

# Rajon, Asif charged with killing Natore college teacher

A charge sheet against the two accused of murder of Mizanur Rashid was submitted yesterday noon to a Natore magistrate's court. Mizanur, a district college teacher, had been killed for protesting stalking of his college students.

Abdur Rahim, sub-inspector of Bagatipara Police Station and also investigation officer of the murder case, submitted the charge sheet against Abdul Awal Rajon and

Mamunur Rashid Asif.

Mizanur, a chemistry teacher of Lokmanpur College in Bagatipara upazila of the district, sustained severe injuries to the head and other parts of the body on October 12 when Rajon and Asif on their motorbikes ran into Mizanur and struck him with an iron rod, according to the charge sheet.

Mamunur Rashid, elder brother of the victim, filed a case accusing Asif and Rajon with the police station on October 15.

After fighting for life for 12 days, Mizanur died at Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujib Medical University (BSMMU) Hospital.

Meanwhile, police on October 20 arrested the main accused of the case Asif, and after eight days of that Rajon was arrested from Chakrampur of Natore town. They are now in jail.

The victim's widow, Razia Sultana Mili on December 15 was appointed to Baneshwar Degree College as a lecturer of political science.

## Rajshahi had to wait two more days to taste freedom

Although the nation achieved the final victory over Pakistan occupation forces on December 16 in 1971, the people of Rajshahi had to wait two more days to get the real taste of freedom.

On December 17 in 1971, the Pakistani forces withdrew from different important points of the town as well as the cantonment and took shelter at their strategic camp set up at Shaheed Shamsuzzoha Hall of Rajshahi University.

The freedom fighters were still to enter the town.

However, thousands of people started taking to streets.

On the night of December 17, the Pakistani forces fled to Natore where they surrendered to the Indian allied forces on December 20.

On December 18 morning, the townspeople captured the last camp of Pakistani forces at Shamsuzzoha Hall.

They rescued a number of injured people including many tortured women from there.

On March 3 in 1971, the local people started fighting with Pakistani forces. On March 28, the occupation forces killed a number of policemen at Rajshahi Police Lines for their refusal to surrender arms.

The freedom fighters under leadership of the then Captain Giasuddin Chowdhury and Captain Rashid started resisting the occupation army, forcing them to remain confined to Rajshahi cantonment for 10 days from April 3 and 13.

On April 13, a large contingent of Pakistani army from Dhaka broke the freedom fighters' resistance. During the following months, the occupation forces committed massacre and torture on freedom-loving people.

After December 18, locals found out a number of mass graves around Rajshahi town and in different upazilas of the area.

Muktijoddha Sanghati Parishad and Muktijoddha Command Council organised various programmes including discussions, photo exhibitions and cultural functions.

## ALLEGED ASSAULT ON FELLOW BY LAWMAKER

# Aditimari college teachers on indefinite class boycott

Teachers and students of Aditimari Degree College began an indefinite class boycott yesterday protesting alleged assault on a teacher of the college by the managing committee president.

Seventy-five teachers and 33 staffs of the college held a protest rally on the college campus yesterday morning and decided to go for class boycott.

They also demanded removal of managing committee chief Muzibor Rahman, also Jatiya Party (JP) lawmaker from the college committee.

"The college teachers and staffs of Aditimari Degree College have given three days' ultimatum to the lawmaker for resigning from the managing committee president post, otherwise, we will go for tougher programme after the deadline," said college teacher Ramzan Ali.

According to several other college teachers, Muzibor Rahman beat up Rezwan Uddin Mintu, associate professor of marketing department of the college, at

his residence in presence of local people on December 15 last.

Mintu went to Muzibor's house as the lawmaker called him for discussing some issues relating to managing committee of Chandrupur School and College in Aditimari upazila.

There was a long-standing family feud over forming managing body of Chandrupur School and College and for this the lawmaker beat up Mintu, the college teachers said.

"Without discussing a single word the lawmaker Muzibor Rahman started to beat me in his house at Aditimari town, where at least 50 local people were present at noon on December 15. The lawmaker also threatened to remove me from job," said Rezwan Uddin Mintu.

"I have already sent a written allegation in this regard to the ministry concerned and local administration on December 15," he said.

When contacted over mobile phone, the lawmaker yesterday denied the allegation and said Rezwan Uddin Mintu and his aides had been disturbing him over

forming managing committee of Chandrupur School and College.

"Rezwan Uddin Mintu along with 15/18 unknown people came to my house on December 15 for begging pardon as he was shown caused by the principal of Aditimari Degree College recently and the college authority was preparing to suspend him for his long absence in the college," the lawmaker said.

The lawmaker further said that Mintu was trying to tarnish his image after failing to win his heart.

Contacted, principal of Aditimari Degree College Azizar Rahman told this correspondent that his office show caused the college teacher as per the decision of the managing committee. The principal, however, denied preparing to suspend the teacher.

Meanwhile, lawmaker Muzibor Rahman said the managing committee of the college will take action against the teachers and staffs who boycotted classes after discussing the matter with the principal.

# 2 jailed for arranging child marriage, one for stalking

Two people were jailed for arranging child marriage while another was for stalking a schoolgirl in Sylhet and Jhenidah districts on Wednesday.

Our Staff correspondent from Sylhet reported that the marriage of Soheli Ahmed, 24, of Keuthaor village under Kanaighat upazila was set to be solemnised with Rahena Begum, 13, daughter of Haris Uddin of the neighbouring village on November 24.

On information, upazila Nirbahi Officer Matul Islam Chowdhury and women affairs officer Afsar Ali Mondol went to the villages and forced the families of the two to stop the illegal marriage.

On the following day, the families of

Soheli, also an expatriate in Dubai, and Rehena, a class six student, went to Sylhet city and made an affidavit showing the girl's age over 18 and registered their marriage.

Hearing the news, UNO Matul Islam Chowdhury, also nirbahi (executive) magistrate, summoned the groom and the bride's father to appear in his court on December 15. Accordingly, the two, Soheli and Haris, appeared in the court that awarded them 15 days' imprisonment and fined them Tk 500, in default they are suffer three more days in jail.

In Jhenidah, a mobile court on Wednesday night sentenced a youth to 10 months' imprisonment for stalking a girl in he town, reports our correspondent.

The convict is Rubel, son of Atiar Rahman

of Hamdah Sheikh Para in the district town. Nirbahi Magistrate Sajebr Rahman pronounced the verdict at 10:30pm.

Officer-in-Charge (OC) Iqbal Bahar of Sadar Police Station said Rubel went to the house of Rokhsana, a final year student of Jhenidah Polytechnic Institute, in the same area on Wednesday night and proposed her to marry him.

As Rokhsana, daughter of Liakat Ali, refused to accept the proposal, Rubel tried to drag her out the house. He also assaulted Rokhsana's two neighbours who came to help her.

On information, police rushed to the spot, arrested Rubel and produced him before the mobile court headed by the nirbahi magistrate. After hearing, the court sentenced Rubel to jail.

Barisal Government Girls' School was established in 1923 on about three acres of land. The number of students of the institution now stands at 2,500.
