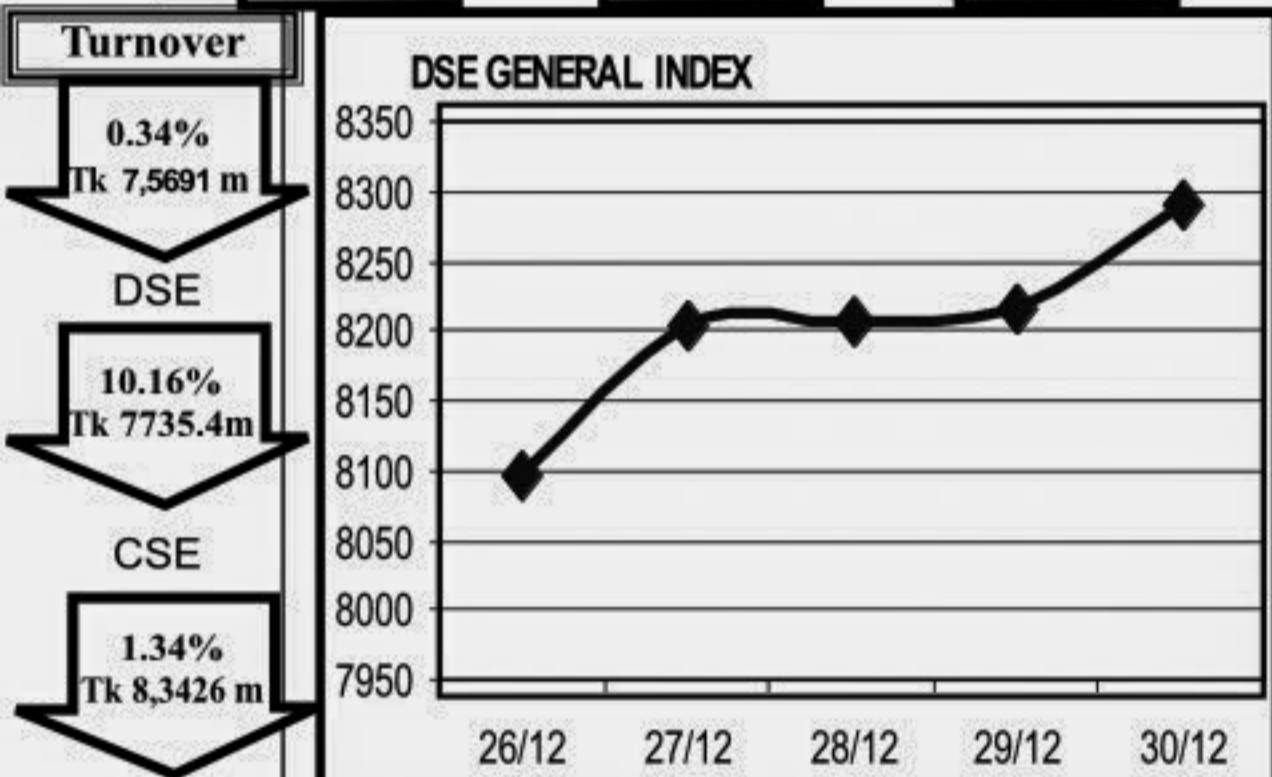

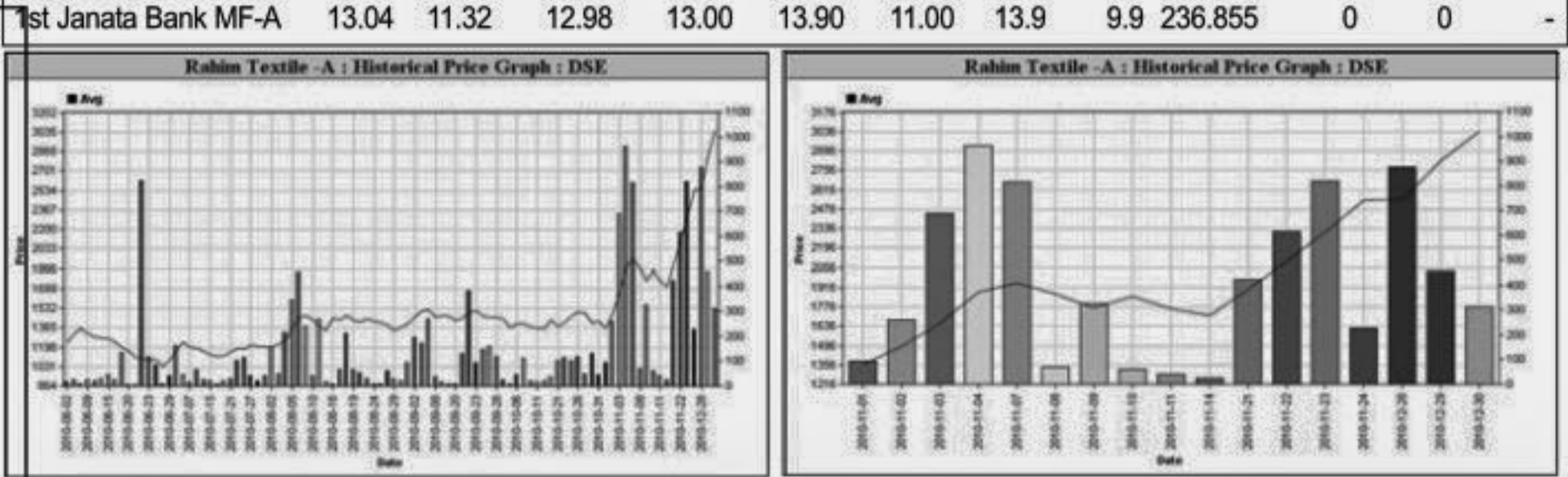

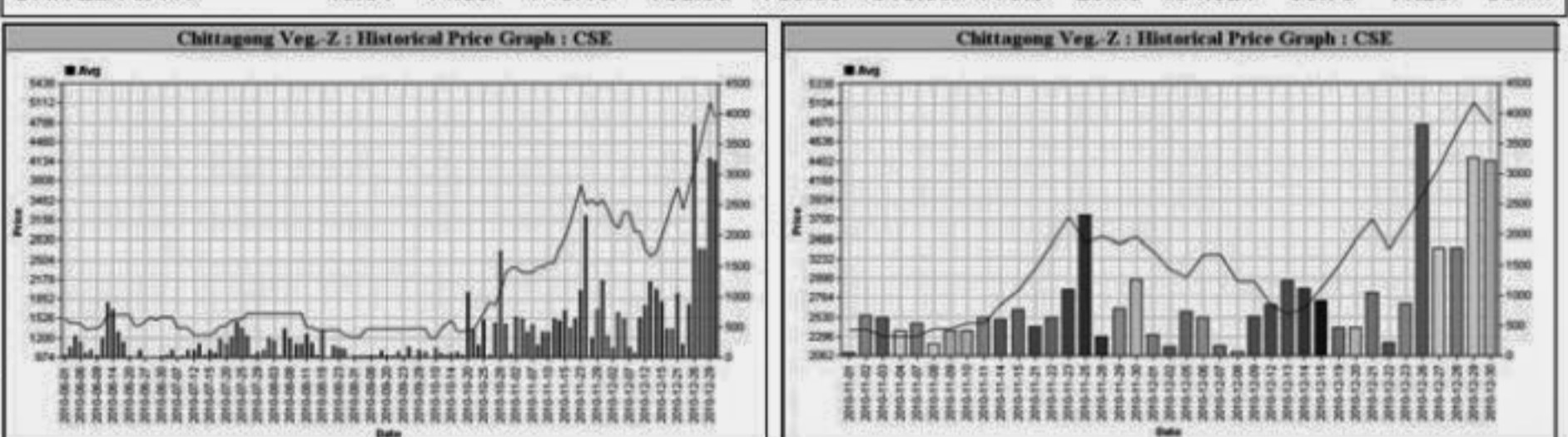

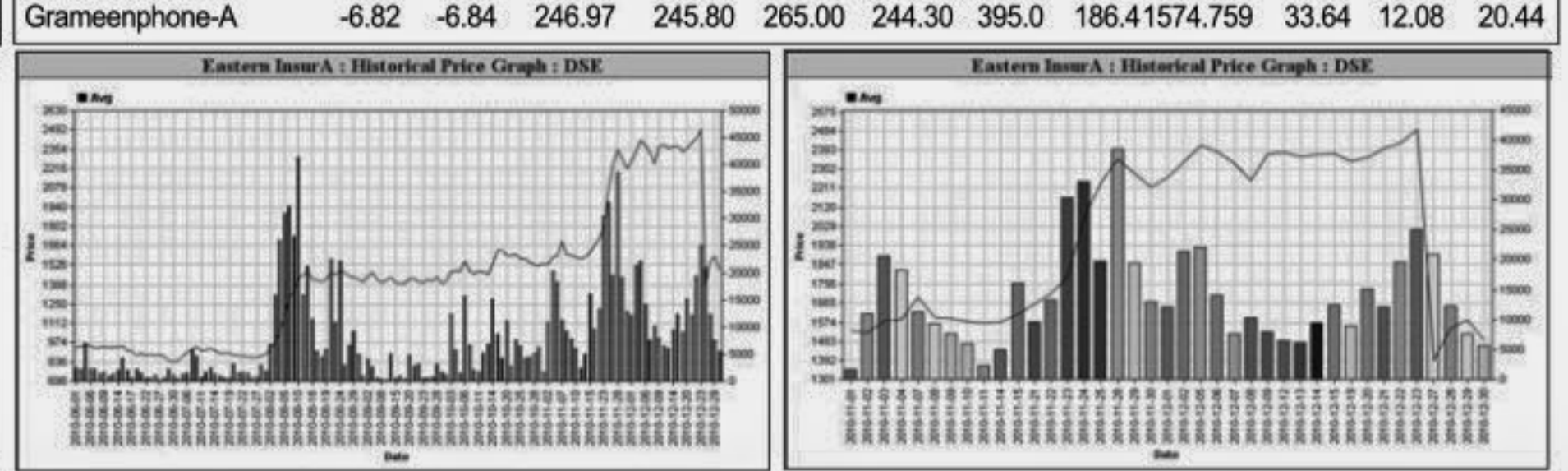

