Gilani's government lost its parliamentary majority on Sunday after the

Muttahida Qaumi Movement (MQM) announced it would go into opposition over government fuel price policies that it said were "unbearable" for Pakistanis.

Gilani met the president of the biggest opposition party in the National Assembly, the Pakistan Muslim League (PML-N) yesterday. They were expected to


