Acid attack on 3 in Bogra

Criminals on Wednesday midnight threw acid on a two-year-old boy and his parents in Bagbari area under Gabtoli upazila of the district. The victims are Rabbi, 2, his father Abdur Rahman, 40, and mother Kohinur Begum, 27. Rabbi is undergoing treatment at Shaheed Zia Medical College and Hospital in a critical condition while his parents received minor injuries. Gabtoli police said, the incident took place at around 2:00am. Criminals threw acid on Rabbi and his parents 'through a hole of the wall' when they were sleeping in their room, they said. Abdur Rahman said, a cousin of his wife Kohinur borrowed Tk 29 thousand from her. A feud was going on between them for last couple of days over payment of the money, he said.

Transport strike observed

UNB, Khulna

Bus movement on Khulna-Satkhira and Paikgachha routes remained suspended for six hours as transport workers enforced a strike yesterday. Buses from Khulna to Satkhira and in Paikgachha upazila did not ply from 6:00am to noon causing untold sufferings to the passengers. Zakir Hossain Biplob, general secretary of local Motor Sramik Union, said the strike was called to protest the beating of two bus drivers - Murad Hossain and Mujibur Rahman - by the truck workers of Satkhira on Tuesday night. Meanwhile, plying of all buses of Nagar Paribahan on Rupsha-Fulbarigate and Daulatpur-Shahpur routes in the city came to a halt from Wednesday morning as transport workers called another strike demanding increased pay for drivers and helpers. Both the strikes were called off yesterday noon after a 'fruitful talks' with the local administration.

Farmer murdered in Natore

Police recovered the body of a farmer from a pond at Dhanura village in Gurudashpur upazila on Wednesday morning. The deceased was identified as Idris Ali, 43, son of late Rose Ali of Kolapara village in the upazila. Local people found the floating body of Idris Ali at about 9:00am and informed the police. Hands and legs of Idris were tied up with rope. Later, police rushed to the spot and sent the body to hospital morgue for autopsy.

Youth arrested with arms

Detective Branch police arrested a youth with a pipegun and a bullet in the town on Wednesday night. The arrestee was identified as Sumon Mia, 24, son of Md Shariatullah of Durgarampur village in Nabinagar upazila of Brahmanbaria district. Mir Musharraf Hossain, officer-in-charge (OC) of Kishoreganj Sadar PS said, Suman was arrested along with arms at 9:30pm when he was moving suspiciously in front of Hotel Golden Prince. He is now being interrogated by detective branch of police, the OC added.

Indian tea seized

Members of Border Guard Bangladesh (BGB) on Wednesday seized four tonnes of Indian tea worth about Tk 10 lakh from Putkhali border in Benapole. Acting on a tip-off, BGB personnel led by Putkhali camp commander Emdad Hossain raided the border area in the morning and seized the Indian tea. Sensing the presence of BGB men, the smugglers fled the scene. Later, the seized tea was deposited to local customs.

Man held on charge of violating schoolgirl

A man was arrested in Damurhuda upazila on Tuesday night on charge of violating a schoolgirl. Police said Amirul Islam, 34, son of Ansar Ali member of Natun Hauli village in the upazila tactfully took the 13-year-old girl of a poor farmer at Bridgepara to a nearby poultry farm while she was standing near her house in the evening. The culprit then raped the girl, a class VII student of a local high school. The victim's family informed police after the victim told the matter to her family the same night. Police arrested the alleged rapist the same night. The accused admitted his guilt, police said. Munshi Asaduzzaman, Officer-in-Charge (OC) of local PS, said that the girl on Wednesday morning filed a case against Amirul under the Women and Children Repression Prevention Act. Police later took the girl to safe custody for medical test.

Interns at Rajshahi medical start wildcat strike

Interns at Rajshahi Medical College Hospital (RMCH) went on an wildcat strike yesterday afternoon following clash with the attendants of a patient. The interns at different wards stopped working at around 4 pm and announced the strike from a rally held in front of women's hostel. Hasan Mahmud, one of the agitating interns at the rally said they would not return to work until the authorities ensure security of doctors at the hospital. The protesters said an attendant of Rabiul Islam at Ward No. 6, attacked intern Ekramul Haq at around 2:30pm when he was treating the patient. Alleged attacker Madhu also hurt intern Hasan Mahmud when he came to save Ekramul, they said, adding that two other interns were also injured by Madhu. Ekramul said several attendants were gathering around Rabiul and some of them attacked the interns when they asked them to give doctors space for treatment. Contacted, patient Rabiul Islam said an intern in plain dress went to him to treat him when he was feeling pain. "Seeing me in distress my brother Madhu asked the intern if he was really a doctor". At a stage, they started quarrelling over the trifle issue and later locked in a fist fight, he said. RMCH director Brigadier General Ashrafal Alam Siddiki said he was taking steps to resolve the matter.

