

The University was set up by Eastern University Foundation - a nonprofit and non-political organization. Its founders include academics, chartered accountants, engineers, industrialists and retired civil servants. The University currently has four Faculties: Faculty of Arts, Faculty of Business Administration, Faculty of Engineering and Technology and Faculty of Law. The Faculty of Arts has two departments: Department of English and Department of Applied Linguistics and ELT (English Language Teaching). The Faculty of Business Administration is a single Department Faculty but has four major areas, namely Accounting, Finance, Marketing, Management and Human Resource. A few social science courses are also offered by Chairmen, and the Treasurer. this Faculty. The Faculty of Engineering and Technology has two departments: Department of Computer Science and Electrical and Electronics Engineering. The Faculty of Law is again a single Department Faculty having undergraduate and postgraduate programmes.

Curriculum Eastern University follows North American model of curriculum in the fields of Business Administration, Computer Science and Electrical and Electronics Engineering; the UK model in Law and English. The academic programme is pursued through a framework of curriculum that includes splitting up of an academic year into three semesters: the Fall, the Spring and the Summer. The Curricula of the academic programmes are of international standard and are updated regularly to make it relevant to future job requirements of the students.




