Eligibility

- A four-year Bachelor's degree or equivalent from a UGC recognized university/college in any social science and science subjects. Any one with a Master's degree from a recognized university in any other subject with at least two years of experience in population & health related fields.
- At least a second division/class in all public examinations or a minimum CGPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.
- Must pass EWU admission test. Students having a score of 550 in TOEFL and 500 in GRE are admitted directly without admission test.
- Professional experience in population and allied fields is preferred but not required.
