Russian 'spy' found in UK parliament

A Russian woman working in parliament is to be deported after security services arrested her on suspicion of espionage, The Sunday Times reported.

MI5 decided that Katia Zatuliveter, 25, who works for Mike Hancock, a Liberal Democrat member of the House of Commons defence select committee, was secretly working for the Russian intelligence service as a "sleeper", the paper reported.

The arrest is believed to be the first time since the end of the Cold War that someone working in parliament has been accused of spying for Russia.

The newspaper said MI5 believes the attractive Zatuliveter was deliberately targeting Hancock, 64, who has a strong interest in Russia. Hancock dismissed allega-

"She is not a Russian spy. I know nothing about espionage, but she has been subjected to a deportation order. She is appealing it, because she feels -- quite rightly -- that she has done nothing wrong," he told the Press Association.

A spokesman for the Home Office, said: "We do not routinely comment on individual cases."

Zatuliveter, who underwent security vetting before taking up her job, was arrested by police and immigration officials last week and is being held at a secure facility awaiting deportation to Russia.

The move to deport her comes after she was stopped while re-entering Britain at Gatwick airport in August. Before releasing her, security officials questioned her in depth about her work for Hancock, the report said.

A source told The Sunday Times: "Her presence here is not considered to be conducive to national security. There was unhappiness about what she could have access to. The intention is to show her the door."

Abbas: As a last resort, I'll ask Israel to take over


Palestinian President Mahmoud Abbas has warned he may dissolve his self-rule government and ask Israel to resume full control of the West Bank if troubled peace talks fail.

Dismantling the Palestinian Authority would be a last resort, Abbas told Palestine TV in an interview broadcast late Friday. However, his comments marked the most explicit warning yet that he's considering a step that could crush lingering hopes for a Mideast peace deal.

If Abbas were to take such a step, Israel, as a military occupier, would have to assume full responsibility again for 2.2 million Palestinians in the West Bank. Israel was relieved of that financial burden with the establishment of the Palestinian Authority in 1994, as part of interim peace deals.

Still, Abbas might face considerable domestic opposition to dismantling the Palestinian Authority, since it employs some 150,000 Palestinians, a large chunk of the work force.

The Palestinian self-rule government, which receives hundreds of millions of dollars a year in foreign aid, has limited authority over 40 percent of the war-won West Bank, while Israel

has final say over the entire area and exclusive control over 60 percent of the land.

Palestinian leaders currently are threatening to quit peace talks with Israel unless it freezes construction in the West Bank and east Jerusalem. Israel so far has refused to do so.

Abbas has said that if peace negotiations collapse, the Palestinians might seek unilateral UN recognition of a state in the West Bank, Gaza and east Jerusalem, territories Israel captured in the 1967 Mideast War.

If all efforts fail, Abbas said, "I will tell the Americans and the Israelis, come and put an end to all this. I can't continue like this. We have an occupation and we don't. No, keep it all and release me (from my responsibility)." On Saturday, Netanyahu called Abbas to thank him for send

ing members of the Palestinian civil defense to help fight a major fire that is devouring much of the Carmel Forest in northern Israel. It was a rare instance of personal contact after weeks of silence between the two leaders.

Also Saturday, Abbas' interior minister ordered the closure of a satellite TV station co-owned by Mohammed Dahlan, a former confidant of the Palestinian leader.

Two 'presidents' claim power in Ivory Coast standoff

Two men crowned themselves president in Ivory Coast's bloody election dispute Saturday as Laurent Gbagbo defied international calls for him to cede power.

As Gbagbo's allies hung the chain of office around his neck at a ceremony, exprime minister Alassane Ouattara, backed as election winner by the United Nations, swore himself in as president in a handwritten letter.

The bizarre standoff unfolded amid reports of more deadly violence and urgent calls from world powers for a peaceful resolution to the disputed election, meant to end a decade of conflict in the west African country.

UN-certified results from last Sunday's run-off vote showed Ouattara as the winner, but Gbagbo's high court allies overturned them by annulling allegedly rigged ballots in parts of the north, his rival's stronghold.