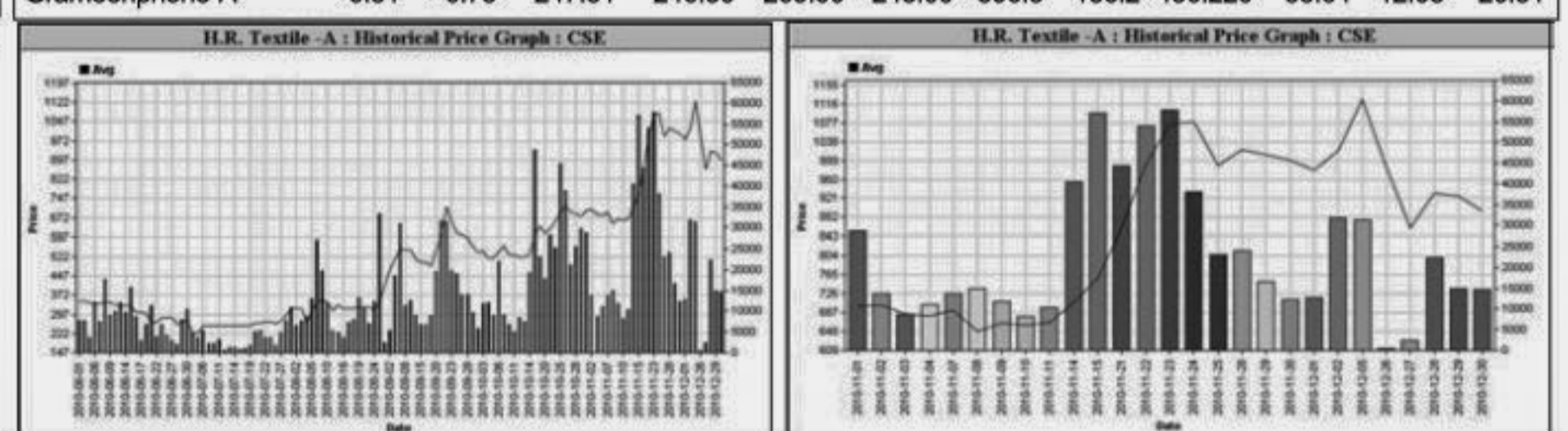

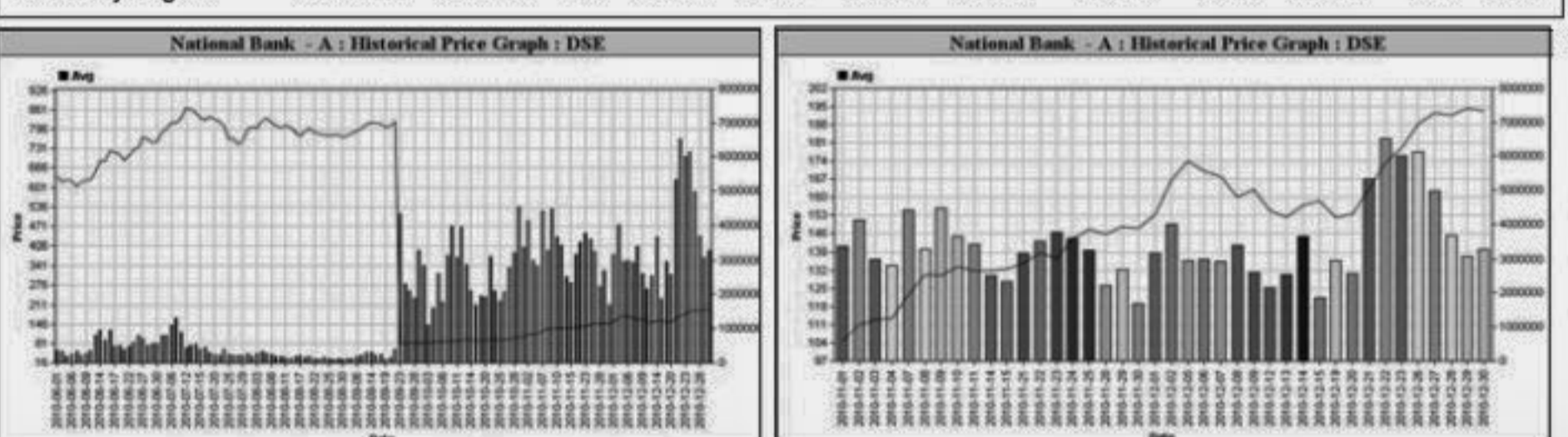

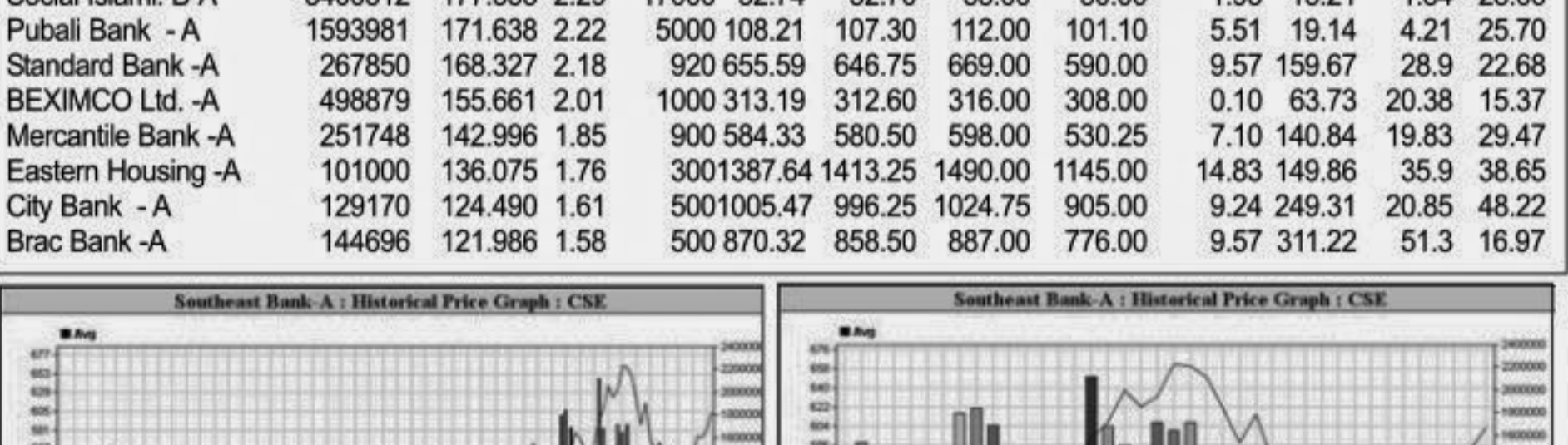

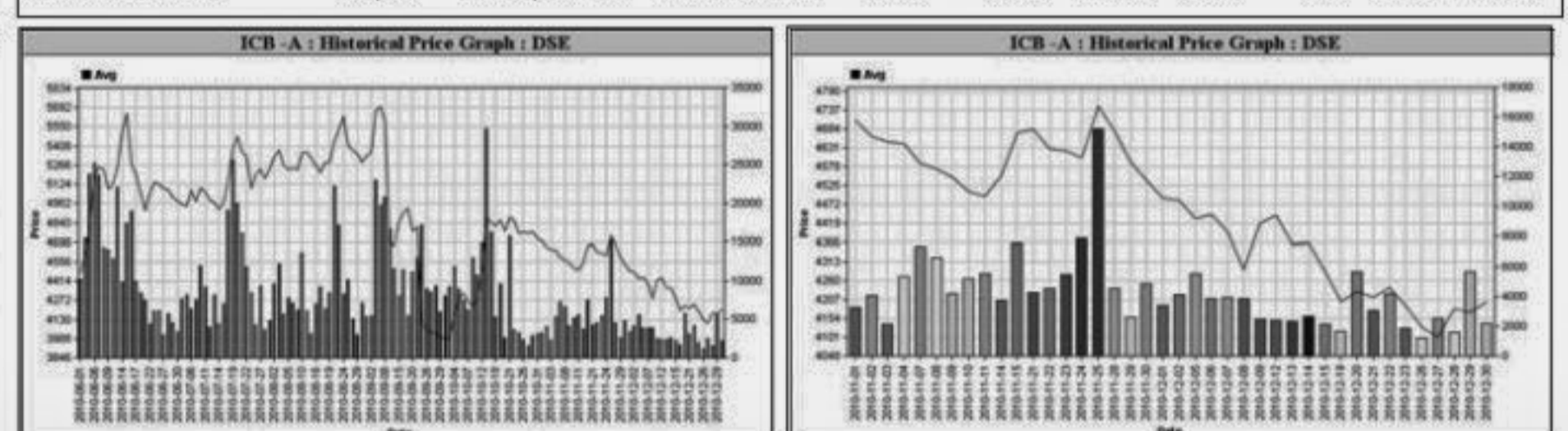

