Rangpur Jubo Dal demands arrest of Padmo's killers

District unit Jubo Dal yesterday brought out a procession in Rangpur town demanding arrest and punishment to the alleged killers of party activist Mosharrif Hossain Padmo.

Jubo Dal also handed over a memorandum to the deputy commissioner (DC) with an ultimatum of 24 hours for arrest of the 'killers'.

The alleged killers are Fuhad, Farhad and Firoj, also three brothers, hailing from Munshipara area in the town, district unit Jubo Dal president Rois Ahmed said. He also blamed police for

their inaction to arrest the 'killers' as they were Jubo League cadres.

He threatened to launch a non-stop agitation if the police fail to arrest the culprits within 24 hours of their ultimatum.

Padmo was killed near Rangpur Keramotia High School intersection on Saturday night while going to his house riding a motor-bike.

Police, however, arrested Ferdousi Begum, mother of the alleged killers, from near Munshipara graveyard. Locals slated police for arrest of Ferdousi instead of the actual killers.

Asked, the OC said

Ferdousi is an accused in the murder case on charge of ordering her sons to kill Padmo.

Contacted, Kotwali police station officer-in-charge (OC) Haider Ali Mollah said, Padmo might have been killed following a previous enmity over cable network business. However, the three killers fled away just after the killing.

Last year, Padmo and his accomplices stabbed Fuhad and Farhad at the same place for the same reason, the OC said.

Last year, two people were killed at Munshipara due to enmity over cable network business.

Criminal held with arms in Chuadanga

Police arrested a criminal and recovered firearms and ammunition from his possession in Chuadanga on Monday night.

The criminal was identified as Robiul Islam, 43 of Bahadurpur in Pangsha upazila of Rajbari.

According to police, a team from Chuadanga Sadar police raided Uzzalpur field where a group of criminals were holding a secret meeting at around 8:30pm.

Police arrested one of the gang named Rabiul while the rest managed to flee. They recovered one LG and two bullets from him.

Officer-In-Charge (OC) of Chuadanga Sadar Police Station said Rabiul is an accused in at least 12 robbery cases.

He was produced in a Chuadanga court that sent him to jail.

Six held in Gafargaon AL leader murder case

Members of the Rapid Action Battalion (Rab) arrested six people in Tongi Industrial area on Monday night for their alleged involvement in the killing of Awami League (AL) leader Mofazzal Hossain Sarwar in Gafargaon upazila on April 23.

Sarwar was the joint convener of Datter Bazar Union AL and also a possible chairman candidate in the upcoming Union Parishad election, police said.

The arrestees are Anwarul Haque, Rafiqul Islam, Nazrul Islam alias Samad, Abul Kashem, Manik and Sirajul Islam. They all are from Gafargaon, Rab sources said.

Of the six, Anwarul Haque, Rafiqul Islam, Nazrul Islam alias Samad are FIR-named accused.

The arrestees were taken to Rab-9 office here yesterday morning. After interrogation, they were handed over to Gafargaon police,

Rab sources said. During interrogation, some of the arrestees said there had been a long-running feud between Mofazzal and them over land dispute and establishing supremacy in the area. Rab sources said.

Officer-in-Charge (OC) of Gafargaon Police Station Md Omar Faruq yesterday told this correspondent that the arrestees would be produced in a Mymensingh court after police interrogation.

Sarwar, 39, was shot dead by a gang in Mandil Bridge area in Gafargaon while returning home from Pagla Bazar at around 10:00pm on April 23.

On April 4, five policemen of Gafargaon Police Station were suspended and closed to Mymensingh police lines for 'negligence' of duty. They are sub-inspectors Ashraf Uddin and Harun-or-Rashied, and assistant sub-inspectors Abul Kasem, Jamal Uddin and Mahmudul Hasan.

Lightning kills 7 in four districts

Seven people were killed by lightning in Nurakona, Lalmonirhat Kurigram and Sherpur yesterday the day before, reports our correspondent.

Lightning killed two people at Chitulia and Chowkidhara-Nawapara under Kendua upazila of Netrakona district yesterday.

The dead were identified as Shahid Mia, 35, of Chitulia village and Rahisuddin, 40, of Chowkidhar-Nawapara village.