The United Nations, the European Union and others have recognised Ouattara as Ivory Coast's new president.



Iran declares

Iran said it will use domestically produced uranium concentrates for the first time at a key nuclear facility yesterday, signalling determination to push ahead with its atomic work a day before talks with world powers.

The move appeared designed to show that Iran will not back down in a longrunning dispute over its nuclear program ahead of the December 6-7 meeting in Geneva.

Iran says its nuclear program is aimed at power generation but the West suspects Tehran wants to make atom bombs.

Iran's nuclear energy chief, Ali Akbar Salehi, said the Islamic state was making rapid technological progress, despite tougher sanctions introduced by the United Nations and the West.

"No matter how much effort they put into their sanctions and in creating all sorts of hindrances our nuclear activities will proceed," he told a televised news conference.

Egypt holds parliament run-offs

Egypt held runoff parliamentary elections yesterday that are certain to hand President Hosni Mubarak's ruling party a crushing victory after the two main opposition groups decided to boycott in protest of alleged fraud in the first round.

With a large-scale crackdown that included arrest sweeps, Egypt's ruling establishment appeared determined to purge the largest opposition group, the fundamentalist Muslim Brotherhood, from the next legislature. The aim seems to be to ensure the Brotherhood cannot use parliament as a platform for dissent amid uncertainty over the country's future and in the lead-up to next year's more crucial presidential elections.

Both the Brotherhood and the other key opposition group, the liberal Wafd party, boycotted Sunday's runoffs.

Assange to fight Swedish charges checks

Wikileaks founder Julian Assange will fight any attempts to take him to Sweden to face rape allegations, his lawyer has told the BBC.

Mark Stephens said legal moves against his client seem(ed) to be a political stunt by a 'lickspittle state' that allowed US rendition flights.

Swedish authorities issued an arrest warrant for Assange on Thursday.

The move comes amid the phased release of some 250,000 cables - US diplomatic secret messages - by his website.

The warrant to interview the journalist - thought currently to be in the UK - concerns alleged sexual crimes during a visit to Sweden in August.

POLITICALLY MOTIVATED

But Stephens told the BBC's Andrew Marr that the entire case against Assange had been dropped by Sweden's chief prosecutor in September.

He said it was only "after the intervention of a Swedish politician" that a new prosecutor in Gothenburg - not Stockholm, where his client and two women had been - began a new case.

It resulted in the current warrants, and an Interpol notice being issued. His client denies the allegations.

Stephens said: "It does seem to be a political stunt. "A warrant was issued on Thursday by reports. We've asked for it. We've been ignored at this point."

He said he and his Swedish legal adviser had been trying to NZZamSonntagnewspaper. contact prosecutors since August and his client had tried to meet prosecutors to "restore his good name".

It said that the Saudis had made "significant progress" under US pressure to deal with the issue, especially disrupting al-Qaeda's sources of money in Saudi Arabia.

However, it added, "Riyadh has taken only limited action" to interrupt the flow of money to Taliban and LeT-associated groups . which have launched attacks in Afghanistan, Pakistan and India.

The same memo said Gulf states remain important sources of . financing for Islamist militant groups, singling out Qatar as "the worst in the region" in its overall level of cooperation with Washington in "counter-terror" issues.

. The Swiss Post Office said yesterday that it was carrying out checks on Wikileaks founder Julian Assange's account with its banking arm, after doubts emerged over the Swiss address he gave.

Wikileaks has advertised . the PostFinance account details online to donate directly to the Julian Assange and other WikiLeaks Staff · Defence Fund," giving an account name of "Assange Julian Paul, Geneve."

"We have to find out if Julian Assange really does live in Geneva. In the process of . checking we did not find his name in Geneva," PostFinance spokesman Marc Andrey told · AFP, confirming a report in the

Andrey said checks were likely to take several weeks and would involve correspondence with Assange, an Australian citizenwhoiscurrentlyinhiding.

He explained that bank accounts were normally granted to Swiss residents or foreigners from areas nearby. But for people from more distant countries such as

Australia or the United States, they must have some kind of relationship with Switzerland, suchas businessties or ahouse. Andrey declined to give further details on the account,
