



Rajshahi Theatre's Folk Festival in full swing

Performers of Gambhira, a popular sub-genre of folk music from Chapainawabganj, stressed the need to revive local performing art forms that are likely to become extinct on the second day (last Tuesday) of Folk Festival organised by Rajshahi Theatre.

'Nana-Natir (grandfather and grandson) Gambhira' also highlighted the history of Rajshahi city and the river Padma, which has now lost her glory.

The second-day of the five-day festival began with a discussion where speakers urged the artistes to uphold



and promote traditional arts forms.

Artistes of Rajshahi Theatre performed popular folk songs that drew people from all walks of life. Of them, "Agey Ki Shundor Din Kataitam" and "Ke Banailo Rangmoholkhana" were greeted with rounds of applause.

will feature works of creative photo-artistes from 30 countries. The theme of 'Chobi Mela VI' is 'Dreams' and the

slogan is: "All that we value, that we strive to uphold, all that gives us strength, has been made of dreams." The festival is designed to be a birthplace of ideas, and a crossover meeting point for

many photographers and photo enthusiasts. It will also showcase new trends in photography, bringing to the fore issues affecting the world at present. The unique festival will be launched on


