

# Tajuddin thanked

against the Awami League. General Hamid was particularly of the view that Bangladesh Sheikh Mujibur Rahman's movement had to be crushed and the chief of the Awami League needed to be taught a lesson. Curiously, none in the junta was willing or ready to condemn Zulfikar Ali Bhutto, who had precipitated the whole crisis in the first place. Control over the regime appeared to be slipping out of Yahya Khan's hands. The military ruler, as some of his close associates were to report later, appeared dazed and was clearly unable to make sense of what was happening in the country.

In Bangladesh, Awami League General Secretary Tajuddin Ahmed was a permanent presence on the scene through his presentation and enumeration of the directives issued by the Awami League to keep the administration going in Dhaka and elsewhere. On March 11, 1971, Tajuddin Ahmed made it a point to thank the people of Bangladesh for coming forward with their full cooperation and support for the nationalist movement in Bangladesh. A confident Awami League

leadership prepared to deal with the regime, an inevitability it saw happening any time.

The country's constitution also provides safeguard against torture. Article 35 (5) of the constitution addresses it directly and says, "No person shall be subjected to torture or to cruel, inhuman, or degrading punishment or treatment."

But no government made any move to enact a law to prevent such incidents.

If the proposed legislation gets through the House, it will contribute to protecting people from abuses and prevent recurrence of human rights violations.

According to the bill, torture means any act that causes physical or mental pain to any person for obtaining information or a confession from that person or some other person.

In case of custodial death, if it is proven that the death occurred as a consequence of torture, the offender shall be sentenced to rigorous imprisonment for life and fined, says the bill.

of the Consultative Group to Assist the Poor (CGAP), and Vijay Mahajan, chair of the CGAP board, said, "We are deeply concerned by the campaign of the past few months and recent legal actions to remove Muhammad Yunus as managing director of Grameen Bank."

They said over the past 30 years Yunus and Grameen Bank together have been a powerful force and symbol for the microcredit movement, and for progress for poor people who were previously excluded from formal financial services.

"Prof Yunus has been a pioneer in the field, and his substantial contributions to advancing the cause of poor unbanked women should be celebrated by Bangladesh, and the international community."

"The current situation is damaging not just to Grameen Bank and poor clients in Bangladesh, but also to the wider microfinance industry," they said.

They said the widespread international support Yunus has received affirms the important role many countries now see for financial inclusion. "We also sense an increasing awareness and understanding at a political level in many countries including the G20 of what financial inclusion can contribute to social and economic development."

"We hope that a compromise can be reached that allows Grameen Bank to operate effectively, and for microfinance in Bangladesh to continue to thrive and contribute to the social and economic development of the country."

CGAP is the world's leading resource for advancement of microfinance. It provides the financial industry, governments and investors with objective information, expert opinion, and innovative solutions to effectively expand access to finance for poor people around the world.

In a joint open letter in support of Dr Yunus, ACCION, Calvert Foundation, Co-Operative Bank, FINCA, Freedom From Hunger, Grameen Foundation, Grassroots Capital, Microvest Fund, Opportunity International,

Pro Mujer, Triple Jump, Visionfund International, and Women's World Banking, said the banker to the poor has diligently served the poor for decades, and none has done more to inspire generations to work to reduce poverty.

"We are increasingly concerned and dismayed with the troubles Muhammad Yunus is facing in Bangladesh. As we understand it, the government of Bangladesh is resorting to technicalities to remove Dr Yunus from the Grameen Bank, without presentation through legitimate and transparent legal processes of any evidence of wrongdoing."

"We deeply deplore this lack of justice and unproven allegations that not only impugn Dr Yunus' character and the integrity of his flagship bank, but reach much further. Forced removal creates unnecessary risk for the more than 8 million borrowers-owners of the bank."

"The government of Bangladesh previously had respect for the bank's independence as a majority client-owned microfinance institution; it is our sincere hope that a return to the status quo can be made quickly."

