The trial proceedings against former forest and environment minister and now Deputy Leader of the House Syeda Sajeda Chowdhury was earlier quashed following an order of the higher court.

The case was stayed following an order from the High Court (HC). Later, the HC vacated the stay order and ordered to continue its trial proceedings.

According to the prosecution, it was alleged that Mosharraf while he was in charge of housing and public works ministry, by using power and violating rules and provisions of the Rajuk, allotted five kathas of land to Sajeda at Banani in the city even though she had another


