Singair grand alliance prospect dim for intra-party feud

Intra-party rivalry has weakened the prospect of the mayoral candidate backed by Awami League (AL)-led grand alliance in the January 17 poll at Singair municipality under Manikganj district. Three candidates are

contesting for the post of mayor, 42 candidates for the posts of councillors and 11 others for reserved seats of councillors for women. Grand alliance backed

candidate AL leader and incumbent Mayor Mir Mohammad Shahjahan is facing tough challenge from BNP backed candidate Khorshed Alam Bhuiyan Joy, president of Singair upazila unit of Jatiyatabadi Jubo Dal as 'rebel' candidate of AL MM Alamgir Hossain, vicepresident of Manikganj district unit of Jubo League, is also in the poll race.

There are around 17 thousand voters in the municipality.



Defeated AL rebel's supporters attack rival candidate's men: 3 hit by bullet

At least three people suffered bullet injury as a rebel AL mayor candidate's men fired at the winning candidate's supporters in Santhia municipality area yesterday afternoon in the area.

Police picked up four from the spot. Agitated mob later besieged the rebel AL leader's house creating a tense situation.

Locals and police said the men of defeated AL rebel candidate Mozammel Haque Master attacked the activists of winning AL backed mayor candidate Mirazul Islam at Santhia municipality market leaving three injured on the spot. The injured are Mamun, Ershad and Raja-all supporters of Mirazul.

Earlier Mirazul was reelected Santhia municipality mayor in January 12 election defeating his nearest rival Mozammel.

Mirajul claimed that Mozammel Master's men attacked his activists when they were passing by Mozammel's house.

The injured three were taken to Bera upazila health complex where the condition of Mamun and Raja turned critical. The two were shifted to Pabna for better treatment.

After the incident, agitated mob besieged Mozammel Master's residence. Police rushed to the spot and brought the situation under control.

They also picked up four people including two sons of Mozammel Master from the spot.



Khagrachhari: BNP expels rebel candidate in Matiranga

Bangladesh Nationalist Party (BNP) on Wednesday expelled its rebel candidate for the mayoral post of Matiranga municipality under Khagrachhari district. The expellee is Md Badsha, general secretary of

party's Matiranga municipality unit, reports a correspondent. According to a press release issued by office secre-

tary of Matiranga municipality BNP Md Abul Kashem, action against Badsha was taken at a joint meeting of the district, upazila and municipality units as he did not withdraw his candidature as per instruction of the party. Contacted, Badsha said he will continue election

campaign as he is the appropriate candidate for the mayoral post. BNP nominated Abu Yosuf Chowdhury to contest for the post.

However, independent mayoral candidate advocate Nazrul Islam on Tuesday withdrew his candidature. He urged the voters to cast their valuable votes for a competent, sincere and honest mayoral candidate.

Faridpur: 4 candidates fined for violating poll code

A mobile court yesterday fined a mayor and three councillor candidates for violating election code of conduct in Boalmari municipality.

The accused are mayor aspirant Hasanuzzaman Mia Mukul and councillor candidates Shahida Begum, Mujibur Rahman, and Ruhul Amin, reports our correspondent.

Mukul was fined for pasting posters on the wall while Shahida for using colour photo in the election posters and pasting them on the wall. Two other councilor candidate-- Mujibur

Rahman and Amin Amin--were fined for using colour banners. A mobile court led by Executive Magistrate

Torikul Alam conducted the drive with the help of Boalmari upazila election officer Abdur Rashid in the morning.

Pabna: Cases against 300 ruling party activists in Ishwardi

Police yesterday filed three separate cases with Ishwardi police station, accusing over 300 activists of the ruling party of attacking four polling centres in the municipality to snatch ballot boxes on Wednesday night, reports our correspondent.

Sub-Inspector Ibrahim Hossain filed a case against 80 AL activists while Sub-Inspector Md Azizul Islam and Sub-Inspector Dulal Uddin filed two separate cases with the same police station against 250 activists of the party.
