges against 53 BDR rebels. Lt Col Shamsuzzaman, commanding officer of the battalion, is the prosecutor, court sources said.

4 housewives murdered

Four housewives were murdered in Natore, Sylhet, Thakurgaon and Naogaon districts on Friday and Thursday.

In Natore, a housewife died instantly when a bullet accidentally pierced her throat while her husband was cleaning his revolver at his house at Rannoigari village in Lalpur upazila on Friday afternoon, reports our correspondent.

The deceased was identified as Arifa Khatun, 22, wife of alleged criminal Wasim, 28, of the same village. Arifa was admitted to a private clinic at Gopalpur where the doctors declared her dead.

Lalpur police arrested Wasim at midnight and recovered a revolver from him. The body was sent to hospital morgue

for autopsy. A case was filed against five people yesterday. In Sylhet, police recovered the hanging body of a housewife from her bedroom at

Shikarkha village in Jointapur upazila on The deceased was identified as

Kontina Begum, 26, wife of Mondol Mia of the same village, reports UNB.

Police said they recovered the body in the morning and sent it to hospital morgue for autopsy.

The victim's husband claimed that Kontina committed suicide following a family feud.

But Kontina's father Abdul Nur of the same village alleged that his daughter was killed by her in-laws following a brawl.

In Naogaon, police recovered the hanging body of a housewife from her bedroom at a rented house near Baludanga bus stand in the district town on Thursday night.

The deceased was identified as Shabana Begum, wife of police constable Fazlur Rahman, working in Naogaon Police Lines and hailed from Konabari village in Bagmara upazila of Rajshahi district.

Parents of Shabana alleged that her inlaws tortured her to death following a family feud and hanged the body to prove that she had committed suicide.

A housewife was beaten to death on Friday allegedly by her in-laws at Bojrapara village under Sadar upazila in Panchagarh.

The killers than hung her body from a beam of a room to prove it as a case of suicide, alleged relatives of the victim.

Police arrested victim's mother-in-law Rabeva Begum on charge of her involvement in the murder while other three members of the family including husband, father-in-law and brother-in-law went into hiding after the incident, reports our Thakurgaon correspondent.

Police said Rubaiya Sultana Rupia, 23, daughter of Sadequl Islam alias Debaru of Magura Senpara village under the same upazila was married to Anwarul Haque, 27, son of Mohimuddin of the same village about four years ago.

After her marriage she was tortured three on and often on trivial pretexts. On the fateful day Rubaiya was beaten to death by the members of her in-laws, according to the case statement.

Rubaiya's father Sadequl Islam filed a murder case accusing four persons including her husband Anwarul Haque, 27, father-in-law Mohimuddin, brotherin-law Hasibul and mother-in-law Rabeya Begum.

Ruling party men beat up journo, student

In Manikganj, a journalist was beaten up by ruling party cadres at Singair Bazar on Friday night, reports our correspondent.

Witnesses said, AL cadres numbering 6-7 including Monju, 28, son of Abdul Monnaf of Purba Basta village and Salam, 45, son of Minaj Uddin of Dhalla village of Singair upazila, attacked Mobarak with iron rods and sharp weapons at around 10:30pm at Singair bazar where

he was talking with a man. Mobarak was taken to Singair Clinic Diagnostic Centre with head injury.

Tusher Kumer Barman, a doctor of the clinic, said Mobarak received serious head injury. He was given six stitchings in his head.