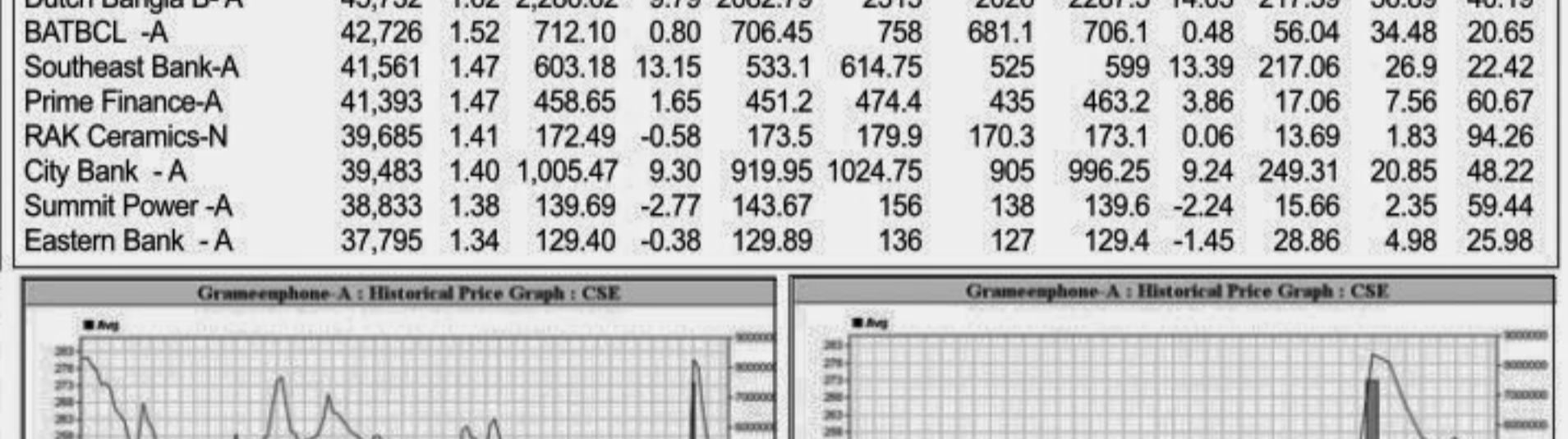

What you should know to buy or sell

Investors follow many calculations of corporate performance when deciding if a stock is undervalued or overvalued. These range from the simple price-earnings ratio, or P/E, to far more technical ways of attempting to discern whether a stock is trending up or down.



Notes: Capital Gainer / Loser tables are prepared on the basis of the close price change of the traded issues. "Close" or "C Price" or "W Clo." is the Closing Price of the Week.
