Teenage girl's body recovered

Police yesterday recovered a body of a teenage girl from a ditch near Chitra Bridge at Hatbadia village under Narail municipality. Acting on a tip-off, a police team headed by SI Delwar Hossain rushed to the spot and recovered the body of the girl aged about 22. Later, police sent the body to Narail Sadar Hospital morgue for autopsy. The police official said, it was found to be bleeding from nostril and mouth. Locals apprehended that the girl might have been strangled after rape. However, police declined to comment anything before autopsy of the body.

Trucker murdered

Police yesterday recovered body of a truck driver from his house at Court Para in the town. The body was identified as Abu Bakar, 35, of the same area. Acting on a tip-off, a police team conducted a raid at the house at about 8:30am and recovered the body. Contacted, Sadar police station duty officer said, a scarf was wrapped over the neck of the body. Later, police sent the body to Jhenidah General Hospital morgue for an autopsy. Akhiron Nessa, mother of the deceased said, Abu Bakar had a bitter relationship with his wife and in-laws for the last couple of years. This might be the reason behind his death, she said. Abu Bakar married to Fahima Khatun, daughter of Nowsher Ali of Court Para area over a decade ago, police said.

Polybags seized

A mobile court of the environment directorate here yesterday conducted a drive in different shops of Nabogram Bazaar intersection and seized 20 kilogram of banned polythene bags from there. The court also realised a fine of Tk 7,400 from seven shops for using and storing banned polythene bags. The shops were Abdul Majid Store, Mira Store, Sajib Store, Munna Store, vegetable vendors Mamun and Lutfar and Bachchu meat shop. Majid Store was fined Tk 2,500 while Mira Store Tk 2,000, Sajib Store Tk 2,000, Munna Store Tk 500, vegetable vendors Mamun and Lutfar Tk 100 each and Bachchu meat shop Tk 200. Later the seized polythene bags were burnt at the bazaar compound. The mobile court was led by administrative magistrate Tarafdar Mahmudur Rahman. He was accompanied by Arefin Badal, assistant director of the environment directorate and members of the law enforcement agencies.

Three drug peddlers jailed

A mobile court here yesterday jailed three drug peddlers for six months each for keeping drugs and doing illegal drug peddling for a long time. The convicts were Shahjahan, 32, son of Abdus Samad and Asad, 52, son of Jamir Uddin of Patgoda area and Masum, 21, son of Asad Ali of old Trishal bus stand area in the town. All of them were sent to jail. Earlier, the mobile court led by magistrate Tahmina Zakaria conducted the raids in different areas of the town in the morning and arrested them. Various illegal drugs were also recovered from their possession, narcotics directorate sources said. Among others, Narcotic Control Directorate deputy director Zafarullah Kajal was present during the drive.

Four jailed for drinking liquor

A mobile court at Sandeshpur village under Bangabari union of Gomostapur upazila on Monday night conducted an anti-drug drive and arrested four people for drinking locally-made liquor. The arrestees were identified as, Saidur Rahman, 40, Torikul Islam, 37, of Sandeshpur village and Monirul Islam, 40, Abdul Quddus, 42, of Alinagar village under Gomostapur upazila. Later, the court summarily tried them, awarded four months' imprisonment and sent them to jail. Executive magistrate Rabiul Faisal, also acting upazila nirbahi officer (UNO) of Gomostapur sentenced each of them to four months' imprisonment.

Indian cattle trader arrested

An Indian cattle trader was arrested while selling 18 cows at a cattle market at Bhurungamari upazila headquarters on Saturday. The arrestee was identified as Nosir Miah, 48, son of late Boher Miah of Tufanganj Police Station under Cooch Behar district of India. Acting on secret information, police went to the market and arrested Nosir while he was selling the cows.

Robber held with revolver

Highway police arrested a robber along with a revolver and two bullets in Gopalpur area on Rajbari-Kushtia road under Pangsha upazila early Sunday. The arrestee was identified as Rabiul Islam, 32, son of Hossain Ali of Laxmonia village in the upazila. Receiving information that a gang of 10 robbers blocked the road, putting logs on it at Gopalpur for committing robbery, police conducted a drive in the area at around 3:00am. They (police) chased the robbers and arrested Rabiul along with revolver and two bullets while his cohorts managed to flee.



