They add prices at the market vary almost daily depending on the amount of flowers and number of customers in the market.

Like past 12 years, Abu Sayeed Mollah from Shyampur in Savar brought 2,000 red roses and 1,000 sticks of tuberoses.

He said they usually sell one rose at Tk 1.5-2 and one stick of tuberose at Tk 1-2.
