

# 11 killed as 2 buses collide in Comilla

At least 11 people were killed and 40 others injured when two buses collided on Dhaka-Chittagong highway near Kather Pool of Chandina upazila in Comilla yesterday.

Witnesses said six people, including a woman, died on the spot and five others soon after being taken to hospital.

The victims were identified as Siddiqur Rahman, 35, a motorcyclist, of Shrimantapur village under Chandina upazila; bus driver Lokman Hossain Bhuiyan, 45, of Nolua village under Kochua upazila, Chandpur; bus helper Ramjan Ali, 23, and passenger Samrat, 38, of Shaharasti, Chandpur; Rafique, 25, of Chandpur sadar and Palash, 30, a sales representative of a pharmaceutical company, of Debipur village under Sudharam upazila, Noakhali.

The identity of five others could not be known immediately. All the injured were rushed to Comilla Medical College **SEE PAGE 19 COL 6**

## Murder, robbery charges dropped

Court terms charges against five "politically motivated"

A court in Dhaka yesterday withdrew dacoity and murder charges against five persons, including two fugitives, considering it "politically motivated" and meant for "harassment".

Kaniz Akhter Nasrina Khanam, judge (in charge) of the Speedy Trial Tribunal-2, Dhaka passed the order following an application filed by the special public prosecutor of the court.

The accused are Joynal Abedin Mollah, Ikbal Hossain, Shahin, Sharif and Humayun Kabir Reaz. Of them, Shahin and Humayun are on the run. Following the withdrawal order, plaintiff 's brother

Mohammad Afzal Hossain broke down in tears and expressed his dissatisfaction over the verdict. He also said they would file a revision prayer with the High Court challenging the legality of the trial court order.

Witnesses go back to '71 as war crimes trial prosecutors visit spots

Mohsin Ali had kept things to himself since the country's independence, but yesterday when prosecutors of the International Crimes Tribunal visited Rokeya Hall of Dhaka University he could not resist describing his wartime experience to them.

He was 10 years old and was living in Rokeya Hall employees' quarters with his family on March 25, 1971 when the Pakistani army unleashed their killing spree on unsuspected Bangalees in Dhaka city.

"I was scared when the Pakistani army knocked on our door. I just managed to hide under a bed. The army men entered the room breaking the door, and shot my parents dead. I was lucky enough that they did not look under the bed." said Mohsin, who now works as an office help in Rokeya Hall at the age of 51.

That night the marauding Pakistani army killed about 45 to 50 people inside Rokeya Hall.

Chief Prosecutor Golam Arif Tipu; and prosecutors Zead-Al-Malum, Syed Haider Ali, and Altaf Hossain listened to Mohsin's experience of