Locals said Shahid Mia and Rahisuddin were struck by lightning while working in a paddy field at around 6:00pm. Locals took them to the health complex where the doctors declared them dead.

In Lalmonirhat, lightning killed Yasin Ali Mollah, 52, son of late Abdul Gofur of Shimulbari village in Sadar upazila, Alimuddin Miah, 58, son of late Nantu Miah of Azizpur village

under Patgram upazila and Rahul Miah, 46, son of late Tarek Ali of Dawabari village of Hatibandha upazila on Monday.

A day-labourer was killed by lightning in Nageswari upazila in Gaibandha Monday morning.

The deceased was identified as Younus Ali, 45, son of late Gafur Ali of Moniar Char village under Nageswari municipality.

According to sources, Younus was struck by lightning while working on a cropland at the village.

In Sherpur, a farmer was killed by lightning at West Kumri village in Sadar upazila Monday afternoon.

The deceased was identified as Abdur Rahman, 45, son of Hazi Ashraf Ali of the village.

Locals said the thunderbolt struck Abdur Rahman when he went to harvest paddy in a field adjacent to his house at around 2:00pm.

Auto-rickshaw driver murdered

Unidentified criminals killed a CNG-run auto-rickshaw driver at Gongarjal village in Baralekha upazila of the district early yesterday. The victim was identified as Mujibur Rahman, 30, son of Rakib Ali of the village. According to police, a gang of criminals entered the house of Mujibur by breaking open the door at around 2:00am, slit his throat and left the scene. On information, police went to the village in the morning, recovered the body and sent it to Moulvibazar Hospital morgue for autopsy. The reason behind the murder could not be known as of filing of this report at 6:00pm yesterday.

Robbers loot house

Robbers looted valuables from the house of one Enamul Hoque at Gazirkhepa village under kabirhat upazila of the district early yesterday. Police quoted the members of the house as saying that a gang of robbers stormed into the house at around 1:30am, confined the family members to a room at gun point and looted gold ornaments, Tk 80 thousand, five mobile sets and other valuables. Hearing screams, neighbours surrounded the house, but the robbers managed to flee.

Eight criminals held

Law enforcers arrested eight alleged criminals in the town on Monday night. A joint team of Rab and police raided different parts of the town and arrested the eight. Sources said listed outlaws and criminals have regrouped in south-western districts ahead of the upcoming union parishad elections. One stabbed to death

One person was stabbed to death over previous enmity in Bazitpur upazila of the district on Monday. The dead is Habibur Rahman, 24, of Patali village. Police said Habib came under attack by his rivals at the village at around 10:30am. They stabbed him in different parts of the body and left the scene. Habib died on the instantly. Being informed police rushed to the spot, recovered the body and sent it to Kishoreganj Adhunik Sadar Hospital morgue for autopsy. No arrest was made in connection with the murder as of 5:00pm yesterday.

College girl's body recovered

Police recovered the body of a college girl in Baganbari area under Akhaura upazila on Monday. The deceased was identified as Nahida Sultana Rita, 23, daughter of Akhaura Upazila Parishad Chairman Borhanuddin. Police said they recovered the body from an abandoned house with a scarf tied around her neck. They sent the body to Sadar Hospital morgue.

Clash over tender in Gopalganj, 10 hurt

At least 10 people were injured in a clash between the hired goons of two contractors over submission of tender at Public Works department here Tuesday.

Locals said the government allocated Tk 10 crore for construction of a technical training centre at Ghonapara in Sadar upazila.

A total of 22 contractors bought schedules for the construction work after local public works department floated tender in this regard.

Criminals hired by contractor Tutul took position near the public works department apparently to prevent other contractors from dropping tender schedule on the last day of its submission yesterday.

A clash between two groups took place at noon as Tutul's supporters prevented Faruk Hossain, a supporter of contractor Abdul Salam of Faridpur, from dropping tender.

Ten people, including two journalists, were injured during the clash. The journalists were injured as they went to cover the incident.

Police later brought the situation under control. Both the contractors--Tutul and Salam, however, submitted their tender later.

Meanwhile, local journal-

ists protested the attack on their fellows and demanded arrest of the culprits who were responsible for the incident.
