Bangladesh Cricket Board is yet to provide the Anti Corruption Commission (ACC) with the documents of its 56.88-milliondollar agreement with Nimbus regarding the television rights of Bangladesh Cricket

The ACC moved to investigate the agreement after a sports organiser had lodged a complaint on December 12 last year with the commission alleging irregularities amounting to 33.77 million dollars over the BCB-Nimbus deal. The six-year deal was penned in July 2008 after the Head of Agreement of the contract had been signed in November 2006.

A senior official of the ACC said they have sent a letter to the BCB asking for the necessary documents and information by February 6 about the agreement, however are yet


