# 166 aspirants for mayor, 1190 for councillor posts in Rangpur divn

As many as 166 mayor aspirants and 1190 councillor candidates filed nomination papers on Monday to contest the election scheduled for January 12 in 17 out of 22 municipalities of Rangpur division.

**Panchagarh:** Three people submitted nomination papers for the mayoral post while 46 for councillor posts in nine wards and 12 for reserved seats for women. The mayor aspirants are Abdul Kader, Md Touhidul Islam and Md Johirul Islam.

**Thakurgaon:** Five people submitted nomination papers for the mayoral post while 66 for councillor posts in 12 wards and 17 for women reserved seats.

The mayor candidates are SM Moyeen, Md Masud, SM Solaiman Ali Sarker, Choudhury Mohammad Golam Sarwar Ranju and Aminul Islam Kalam.

**Ranisangkoil (Takurgaon):** Six people submitted nomination papers for the mayoral post of the municipality. They are Mokhlesur Rahman, Sirajud Dowla, Alamgir Sarker, Khandaker Abdul Haque, Mohammad Toha and Tajul Islam. Forty-two people submitted nomination papers for councillor posts in nine wards while 13 for the reserved seats.

**Pirganj (Takurgaon):** Four people submitted nomination papers for the mayoral post while 34 for councillor posts in nine wards and eight for the reserved seats. The mayor aspirants are Anwar Hossain, Mujibur Rahman, Esrafil Haque and Golam Mostafa.

**Nilphamari:** seven people submitted nomination papers for the mayoral post of the municipality while 37 for councillor posts and nine for the reserved seats for woman. AKM Aminul Hoque, Anisur Rahman, Anuzzaman Hossain, Dewan Kamal Ahmed, Zahurul Alam, Khairul Alam and Abu Helal will contest the election as mayor candidates.

**Sayedpur (Nilphamari):** Eleven people filed nomination papers for the mayoral post while 91 for councillor posts in 15 wards and 27 for the reserved seats. The mayor candidates are Shaheen Akter, Sakhawat Hossain, Abdur Rahman, Hitler Choudhury, Amjad Hossain Sarker, Zakir Hossain Talukder, Jobeydul Islam Biplob, Tahmid Islam, Akhter Hossain Badal, Siddiqui and Joyanal Abedeen.

**Jaldhaka (Nilphamari):** Seven people submitted nomination papers for the mayoral post of the municipality. They are Anwarul Kabir Choudhury, Abdul Wahed Bahadur, Azizul Huq, Ilias Hossain, Harunur Rashid, Moinul Islam and Mokbul Hossain. Fifty-three people filed nominations for councillor posts while 13 for the reserved seats for women.

**Lalmonirhat:** Five people submitted nomination papers for the post of mayor while 53 for councillor posts and 12 for the reserved seats. Those are contesting the poll for the mayoral post are Reazul Islam Rintu, Abdur Rashid, Chittaranjan Roy, Mosharrar Hossain Rana and Hafizur Rahman Babla.

**Patgram (Lalmonirhat):** Five people

filed nominations for the mayoral post while 38 for councillor posts and nine for the reserved seats. AKM Mostafa, Salauzzaman, Mofizur Rahman, Shamsur Ali, Anisur Rahman and Morshed Alam are mayor candidates.

**Kurigram:** Nine people submitted nomination papers for the mayoral post of the municipality while 66 for councillor posts and 18 for the reserved seats. The mayor aspirants are Noor Islam, Abu Baker Siddique, Majidul Alam, Mokhlesul Gazi, Sakhawat Hossain Biplob, Abdul Jalil, Kazul Islam, Touhidul Islam and Yasin Ali Sarker.

**Nageshwari (Kurigram):** Ten people filed nominations for the mayoral post of the municipality while 62 for councillor posts and 19 for the reserved seats for women. Golam Rasul, Fazlul Haque, Mohammad Hossain Ali, Abdul Kashem Sarker, Abdus Sabur Abdur Rahman Mia, Abdur Rob, Mossadek Hossain, Hossain Ali Sarker and Roushan Alam are contesting the poll for the post of mayor.

**Ulipur (Kurigram):** Twelve people filed nominations for the mayoral post of the municipality. They are Sajedur Rahman, Shafiqul Hossain, Abdul Quddus, AKM Shafiqul Islam, Haider Ali Mia, Abdullah Ali, Abu Sayeed Sarker, Abdur Hamid Sarker, Rakibul Islam, Saifur Rahman, Mokhlesur Rahman and Golam Mstafa. Sixty-three people submitted nominations for councillor posts while 17 for the reserved seats.

