

Hemanta Mukhopadhyay **HQ CHOWDHURY** Sometime around 1946, composer Hanuman Prasad heard a Bengali girl sing while on a visit to a dance class on the ground floor of a building in Bombay (now Mumbai). Hanuman Prasad liked her voice and gave her some lines to sing (in a chorus) for a small film "Bhakt Prahlad". The voice traveled far and wide to many compos ers including 'Sachin Karta' aka 'Burman Dada' (in Bombay) who immediately spotted the unique quality in her vocal chord. The girl was Geeta Roy, daughter of landowner Devendra Roy Chowdhury and Amiya, originally from Faridpur, Bangladesh. The Chowdhury family had shifted to Bombay in 1942 when Geeta was just 12.

Burman Dada approached the Chowdhurys for the rehearsal of his songs in "Do Bhai". There was no reason to refuse Dada as by then he was a much respected figure amongst the Bengalis. The young girl, after weeks of training, was put to test much against the wishes of the producer, with "Mera Sundar Sapna Beet Gaya", a song that had a Kirtan flavour. The song was such a rage that it set the career of Geeta Roy who later became one of the all-time great singers of the subcontinent. There were other songs too in the film including the wailing "Yaad Karogey Yaad Karogey". But it was "Mera Sundar Sapna Beet Gaya" that left all songs behind and far too. Listeners from Lahore to Lumding

went crazy with the song. Manna Dev had come to Bombay with his uncle KC Dey aka "Kana Keshto" in 1943. He was struggling as a singer in Hindi films. KC Dey left Bombay in 1946 and Manna Dey became Dada [Burman] and Khemchand Prakash's assistant. But unfortunately, he never got any song
