

In a Water Wonderland

Masuma Pia's solo photo exhibit at Drik

An eight-day solo photography exhibition opened on December 17 at Drik Gallery, Dhaka. With the title, "Immersed in Water", the exhibition features Masuma Pia's 51 striking images that have taken her eight long years of hard work. Director General of Bengal Foundation Luva Nahid Chowdhury with others inaugurated the exhibition.

Pia's second solo exhibition makes the viewers dip into the eternal bliss of watery serenity.

Entering the gallery, the viewer cannot help but be fascinated with the poetic titles of the transparent watery arts by Pia. Some are eloquent: "...From early on, from the time I began to fathom, I was aware of the volatile relations I had with water; I dipped and resurfaced, and water butterflies. kept me afloat"; "Water smiles up, mirroring the sky. The way to come together neither of them knows"; "Who desires tears in a butterfly festival? Lines are not painted on her trail..." and many more.


The singing of raindrops over a lushgreen light keeps the viewer blissfully aware while the reflection of twilight mingling with the shadow of a forest speaks of the awesome solitary pond and lake. The way Pai framed three connected tender rose leaves adorned with dewdrops have the appearance of an exquisite ornamentation with pearls.


The subtle game of azure and green on a tranquil lake produces a panoramic view of a water nymph's dance. One also finds grey twilight, water hyacinth ground, and inventive reflections of beautiful elements like kingfishers and


The use of soft tender light and shadow of dying twilight is confined in a remarkable way in one of Pia's photographs that seems like an illusion as it forms three human figures within it. The artiste has truly captured different parts of both rural and urban Bangladesh with her various seasons.

Born in Jessore in 1973, Masuma Pia completed her Masters in Marketing from Dhaka University. She is the CEO of a media and communication firm called 'Matri'. She is also an active member of Map Photo Agency. Aside from solo exhibitions, Pia participated in a number of group photography exhibitions and workshops.

The exhibition is open from 3 to 8pm and ends today.

Promoting arts across the frontier

Abdus Shakur exhibition in Kolkata

Art should not be fettered by geographical boundaries, said renowned Bangladeshi painter Abdus Shakur Shah. "To promote art and culture there should be less security curbs on the movement of people between our two countries," Shakur, the 1977 Lalit Kala Academy topper and 1991 Japan Excellence Award recipient, told the media in Kolkata on Tuesday night at an exhibition of his paintings embossed with textile designs.

He expressed wonder about why common people of the two sides who speak the same language, and share a culture can't visit each other

more frequently.

Shakur, who has held exhibitions in Canada, the UK, Italy and India, explained how his earthy sketches on rural folk tales of Bengal were contemporised by a Bangladeshi corporate house 'Myth Shop' through textile designs and almost became a fashion statement for the youngsters there.

"After the exhibition of these art works in Dhaka, I could sense how we could create our own brand and rival the big fish by propagating Bengal's traditional and indigenous culture among our young people," he said.


Religion cannot draw a line between the two neighbours, so beautifully demonstrated in the award-winning film "Moner Manush" by celebrated filmmaker Goutam Ghosh, he said.

The fact that the film is drawing huge crowds in both the countries has lent credence to the contention, according to him.

and paintings, mostly culled from the folk tales of erstwhile East Bengal, was inaugurated by the Deputy High Commissioner of Bangladesh to India, Md Mustafizur Rahman. Rahman called for holding of

more such exhibitions, on textile works, painting and others by Bangladeshi artists, in Kolkata and elsewhere in India.

Eminent Indian painter Bijan Choudhury, having spent several years in Dhaka earlier, dwelt on his long association with Shakur and how he had been inspired by Shakur's style.