**Gaibandha:** Seven people filed

nominations for the mayoral post while 61 for councillor posts and 19 for the reserved seats. The mayor candidates are Anwarul Islam Sabuj, Shah Shariful Islam, Masud Zakir, Shahad Hossain, Momtazur Rahman, Shamsul Alam, Hamidul Haque and Wahiduzzaman Titu.

**Gobindaganj (Gaibandha):** Six people submitted nomination papers for the mayoral post while 47 for councillor posts and 13 for the reserved seats. The mayor candidates are Nazmul Hossain Muktur Rahman, Abdul Motin Molla Mossadek Ali, Faruque Ahmed and Atiur Rahman Sarker.

**Sundarganj (Gaibandha):** Six people filed nominations for the mayoral post of the municipality while 38 for councillor posts and 11 for the reserved seats. Md Nurunnabi, Badul Majid Mondol, ATM Masudul Islam, Md Abdullah, AKM Fakhrul Islam and Sahadat Hossain are contesting the poll for the post of mayor.

**Baderganj (Rangpur):** Seven people submitted nominations for the mayoral post while 38 for councillor posts and 13 for the reserved seats. The mayor candidates are Monabbar Hossain, Hena Mohammad Ferdous, Kamal Lohani, Sarwar Jahan Manik, Anwarul Haque, Azizul Hoque and Uttam Kumar Saha

**Haragachha (Rangpur):** Seven people filed nominations for the mayoral post of the municipality. They are Nazrul Islam, Ershadul Haque, Monwar Hossain, Jamil Akter, Shahadat Hossain Jhantu, Saiful Islam, and Shafiqul Alam.

# 85 houses, two jute godowns gutted

At least 85 houses were gutted in fire incidents on Sunday at different villages under Sadar upazila of the district.

Fire fighters and locals said, on Sunday evening at about 7:00pm, fire broke out at a kitchen of Shafiruddin's house at Khalpara village under Sadar upazila. Soon it engulfed the adjacent 41 houses.

On information, fire fighters rushed to the spot and brought the fire under control after an hour long frantic efforts with the help of local people.

The house owners claimed the fire damaged properties worth about 20 lakh while the fire fighters estimated the loss

at Tk 4 lakh.

In the second incident at about 7:30pm, fire at Shahapara village in Thakurgaon municipal area gutted four houses.

In third incident at about 10:30pm, fire originated from the kitchen of Rafiqul Islam at Paikpara village under Sadar upazila and gutted 40 adjacent houses.

The house owners said the fire damaged properties worth Tk 25 lakh while the fire fighters estimated the loss at Tk 4 lakh.

In Magura, a devastating fire gutted two jute godowns and 12 shops at Khamarpara bazaar in Sreepur upazila on Saturday night.

Local people said the fire originated from an electric short circuit at a shop at about

11pm and soon engulfed the adjacent 11 shops and the two godowns.

On information, fire fighters rushed to the spot and doused the fire with the help of local people.

The fire affected businessmen claimed that cash and valuables worth Tk 1 crore were gutted in the blaze.

Another report from Joypurhat adds: Fire gutted two shops at Shalapur bazaar in Panchbibi upazila on Saturday night.

Witnesses said the fire originated from an electric short circuit at about 11:30pm and soon gutted a medicine shop and a grocery shop of the bazaar.

Fire fighters, on information, rushed to the spot and extinguished the blaze.

## Man murdered by 'wife'

A man was strangled allegedly by his wife and her lover at village Panchol in Kalaroa upazila Sunday night. Police arrested Shapla Begum, 32 for her alleged involvement in the killing. Victim Nur Mohammad, 42, was son of Abdul Khaleque of the village. Quoting local people police said, Shapla Begum fell in love with Kabir Hossain of the same village two years ago. As Nur Mohammad protested, they threatened him of dire consequences, police said. On the fateful night, Shapla and her lover Kabir Hossain strangled Nur Mohammad. Locals found the body of the victim lying in the room and informed police. Police arrested Shapla but failed to arrest Kabir as he went into hiding.

## 20 hurt as boiler explodes

Twenty people were injured and eight houses and four shops were gutted following explosion in a chemical factory at Bottola in Fatulla on Monday afternoon. Police said, boiler of Bhai Bhai Chemical Factory exploded with a bang creating panic in Bottola area at 12:30pm. Fire spread to adjacent eight houses and four shops following explosion, burning 20 people including the members of the houses and shops and passers-by. Owner of the factory Firoz Ahmed along with officials and workers went into hiding following the explosion. On information, fire fighting units from Mandalpara rushed to the spot and doused the flames. All the injured were admitted to Khanpur 200-bed hospital. Preliminary estimation puts the property loss at Tk 15 lakh.