Meanwhile, 16 non-resident Bangladeshis living abroad wrote an open letter to the Government of Bangladesh under the banner of "Voice for Justice", protesting the dismissal of Yunus from the country's most prestigious institution.

Voice for Justice is a global community organisation whose mission is to prevent acts of injustice, and to actively seek and ensure justice against any action of an individual, group or entity deemed illegal, unfair or discriminatory.

"We, the undersigned members of the international community of Bangladeshis, are deeply shocked by the recent dismissal of Nobel Laureate Dr Yunus from the Grameen Bank, an institution he founded and shepherded for the betterment of poor Bangladeshi women."

"The action by the Bangladesh Bank is an example of government overreach. Even if Dr Yunus recently passed the retire-

ment age, Grameen Bank's Board of Directors should have had the option to work out a graceful transition for him," they said.

"Dr Yunus is a distinguished citizen of Bangladesh and a model citizen of the world. His work is recognised by numerous national and international organizations. His micro-credit model is emulated in five continents. It has lifted millions of women and their families out of poverty and empowered them to become dynamic entrepreneurs," they said.

The group said every Bangladeshi is proud of Dr Yunus' Nobel Peace Prize and the renown he has brought to the motherland. "It is time we learn to respect a son of the land who has earned high honours and recognition around the world."

"The sudden and disrespectful dismissal of Dr Yunus is unfortunate and unacceptable. It has caused deep concern worldwide and has tarnished the image of Bangladesh as a progressive and democratic country."

"We deplore this action by the Government of Bangladesh and demand immediate reinstatement of Dr Yunus," the members of Voice for Justice said.

minnows Netherlands that was followed by a tied match against India, a heartbreaking loss against Ireland and a nail-biting six-run success against South Africa; enough to show how inconsistent they have been in the tournament.

But everything will depend on how the under-pressure Tigers will bounce back in the crucial match after a meek surrender to West Indies in the previous game at Mirpur. The Tigers have yet to play their best cricket in the event although they won against Ireland after some impressive batting against India in an 87-run defeat.

"We have to keep in mind that we have to perform well," said Bangladesh captain Shakib Al Hasan yesterday adding that his side was ready to erase the nightmarish memory of the West Indies.

A win will all but confirm England's entry to the quarterfinals while for Shakib's men a victory not only will keep the hopes alive of advancing into the next round but also bring back the enthusiasm among the cricket crazy fans of the country which was dented after Bangladesh hit their lowest ODI total of 58 against the Caribbean.

The expectation and hype were not same as it was before the first three games, rather there has been a huge on and off the field pressure for Jamie Siddons's charges ahead of this big challenge. There has been a lot of talk about whether Shakib can show his character in the match as the Bangladesh captain was the centre of all controversy following the nine-wicket defeat to West Indies.

The world's number one all-rounder has got a chance to renew everyone's faith in him but to do that his team has to come strongly with the bat and he must get back his rhythm with his left-arm spin as well as with the bat to boost up the vulnerable middle-order.

The Bangladesh team however was upbeat with their chances against England

as they pinned their hopes on their slow bowlers but the question remains whether the batsmen can apply themselves in the middle and refrain from making the same mistakes they did in the previous games.

The Bangladesh think-tank was considering changes to the batting line-up to bring up solidity as Mushfiqur Rahim might go back to his number six position to allow Rokibul Hasan a chance to bat at his customary number four position. There is a chance to see two changes in the team as all-rounder Mahmudullah Riyad is likely to replace Mohammad Ashraful while left-arm spinner Sohrawardi Shuvo may come in place of pacer Rubel Hossain. But if dew is a factor then Bangladesh may drop the idea of playing one pacer.

It is believed that the spinners will play a vital role in the match and that's why England may also play with three spinners in Graeme Swann, James Tredwell and Michael Yardy.

Praising his spinners and batsmen, England skipper Andrew Strauss branded Bangladesh as a dangerous side especially in their own den. But now it's time for the Tigers to prove a point by roaring in a must-win game to keep alive the World Cup for millions of cricket fans in the country.
