

CASE FOR GRENADE ATTACK ON BRITISH HC Warrant against 10 PWs for skipping court

A court here yesterday issued warrant against the former president of the district Bar association and 9 others for failing to appear before the court despite repeated summons to give deposition in the sensational case (for explosive substances) for the grenade attack on the then British High Commissioner Anwar Chowdhury.

Additional District & Sessions Judge-V Manzurul Haque Khan gave the order to issue warrants against former district Bar association president Abdul Hai Khan, inspector Shafiqul Alam of DB police, SM Khokan Rana, Kawsar Ahmed, Mashuk Ahmed, Abul Kalam Azad, Main Uddin Ahmed, Mofazzal Hossain, Matiar Rahman and Cherag Ali.

The judge set 29 March as the next date for recording deposition by the prosecution witnesses (PWs) in the case, court sources said.

Kingpin of outlawed Huji Mufti Abdul Hannan, his brother Muhibullah alias Muhibur Rahman and Mufti Mainuddin alias Masum Billah could not be brought to Sylhet. However, other accused Huji activists Delwar Hossain Ripon and Shahedul Alam Bipul were produced

before the court yesterday.

Two cases, one for murder and the other for explosive substances, were filed in connection with the grenade attack on the then British High Commissioner to Bangladesh Anwar Chowdhury, after Jum'a prayers on 21 May, 2004 in front of the shrine of Hazrat Shahjalal (RA) in Sylhet.

Three people were killed while over 50 others including the district Bar president Abdul Hai Khan sustained injuries in the incident.

The Divisional Speedy trial tribunal of Sylhet on 23 December, 2008 awarded death to Mufti Hannan, Shahedul Alam Bipul and Delwar Hossain Ripon while Mufti Muhibur Rahman and Mufti Main Uddin were sentenced for life and fined Tk 10,000 each, in default, to suffer 2 years more in jail.

The same group of accused are facing trial in the case for explosive substances.

So far deposition of 19 out of 57 prosecution witnesses has been recorded in the case.

But, due to non-appearance of the PWs, the trial process is being hampered badly and delayed, said APP Jashim Uddin Ahmed yesterday.

Strike at MMCH called off

Interns and students of Mymensingh Medical College Hospital yesterday called off their indefinite strike following assurance of the authorities of meeting their demands.

They went on strike last Saturday in protest against the attack on them by some local people Thursday. They were demanding punishment to the attackers.

Following the fruitful negotiations with the authorities concerned, the striking interns and students called off their program at 1pm.

Earlier, the intern doctors and some outsiders of nearby Charpara area locked in an altercation over harassing a female intern by a stalker on Thursday night.

Following the incident, some people of the area allegedly attacked the interns and vandalised several rooms of the hospital.

BCL leader beats up SI at police station in Natore

A Chhatra League (BCL) leader assaulted a sub-inspector of police inside a police station on Monday noon.

Police said, Faruk Hossain, general secretary of Gol-e-Afraz College unit BCL assaulted SI Nuruzzaman of Singra police station as he tried to stop him from beating up a member of a rival party.

Witnesses and sources said, Faruk, also an OMS (open market sell) dealer in Tazpur area locked in a quarrel with BNP activist Khuyar when he came to buy OMS rice from Faruk.

At one stage, Jubo Dal leader Sahadat Hossain came to manage the situation.

On information, police rushed to the spot, arrested Shahadat and Khuyar and took them to Singra police station.

When another Jubo Dal leader, Habib Master, came to see the arrestees at Singra PS, Faruk beat up Habib inside the police station.

Faruk also assaulted sub-inspector Nuruzzaman as he tried to protect Habib.

Police arrested Faruk and within a few minutes agitated BCL and Jubo League leaders and activists led by BCL leader Lutfur Habib Rubel attacked the police station and damaged its boundary wall, said policeman.

Rubel is the president of Gol-e-Afraz College unit BCL and also brother-in-law of Zunayed Ahmad Palak, MP of Singra constituency.

Sub-inspector Nuruzzaman later said, Faruk assaulted him inside the police station as he tried to save Jubo Dal leader Habib from Faruk's anger.

Nasirul Islam, additional superintendent of police in Natore said, police arrested Faruk on charge of assaulting police personnel.

Faizur Rahman, officer-in-charge of Singra police station said, police also arrested Shahadat and Khuyar in a case filed on charge of looting OMS rice.

60-day ban on fishing in hilsa-rich areas

A 60-day ban on fishing, including catching hilsa fry, locally known as *jatka*, from March-April took effect in all hilsa-rich areas and Meghna river in Chandpur and Laxmipur from Monday midnight.

The ban will continue till midnight of April 30 this year.

District fishery officer

Ratan Dutta said an area from Uttar Matlab upazila of Chandpur to Char Alexander of Laxmipur, over a stretch of 100 kilometers on both banks of Meghna and its tributaries and confluences, will fall under the purview of the ban.

He said the ban on catching fries including *jatka*, hilsa fish smaller than 23 centimeters in

length, is imposed from March 1 to April 30 every year in all hilsa-rich areas of the country since 2006.

Catching *jatka* during the aforesaid period is deemed as punishable offence. Police, Navy and Coastguards in boats and ships will keep watch at different points of hilsa-rich areas in the next 60 days starting from Monday.