## Muggers take away Tk 4.5 lakh

Armed muggers shot and wounded a transport official and robbed Tk 4.5 lakh at Shimrail, Siddirganj on Monday. Tamijuddin Tamij, 55, manager of Khawja Garib-e-Newaj Transport, wounded by bullet in the leg, was admitted to local Maa General Hospital. Tamij said he withdrew Tk 5 lakh from Dutch Bangla Bank at Hajee Ibrahim Khalil Shopping Complex, Shmrail, at about noon. Five armed muggers riding motorbikes were waiting in front of the bank. When he was passing by, the muggers snatched away the bag full of money. As he raised a hue and cry, the muggers fired two gunshots, one hitting his leg, and scaring away the people. During the incident, a bundle of Tk 50,000 fell down, which he collected later.

## 'Suicide' in Sylhet

A diabetic patient, who allegedly took poison Friday in a bid to commit suicide, died at Sylhet Osmani Medical College Hospital Saturday morning. The deceased was identified as Anwar Ali, 45, son of late Abdul Mosabbir of Purba Talipara village in Balaganj upazila. Family sources said Anwar had been suffering from diabetes since long. Recently the disease aggravated and he took poison Friday night as he could not bear any more the extreme physical pain. He was rushed to the hospital where he died early Saturday morning. A UD case was filed in this connection.

# 4 boys, girls murdered

Four boys and girls were murdered in Habiganj, Bagerhat, Rajshahi and Manikganj districts on Monday and the day before.

Body of a schoolboy was recovered from a canal in Madhabpur upazila in Habiganj on Monday afternoon, reports our staff correspondent in Sylhet.

The boy, identified as Niloy Chakravarty, 14, was a student of class eight in Awliabad High School and son of Ranjit Chakravarty of village Borhanpur.

Police, quoting family members, said Niloy went missing since he took Tk 500 from his mother and went to the nearby Mantala bazaar Sunday afternoon.

Getting a phone call at about 2:00 pm a police team, headed by ASP Sugyan Chakma and others from the Madhabpur PS, recovered the body from a canal near Boalia bridge.

They also arrested one Liton Paul, son of Mukunda Paul of the same village as a suspect.

The body bore marks of injuries, a police official said, terming it a case of killing.

In Begerhat, police recovered body of a schoolgirl from the bank of Kumarkhali Canal under Mongla upazila, reports our staff correspondent in Khulna.

The girl, identified as Jyotsna Khatun, 12, was the only daughter of Shahidul Islam of Kumarkhali village under the same upazila.

A student of class three of

Khanjahan Ali Registered Primary School at Mongla, Jyotsna had been missing since she came out of her house in the evening of December 11 last, said her father.

Police, quoting the autopsy report, said that the schoolgirl was killed after rape.

A five-year-old girl was strangled allegedly by neighbours due to previous enmity with her parents at Kholabona village of Poba upazila in Rajshahi on Sunday night, reports our staff correspondent.

The girl went 'missing' Sunday morning after she went to attend a mosque-based mass education class in the village.

Police recovered the body of Amina Khatun Boishakhi from Kholabona eidgah at around 9pm after locals located it following confession of three neighbours.

Police later arrested the three -- teenager Rozina Khatun, her parents Korban Ali and Sagori Begum Tia of the same village.

They confessed to police that they strangled Boishakhi to death and hit her with brick before hiding her body under stack of fodder at the field.

Victim's father Abdul Alim lodged a case with Poba police station against the three.

Sub inspector Nazrul Islam, who is investigating the case, said Rozina stole a cell phone of Alim about one and a half years ago.

Rozina and her family members were angry at Alim as they were forced to return

the mobile phone through a village arbitration, he said.

The culprits caught Boishakhi at around 10am when she was returning home from the village mosque and later killed her at night, he added.

In Manikganj, students of Farirchar Dakhil Madrasa in Sadar upazila brought out a procession and held rally on Monday demanding arrest and punishment of the killers of their fellow student Shariful Islam.

The students brought out a procession at around 1.00pm from the madrasa premises and paraded the local areas. After the procession, they held the rally on the madrasa premises. Local people also joined the programmes.

The rally demanded immediate arrest and exemplary punishment to those who stabbed Shariful Islam, 15, a Dakhil examinee and son of Md. Rezaul Karim of Barta village.

Sub Inspector of Manikganj Sadar police station and investigating officer (IO) Saiful Islam said Selim, 42, son of Rohiz Uddin of the village and some of his accomplices stabbed the madrasa student Shariful at around 3.00pm on Sunday at Madhabpur Government Primary School premises where he went to play carom.

They also stabbed his brother Shahinur when he came to save Shariful. The two brothers were immediately taken to Manikganj Sadar Hospital for treatment where the on-duty doctor declared Shariful dead, the IO said.
