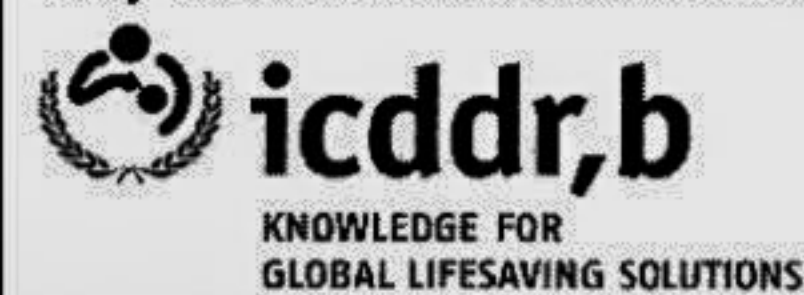

## CALL FOR RESEARCH PROPOSALS

The Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO) of the United Nations and the Food Planning and Monitoring Unit (FPMU) of the Ministry of Food and Disaster Management (MoFDM), Government of Bangladesh, are implementing the NFPCSP with financial support from European Union (EU) and United States Agency for International Development (USAID). The NFPCSP Research Grant Scheme supports food security research in order to inform policy and strengthen evidenced-based decision making. The following research topics have been identified by FPMU-MoFDM in consultation with partners as priority issues to inform food security policy making.

The NFPCSP invites eligible institutions to submit research proposals on the following topics:

9	Improving the targeting effectiveness of social safety nets in Bangladesh
10	Social safety nets and productive outcomes: evidence and implications for Bangladesh

12	Rural-urban migration and its implications for food security in Bangladesh
13	Food Composition Tables for Bangladesh
14	Development of a complementary feeding manual for Bangladesh

Grants will be awarded on a competitive basis following the selection criteria mentioned in the "Guidelines for the Submission, Selection and Implementation of Research Proposals" (reference: NFPCSP/RGS/Guidelines/2009/02) which can be downloaded from the project website or can be obtained by sending an e-mail to [rg@nfpcsp.org](mailto:rg@nfpcsp.org) writing rg in the subject.

Maximum funding for each research proposal varies from US\$ 40,000 to US\$ 50,000 as specified in the ToRs and with a maximum duration of 12 months. Interested non-profit institutions and individuals through institutions of affiliation are encouraged to submit their research proposal(s) in English following the Guidelines.

Applicants are requested to carefully read the Guidelines before preparing the research proposals. Queries may be sent by e-mail to [rgq@nfpcsp.org](mailto:rgq@nfpcsp.org) by Thursday, 2<sup>nd</sup> June 2011. Answers will be posted on the website [www.nfpcsp.org/RGS/FAQ](http://www.nfpcsp.org/RGS/FAQ). Failure to comply with the Guidelines will lead to the rejection of the research proposal. Therefore, applicants are encouraged to validate the proposals against the checklist contained in Annex 3 of the Guidelines before proceeding with submission.
