BDR to be BGB from 3rd week of Jan

Bangladesh Rifles (BDR) will replace their name with Border Guard Bangladesh (BGB) officially from the third week of this month.

BDR Director General (DG) Rafiqul Islam yesterday told newsmen that the paramilitary force is legally known as BGB from December 20. "A new flag will be hoisted formally any day of the third week of this month," he said.

The DG said this after inaugurating a student dormitory for the children of BDR staffs at Lalbagh near Nababganj lane in the city.
