RU to remember martyrdom of 3 teachers today

Rajshahi University (RU) will recall today the sacrifices of three RU teachers who embraced martyrdom during the Liberation War.

On the occasion of Martyred Intellectuals' Day today the university authorities have chalked out elaborate programmes including placing wreaths at graveyards, rally, discussion and Qurankhwani.

Following a series of historic events from 1952, the country achieved its independence in 1971 through supreme sacrifices made by thousands of people. RU had its own share of sacrifices. The university was attacked on the dark night of March 25 by Pakistani army like many different places of the country.

The people on the campus came to the aid of the then East Pakistan Rifles (EPR), police and freedom fighters who were fighting against the Pakistani army. The occupation army killed RU mathematics department teacher Prof Habibur Rahman, sanskrit department teacher Prof Sukhranjan Samaddar and psychology department teacher Prof Mir Abdul Kayum during the Liberation War.

Prof Habibur Rahman, famed for his voice against wrongs, directly took part in protest against the atrocities of Pakistani army in March 1971. He stayed on the campus with his family although most of the residents left the campus when Pak army attacked the area.

He kept regular contact with the Mukti Rahim (freedom fighters) and Bangali members of the then East Pakistan Rifles (EPR). On April 15, Pak soldiers led by Brig

Aslam and Col Taj picked him up from his house and took him to Jubery Bhaban on the university campus.

The building was used as Pakistan army's 'concentration camp and torture centre'. Prof Habibur Rahman never returned nor was his body found.

Prof Sukhranjan Samaddar gave shelter to a tired EPR soldier at his house for a night. Getting the information, Pak army searched the house on April 14.

Failing to find the EPR man, the Pakistan soldiers took Prof Samaddar to Jubery Bhaban. A RU psychology department teacher, who worked as a collaborator of the occupation forces, identified him (Prof Samaddar) as a Hindu.

Later his body was found at a mass grave adjacent to the university near Binodpur Bazar.

On the night to November 25 in 1971, Pak soldiers picked up Prof Mir Abdul Kayum from his father-in-law's house at Goramara in the city with the help of a university staff.

His body with slit throat was found at a mass grave on the bank of Padma river on December 30.

'Name Pabna Medical College after Dr Rabbi'

The people of Pabna district have reiterated their demand for naming Pabna Medical College after the name of martyred intellectual Dr Fazle Rabbi, a glorious son of the district.

Dr Rabbi, a professor of Dhaka Medical College and an organiser of the Liberation War, borepurd martyrdom only a couple of days before the final victory on December 16 in 1971.

As per the blueprint of Pakistan occupation forces, their local collaborators picked up a number of intellectuals including Dr Rabbi and brutally murdered them at Rayer Bazar and Mirpur killing grounds.

Dr Rabbi's body was later found at Rayer Bazar.

Martyred Intellectual Dr Fazle Rabbi Smrity Parishad in Pabna has organised day long programmes in the district headquarters today.

"Dr Fazle Rabbi sacrificed his life for independence of the country. But no remarkable step has been taken to keep his memory alive in Pabna, home town of



Dr Rabbi during the 39 years of independence," said Prof Md Moshir Rahman, convener of Dr Fazle Rabbi Smrity Parishad in Pabna.

Dr Fazle Rabbi Foundation formed in 1995 demanded naming Pabna Medical College after the name of Dr Rabbi when Pabna Medical College was established in 2007.

Besides, over one hundred people from different professions submitted a memorandum to the health ministry and the planning ministry demanding naming Pabna Medical College after the martyred intellectual's name last year, said Zinat Ara, chairman of Dr Fazle Rabbi foundation.

But the file is still waiting

at the health ministry for approval, she said.

Dr Fazle Rabbi was born on September 21 in 1932 at Chhatiani village in Pabna Sadar upazila. He passed the SSC in 1948 from Pabna Zila School and HSC from Dhaka College in 1950 with outstanding results.

He passed MBBS in 1955, scoring the best result in the country and achieved gold medal from Dhaka University for it.

Later he went to England for higher study and after getting the MRCP degree, he joined Hammersmith Hospital in England as senior registrar.

Dr Rabbi returned to the country in 1963 and joined Dhaka Medical College as an associate professor. Urged by the desire to serve the ailing humanity, he contributed greatly in bringing qualitative change in medical service at that period.

As Dr Rabbi helped the freedom fighters in different ways, the Pakistan occupation authorities kept him under their watch and finally killed him with the help of their local collaborators.

Dinajpur, Sirajganj were freed on this day

Dinajpur and its nearest upazila Biral were freed from the clutches of Pakistani occupation army on this day in 1971.

On December 14 in 1971, valiant freedom fighters hoisted the flag of independent Bangladesh in the upazila town after a nine-month fierce fighting with the Pakistan army.

The Pakistani forces left the district headquarters on this day and the freedom fighters entered the town and burnt Pakistani national flags chanting slogans.

As the news spread, people from the adjacent villages came to the upazila town and rejoiced by chanting slogans 'Joy Bangla' with the freedom fighters.

On March 25 in 1971, the Pakistani forces launched a crackdown on the upazila with the help of its Bangladeshi collaborators.

After the declaration of independence by Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur

Rahman on March 7, the freedom fighters along with the villagers formed a protection committee with an aim to keep the district free from any chaos by the Pakistani forces.

But the Bangladeshi collaborators provoked the Pakistani hyenas to carry out arson attacks, looting and killings of innocent people. The massacre also forced many people to leave the district for safer places as well as seeking refuge in India.

On April 22 morning in 1971, the Pakistani troops shelled heavily from different points and entered the upazila.

The occupation forces with the help of their collaborators conducted massive searches at the houses of the district town, looted valuables and tortured and raped women and young girls.

As cruelty by Pakistani forces and their collaborators climaxed, the freedom fighters made several attacks on them.

The fierce fighting intensified further as the Indian forces joined the freedom

fighters forcing the Pakistani army to retreat.

On this day in 1971, freedom fighters also cheered victory when they took control of the Sirajganj district town after defeating the Pakistani occupation forces in a fierce battle, reports a correspondent.

On the night of December 13, several groups of freedom fighters led by Mozaffar Hossain, Amir Hossain Bhulu, Shajahan Ali Tara, Aminul Islam Choudhury, Ismail Hossain, Golam Kibria, Ismail Hossain-2, Ishak Ali besieged the strategic points around the town, including Rahamatganj, Mirpur and the bank of Jumuna adjacent to Launch Ghat.

A fierce battle ensued when the valiant freedom fighters launched attacks on the Pakistani soldiers, forcing them to retreat.

In the late hours of that night the Pakistani soldiers gathered at Sirajganj Bazar railway station and left the town for Ishwardi by a train.
