



Answer scripts found beside highway

OUR CORRESPONDENT, Manikganj

Answer scripts of Bangla second paper of the ongoing Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC) Examinations under Dhaka Education Board were found lying beside Dhaka-Aricha highway at Uchutia in Manikganj on Wednesday.

Ansar and VDP members found a sack containing two bundles of answer scripts in front of their office at around 5:30pm and informed the deputy commissioner (DC).

Deputy Commissioner (DC) Munshi Shahabuddin Ahmed immediately sent Chowdhry Samia Zaman, assistant commissioner (land) of Manikganj Sadar upazila, to the Ansar and VDP office.

The assistant commissioner along with the officer-in-charge of Manikganj Sadar Police Station reached the Ansar VDP office at Uchutia at around 5:45pm, received the answer scripts and took them to the district treasury office.

Tapan Kumer Sarker, deputy controller of examinations of Dhaka Education Board, came to Manikganj yesterday morning and received the answer scripts from the deputy commissioner.

When contacted, the deputy controller said answer scripts of Bangla second paper were distributed among the examiners on April 19. After investigation, the board authorities will take necessary actions against the person responsible, he added.

Injured by stalker, little Fatema stops going to school

Injured by a stalker on April 5, a class four student of Abnali Abdul Aziz Registered Primary School in Terokheda upazila of Khulna district has stopped attending school.

The victim, Fatema, 13, had to take shelter at a relative's house in Khulna city following assault and threat by Abdul Ahad, 23, a carpenter of Ikhril village under Terokheda upazila, and his associates, said Fatema's father Abdul Aziz Molla, a farmer of the same village.

Ahad seriously injured her daughter at 10:30am on April 5 when she was going to school, Aziz Molla said in the FIR lodged with Terokheda police station on April 11.

Fatema had to undergo treatment

at Khulna Medical College Hospital from April 5 to April 10, the complainant said, adding that the accused also snatched her gold necklace worth Tk 18,000.

OC Matiar Rahman recorded the FIR as a regular case and made SI Badruzzaman its investigation officer.

"Fatema sustained fractures in her spinal chord and legs as Ahad on April 5 hit her with an iron hammer. The stalker got angry as Fatema's father refused to withdraw an abduction case filed earlier and marry her to Ahad," said Md Ruhul Amin, headmaster of Abdul Aziz Registered Primary School.

On June 8 last year, Aziz lodged an FIR with the same police station

against Ahad for attempting to kidnap Fatema and police arrested the accused the following day.

But he was released on bail in November and started disturbing the girl even more. Fatema and her father received death threats six times since November last year as they refused to withdraw the under trial case against Ahad.

Even after filing of the second case, Ahad is moving at large at Terokheda and Khulna city, said the complainant.

Contacted, OC Matiar Rahman said, "I am sincerely trying to arrest the accused as there are sufficient pieces of evidence against him in connection with the second case filed on April 11."

Erosion threatens fresh areas in Morrelganj

Victims stay in makeshift camps without help

Erosion threatens three more academic institutions, police station, health complex, government staff quarters, private dwellings and several hundred acres of land in Morrelganj upazila of Bagerhat district.

The Panguchi River devoured thousands of houses, shops and markets, mosques, temples and churches, academic institutions and several thousand acres of land in the last ten years, leaving thousands of

people homeless. The affected people have been staying in makeshift camps at the upazila headquarters without getting any sort of help either from the government and non-governmental organisations.

The river erosion has not only disrupted transport services between Morrelganj and Sharankhola upazilas but also devoured many places of historical interest.

The memorial for Robert Morrel is also on the verge of disappearance due to the

unabated erosion by the Panguchi River.

Captain Robert Morrel came to the Sundarbans in forties from Barisal. Morrelganj has been named after him as he settled in a part of the forest, felling trees to make it liveable.

Lawmaker Dr Mozammel Hossain from Morrelganj-Sharankhola constituency told this correspondent that he had asked for adequate allocation of government fund to build up infrastructure to save Morrelganj from being ruined.

9 policemen including Mirsarai OC transferred for negligence to duty

Nine police personnel, including OC of Mirsarai police station, have been transferred to different police stations for negligence to duty following the killing of ASI Borhan by criminals.

Sources at district police superintendent office said the transfer order, on the basis of the probe committee report, reached Mirsarai on Wednesday afternoon.

As per the order, OC Humayun Kabir has been

transferred to Cox's Bazar and he will be replaced by Bandarban OC Mohammad Jahangir Alam.

At the same time second officer of Mirsarai PS Yasin Farook has been transferred to Noakhali, SI Safiq and SI Raju to Chandpur, SI Mizan to Rangamati.

Besides, SI Sadek, SI Nasir, ASI Hedayet and ASI Helal Uddin have been transferred to different other police stations.

On April 16 night, ASI Borhan Uddin of the police station was stabbed to death by criminals while conducting a drive to arrest drug trafficker Parvez at Purbo Hinguli in the same upazila while SI Nasir who was leading the team was also injured in the attack.

District police department formed a three-member probe body headed by additional police superintendent Nur Alam Meena to investigate the incident.

The probe body chief Nur Alam said that the OC was not aware of the drive by unarmed SI Nasir and ASI Borhan.

They found it mysterious why Nasir and Borhan were without arms and police constables went to the spot without taking permission from the OC.

Jailed for killing husband

A court here yesterday sentenced a housewife for life for killing her husband in 2008. Convict Majeda Begum alias Kushi, 37, was wife of van-puller Abdul Gani Sheikh, 40. The court also fined her Tk 5000, in default, to suffer another one year in jail. Acting District and Sessions Judge Md Rezaul Karim pronounced the verdict. According to the prosecution, on February 6, 2008, Majeda and her husband Gani locked in an altercation over a trivial matter. At one stage, Majeda stabbed Gani with a kitchen knife, leaving him dead on the spot. On the same night Kamal Sheikh, brother of the deceased filed a case in this connection.

Stalker punished

A mobile court in Dashmina upazila yesterday sentenced a stalker to four months' jail and fined Tk 5,000. Ajmol Hossain, executive magistrate, also UNO of Dashmina upazila delivered the judgment at around noon. The stalker is Rabiul Islam of Karpurkathi village under the same upazila. Police and mobile court sources said, Rabiul used to tease a student of Arojbegi Madrasa for long. On the day, as Rabiul made an indecent offer, a classmate of the student informed the police with the help of local people. Police reached the spot with the mobile court and the court delivered the judgment after hearing both parties.

3000 chickens culled

UNB, Comilla

About 3000 avian flu affected chickens of 'Shata poultry farm' were culled at Rarirchar village in Chandina Tuesday night. Farm owner Abdur Rahim said 1200 chickens died from April 15 to April 17. Later, he informed the upazila livestock resource office of the matter. Chandina upazila livestock resource official Maqsuma Akter said they collected samples of the chickens and sent them to the district livestock resource office for test, which confirmed the avian influenza.
