

# 8-year-old rape victim dies without treatment

*All the accused still at large*

An eight-year-old girl, left untreated after being raped at Pashchimpar Dighuli village under Jamalpur Sadar upazila on April 8, died on Sunday night.

The deceased is Tarin, 8, daughter of Chan Mia of village Patilakura of the upazila.

Victim's grandmother Rawshon Ara on Monday night filed a case with Sadar police station accusing six people including the alleged rapist -- Harun-or-Rashid, 38, of Pashchimpar Dighuli village.

The other accused are Habu, 42, Jamal, 35, Kori, 40, Alam, 42, of Pashchimpar Dighuli village and Ripon, 30, of Patilakura village under Sadar upazila.

None of the accused were arrested as of filing this report yesterday.

Harun on April 8 evening offered a candy to the girl, living at her maternal uncle's house in Pashchimpar Dighuli village, took her to a lonely shallow machine room at the village and raped her, goes the case statement.

Police quoted the locals as saying that the five other accused helped the rapist to keep the incident secret through a monetary deal and they managed the victim's poor father and relatives by providing them a sum of money.

On Sunday night Tarin vomited several

times and then fell asleep.

As the girl was found dead the following morning, it became known to neighbours that she remained untreated for days after being violated, locals said.

This correspondent failed to contact Tarin's father as he left the house for an undisclosed place after his daughter's death.

On Monday morning, locals blocked Jamalpur-Tangail highway at Jamtoli and staged demonstration demanding punishment to the rapist and his accomplices. Superintendent of Police Abdur Razzak rushed to the spot and brought the situation under control by giving people assurance of taking action against the criminals.

The victim's body was sent to Mymensingh Medical College and Hospital morgue for autopsy on Tuesday morning, said officer-in-charge (OC) of Sadar police station Abdul Matin.

Police administration has closed SI Abdul Aziz, the in-charge of Narayanpur sub-police station under Sadar police station, as locals complained that he was involved in hiding the rape and saving the criminals after the incident, the OC said.

SI Abdul Aziz however refuted the allegation.

## NOR'WESTER LASHES SEVERAL DISTRICTS

# 4 killed, houses, crops damaged

At least four people were killed and scores of others injured as nor'wester lashed Pabna, Lalmonirhat, Chuadanga and Jhenidah districts on Monday.

Two people were killed and 40 injured in house collapse in Santhia upazila of Pabna, reports our correspondent.

The deceased are Nuri Khan, 14, daughter of Nuru Khan of village Baoikola, and Md Aftab Mollah, 65, son of Ahmad Mollah of Bhadaliapara village of Karamja union in the upazila.

Shamsur Rahman, UP chairman of Karamja, told this correspondent that a storm lashed Bhadaliapara, Baoikola, Shomasgari, Baratpur, Mongolgram, Dattapara, Pashchim Karamja, Punduria and Shamukdani villages at about 8:00pm.

Nuri died soon after the house collapsed on her while Aftab on way to Santhia upazila health complex, he added.

The nor'wester destroyed

over 200 dwelling houses, damaged crops and uprooted a number of trees.

The storm also hit the oil depot of an underconstruction 50mw rental power plant in Beraupazila.

A youth was killed and several hundred houses were damaged as a storm lashed Lalmonirhat and Chuadanga districts Monday evening.

The deceased was identified as Jasim Uddin, 19, a resident of CP School area near Railway office in Lalmonirhat town.

He died as a branch of a tree fell on him during storm at Rail office compound.

Several hundred houses were razed, including Itapota Madrasa and huge standing crops damaged in Mogolhat and Itapota unions in Sadar upazila.

In Chuadanga, nor'wester accompanied by thunderstorm swept four upazilas in the evening damaging boro paddy on hundreds of hectares and uprooting a large number of trees. Scores of houses were also damaged by the storm.

In Jhenidah, lightning killed a young man at

Bagutia village under Shaikupa upazila during the storm on Monday.

The deceased was identified as Zakir Hossain, 24, son of

Sharafat Hossain of the village, reports our correspondent.

Locals and police said, at around 10.30pm, Zakir went to Bagutia Bazaar to buy

sugar. When he was returning home lightning struck him killing on the spot.

Locals found his body in the morning.

## Couple commit 'suicide'

Police recovered the bodies of a couple hanging from a tree at Haldibunia village under Chila union in Mongla upazila of Bagerhat district yesterday noon.

The couple may have committed suicide some time on Monday night, police said after primary investigation.

The deceased are Suranjit Mistri, 32, son Amulya Mistri, and Nupur Biswas, 25, daughter of Jiten Biswas of Haldibunia village.

Nupur was the second wife of Suranjit who has a six-year-old son from his first wife Bina.

Bina's brother Dwijen Ghorami said, "Last year my brother-in-law Suranjit married Nupur and they left the area. Since then Bina has been living with us in the same village. Suranjit did not take care or enquire of Bina

in last one year."

"After the seeing the bodies hanging from the tree beside a pond belonging to Tushar Mondal of Haldibunia village today [Tuesday] morning, local people informed police. The cause behind the suicide could not be ascertained," said Sudarshan Mistri, acting chairman of Chila union parishad.

"As the families concerned did not accept Suranjit's second marriage, Suranjit and Nupur left the area last year. It remains a mystery why they came to Haldibunia village on Monday night. Police is investigating the matter," Mongla police station officer-in-charge Nikhil Mondal said.

An unnatural death case has been filed with Mongla police station and police sent the bodies to Bagerhat Sadar Hospital for autopsy.

## Verdict in case against 57 mutineers Apr 30

The special court-13 will deliver judgement in the mutiny case against 57 jawans of Dinajpur 2 Battalion of Border Guard Bangladesh (BGB) on April 30.

After framing charges against the accused, the court headed by Col Saleh Ahmed announced the date yesterday afternoon. Two other members of the court are Lt Col Md Mahfuz Alam and Major Masudul Islam.

Deputy Attorney General Biswajit Roy was present.

The trial of the case began on November 27 last year. Prosecutor Major Iftekhar Ahmed Qureshi, acting commanding officer of Dinajpur-2 Battalion, read out the allegations against the accused.

He stated that the jawans took control of the battalion, looted firearms and ammunition from armoury on February 26 in 2009, expressing solidarity with the mutineers of BGB headquarters at

Pilkhana in the capital. The accused also fired blank shots and misbehaved with the family members of their officers, the prosecutor added.

Four of the accused confessed to their involvement in the mutiny at the battalion headquarters and begged for mercy while the rest claimed innocence.

As many as 67 prosecution witnesses (PWs) gave their depositions before the court. Arguments between the accused and the witnesses were held at the court.

## Man killed by brothers over land dispute

A man was killed by his brothers following feud over a piece of disputed land at Borchar village in Raipura upazila Sunday night.

The deceased was identified

as Bakul Mia, 35, of the village.

Police said Bakul Mia locked in an altercation with his younger brothers Maha Alam, 25, and Nabi Hossain, 22, over the disputed land at around 9pm.

At one stage, Maha and Nabi

hit Bakul with sharp weapons, leaving him dead on the spot.

Maha and Nabi went into hiding soon after the incident.

A murder case was lodged with Raipura police in this connection.
