The ruling party of Yemen was scheduled to meet for crisis talks yesterday after Saleh said he was ready hand over power to a safe hand.

The battle for control left at least one soldier dead and a militant seriously wounded, an official said.

"Jaar and surrounding villages have fallen into the hands of Al-Qaeda," he said on condition of anonymity. The militants seized control of public buildings, including a local radio station and a barracks.

Yemen's Saleh warns of 'chaos'

In Batige, 10 kilometres from Jaar, about 30 armed and hooded suspected Al-Qaeda fighters seized and made off in four vehicles with cases of weapons from a munitions factory, witnesses said.

The flare-up came as US Defence Secretary Robert Gates said Saleh's fall or replacement by a weaker leader would pose "a real problem" for Washington's fight against Al-Qaeda, in an interview with ABC television.

Saleh at the same time portrayed himself as a symbol of stability in the Arabian peninsula.

"I have already said and I now reiter-

ate that I am not clinging on to power," he said in an interview with Al-Arabiya television, as six soldiers died in another suspected Al-Qaeda attack in Marib, in the east.

"I've spent 32 years (in office)... This is experience that I want to transfer peacefully to the people, not to chaos," the embattled president said, referring to the two months of anti-regime protests which have rocked Yemen.

"I will transfer power to the people, who are the source and owner of power," said Saleh, warning that Yemen was a "time bomb" and could slide into civil war like Somalia across the Gulf of

With the United States keeping a lifeline for Saleh, Gates played up the key role of Yemeni authorities in helping to fight Al-Qaeda.

Rescuers struggle in quake-hit Myanmar

Rescue teams struggled yesterday to reach those affected by a powerful earthquake that struck Myanmar's east three days ago, as aid workers feared the death toll would increase.

Officials say 75 people were killed by the 6.8 magnitude quake that hit near the borders with Thailand and Laos late on Thursday, reducing homes and government buildings to rubble and affecting thousands of people.

"As we learn more it appears that the casualty figures will continue to increase," an aid worker in the country told AFP, asking not to be named.

Tachileik town and nearby Tarlay and Mong Lin in Myanmar's Shan state appeared to have been most severely affected by the quake, which was felt as far away as the Vietnamese capital Hanoi.

"We don't know how many people were affected yet. We are still trying to get the figures," a Myanmar official said yesterday. An unnamed Red Cross worker in

Tachileik told exile news group the Irrawaddy that at least 150 people had been killed, but the official said there was no confirmed increase from Friday's toll of 74.

The charity World Vision believes around 15,000 people may have been affected in the worst-hit areas.

The affected region was already difficult to reach before the quake, while access to the area by foreigners is restricted and the military-dominated government tends to keep a tight grip on information.

The ruling junta was widely criticised for refusing foreign assistance for weeks after cyclone Nargis wrought devastation across the Irrawaddy Delta in May 2008, leaving more than 138,000 people either killed or missing.

only 32 Bangladeshis crossed the Libyan border on March 26, Foreign Secretary Mijarul Quayes yesterday.

He said about 500 Bangladeshis are expected to be flown home today from Tunisia by Biman flights and the rest will be repatriated shortly.

"It appears that the inflow of Bangladeshi nationals is gradually slowing down. The repatriation of Bangladeshi migrants will be completed soon, if there is no huge influx from Libya," the foreign secretary

He said the ministry's consular team is overseeing the repatriation of Bangladeshis at Ras Jdir border in conjunction with international organisa-

The foreign ministry has requested the Biman authorities to arrange extra flights immediately to bring back the remaining stranded Bangladeshis as soon as possible.

Quayes said the ministry's consular at Al Salloum border in Egypt has completed arrangements for repatriating the three

> The secretary said 32,376 Bangladeshis have been repatriated from Libya so far. Of them, 3,722 returned home with the help of their employers, 26,293 under IOM arrangements and a few on their own.

> Biman has flown 2,361 Bangladeshis home until now, Quayes said.

Meanwhile, six of the 10 bodies of the Bangladeshi nationals, who jumped from a ship while being taken to Greece from the Libyan border on March 6, were flown to Dhaka yesterday. The bodies of the rest will be brought home today.

At least 13 Bangladeshi died after they jumped from the ship while one still remains missing. The bodies of three Bangladeshi migrants had been flown home earlier.


