Glass tower gets green light

A 150-foot high glass tower, a major component of the Swadhinata Stambha complex in the capital, will be constructed by July next year, a decade after a project was taken to build the complex.

The structure named the Tower of Light will be installed for Tk 135 crore to commemorate the March 7 speech of Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman at the historic Suhrawardy Udyan.

The Awami League government took the project in 1996 and built an underground museum, a 2,000-seat theatre, VIP and Service Blocks, walkways, walls with mural and marble work and the south plaza in the first phase. The completed structures were opened to public on March 7 this year.

Construction of the glass tower and other unfinished work at the 67-acre complex will be completed by July next year, said AB Tajul Islam, state minister for liberation war affairs.



Libyan rebels battle for oil town Brega

Agree on conditional ceasefire; Gaddafi's forces bombard Misrata

AGENCIES, Ajdabiya, Rabat

Libyan rebels were digging in yesterday in their battle with Muammar Gaddafi's forces for the oil town of Brega as leaders proposed a ceasefire under the right conditions.

But the West backed off from arming the rag-tag band of fighters and pushed for a political solution instead.

An AFP correspondent citing rebel commanders said fighting had erupted around Brega, about 800 kilometres east of Tripoli yesterday morning.

Rebels prevented reporters and civilians from leaving the strategic town of Ajdabiya for Brega, about 80 kilometres to

the west, but it was unclear exactly where the frontline was or who controlled the refinery town.

The rebels had the previous day been beaten back by heavy shelling from Gaddafi's forces when they launched a counter-offensive at Brega in a bid to resume their march on Tripoli, started soon after the uprising against the hardliner's rule was launched on February 15.

The opposition is ready for a ceasefire provided Gaddafi's forces end their assaults on rebel-held cities, Transitional National Council leader Mustafa Abdul Jalil said yesterday.