Jubo League cadres stab Abhoynagar BNP chief

Abhoynagar BNP president Motiar Rahman Farazi was severely stabbed yesterday allegedly by Jubo League cadres of Noapara. A senior member of the opposition party, he was hacked in broad daylight before hundreds of people at a marketplace at noon. Motiar, hailing from Akterpur village under Abhoynagar upazila of Jessore, sustained stab injuries in different parts of his body. Chhatra Dal leader Niyamul Islam Rico was also injured while trying to save him from the attackers. Rico, office secretary of Noapara municipality Chhatra Dal said, Motiar Rahman was sitting at Usha Medical, a pharmacy at

Noapara Bazar at noon.

All of a sudden, a group of Jubo League activists led by Mona, Milon and Azim Sheikh appeared there with sticks and other lethal weapons. They dragged the upazila BNP president out of the shop, beat him up and later hacked him indiscriminately in front of hundreds of people. "They also beat me up as I tried to save him", Rico added. Motiar and Rico were sent to upazila health complex and later shifted to Jessore General Hospital. Dr Abdur Rouf of the hospital said, Motiar received stab injuries in his two hands, left leg and different parts of body. His two arms have been damaged, however, he is now out of danger, he

said.

Kazi Golam Haider, secretary of Abhoynagar upazila BNP said, the attack was carried out as per the instruction of a local Awami League lawmaker to establish supremacy in upcoming union parishad election. Officer-in-charge (OC) of Abhoynagar police station said, some unknown activists were behind the cruel attack. No one filed any complaint in this regard, he added. Assistant police superintendent Reshma Sharmin visited the spot. Upazila BNP brought out a procession immediately after the incident in protest against the attack. District BNP also held a protest rally and brought out procession in the afternoon.

Lightning kills two

Two people were killed by lightning in Panchagarh and Thakurgaon districts on Wednesday. In Panchagarh, lightning killed a woman at Amlahar village under Sadar upazila in the afternoon. Family and local people said Panchami Rani, 35, was struck by lightning on the premises of their house in the afternoon and died instantly. In Thakurgaon, a man was killed and his wife and son were injured by lightning at Kalanda village under Baliadangi upazila in the morning. The dead is Khairul Islam, 40. Locals said Khairul and his wife and son were struck by lightning while working on a field near their house at around 10:30am.

RIVAL PARTIES CALL MEETINGS Sec 144 on several Khulna city points

Khulna Metropolitan Police (KMP) yesterday imposed Section 144 on 13 places of the city from Thursday midnight as two Islamist groups and several ruling party groups called rallies today. The 48-hour ban on gatherings will continue till Saturday midnight, said a KMP press release signed by its commissioner Shafiqur Rahman. The KMP imposed Section 144 on Babri Chatter as Islami Ain Bastobayon Committee and Bangladesh Muslim Ummah Oikya Parishad called for rallies there after the Juma prayers today. The 12 other points that fall under Section 144 include Baitunnur Mosque area, Moilapota Crossing, Shaheed Hadish Park, Rupsha Ferry Ghat and Royal Chatter in the city. Bangladesh Muktiyodhha Sangsad, city unit of Awami Jubo League, Jatiya Sramik League and Krishak League, Awami League of Sadar unit and Swadhinata Chikitshak Parishad have also called for rallies at those points. KMP imposed the ban on those points for the sake of public security, the press release said.

Leaders call off strike at Barapukuria

People of Phulbari upazila yesterday afternoon withdrew their indefinite strike following a meeting between local leaders of National Oil, Gas, Mineral Resources, Power and Port Protection Committee and Dinajpur district administration. The meeting was held at the local rest house of Roads and Highway Department (RHD). However, officials of Barapukuria Coal Mine Company Ltd (BCMCL) did

not attend the meeting.

At the two and half hours long meeting, the district administration partially accepted the demands and assured the meeting that the demands of agitating people will be met as early as possible, sources said. After the meeting, ADM Azizul Islam and Mostafizur Rahman, acting SP, spoke to the people waiting outside the meeting venue. After that Saiful Islam Jewel, convener of National Oil, Gas, Mineral Resources and Port and Power Protection Committee, called off their indefinite strike.
