# Suicide bombing kills 35 at Moscow airport

A bomb attack at Moscow's Domodedovo airport killed at least 35 people and injured more than 100 yesterday.

Investigators say the explosion, which happened in the arrivals hall, was caused by a suicide bomber.

President Dmitry Medvedev vowed that those behind the attack would be tracked down and punished.

He ordered increased security across Russia's capital, its airports and other transport hubs.

Medvedev also called an emergency meeting with officials and also postponed his planned departure for this week's World Economic Forum at Davos.

The airport -- the busiest serving Russia's capital -- is 40km (25 miles)

south-east of the city centre.

Footage from mobile phones showed the arrivals area filled with smoke and with bodies strewn across the floor.

BBC security correspondent Gordon Corera said immediate suspicion about yesterday's attack would fall on militants from the Caucasus region.