Khulna Wasa drive for arrear bills thwarted

City dwellers demand smooth water supply first

Khulna Water and Sewerage Authority's (Wasa) recent drive to realise outstanding bills has apparently failed due to sharp reaction from people who are crying for steady supply of water.

Aggrieved people assaulted Commercial Manager of Khulna Wasa Khademul Islam when he went to Tootpara area on April 19 with a 17-member team including policemen to realise outstanding bills from city dwellers.

On April 21, the same team of Wasa returned to

office without any drive in Shaikhpara area in the face of opposition by locals.

"Under the circumstances, it has become quite impossible for us to continue the drive," said Khademul Islam, also head of the 17-member team formed to realise the outstanding bills.

There is apprehension that people will become more violent if police goes into action to help WASA realise outstanding bills before solving serious water crisis prevailing in the city for the last two months, said Ajmol

Ahmed Tapon, panel mayor-1 of Khulna City Corporation (KCC).

People of about eighty percent areas under 31 wards of KCC do not get even one-third of their required water supply and WASA officials are quite aware of people's untold suffering due to the situation, he said.

"We are concerned about security while launching any drive to realise bills from the people who do not get water to meet even 30 per cent of their need?" said a sub-assistant engineer of Wasa requesting anonymity.

Managing Director of Khulna Wasa Md Abdullah told this correspondent on Saturday that there is no alternative to launching drive against those who did not pay bills during last ten years.

Wasa does not have the ability to supply more than one crore gallon of water a day against the need of three crore gallons for 16 lakh people of Khulna city, he said.

Many tube-wells are not functioning as underground water level has gone down, said Jaglul Haider Chowdhury, Deputy Managing Director of KhulnaWasa.

Repair dyke on Monu River Demands human chain in Kulaura

Hundred of people on Monday formed a human chain on a damaged embankment on the Monu River at Dolia-Belertol village in Kulaura upazila demanding its immediate repair.

Addressing a rally at the venue, the speakers said if the embankment is washed away in the upcoming rainy season as many as 24 villages under Prithimpasa, Kormodha, Bhukshimul, Rautgaon, Kadipur, Tilagao and Brahminbazaar unions will be inundated.

They lamented, saying the authorities concerned

have no headache to repair the embankment on emergency basis.

The speakers expressed their indignation at sheer indifference of the authorities concerned to repairing the embankment and also threatened to launch a greater agitation if the embankment is not repaired as early as possible.

Among others, Aftab Ali, convener of the Belertol River Embankment Protection Movement Committee, former chairman of Prithimpasa union Abdul Gafur and Abdul Latif, JSD leader Abdul Gaffar and Khetmojor leader Syed Musarrat Ali addressed.

Bid to rape college girl, madrasa student held

Police yesterday arrested a madrasa student on charge of biting the face of a college girl and attempting to violate her.

The arrestee, Sany Belal, a first year Alim (equivalent to HSC) student of Jongly Fazil Madrasa, and resident of Dastanabad village in Natore Sadar upazila, confessed to his evil act, police said.

Belal waylaid the victim, a first year student of Kafuria Degree College, when she was going to the college along with her two friends at around 9:00am, police and locals said.

He forcibly took her to a shallow machine room in Kafuria Beel, tried to rape her and bit her face when the girl resisted. Hearing her scream, locals rushed to the spot and rescued her.

"Belal, who had been

stalked me for about a year, gave a proposal for love about two months ago, which I rejected. As I told my mother about the incident and later my teachers were informed, Belal threatened me of doing something so that I cannot show my face to anybody. Finally he attacked me," said the girl.

"I demand exemplary punishment to the culprit so that he dare not do the same again," said the girl's mother.

The victim's father Maksedur Rahman filed a case in this connection, said Natore police station officer-in-charge Abdullah Al Mamun.

Teachers and students brought out a procession and formed a human chain at Kafuria Bazar in Natore Sadar upazila yesterday demanding punishment to the culprit.
