

# Victim of teacher's cruelty still reels from trauma

Class VIII student Rizia Sultana Sathi, who remained unconscious for 22 hours due to beating by her teacher Kamalesh Roy of Noornagar PWD High School in Khulna city on Wednesday, is still reeling from the trauma at Khulna Medical College Hospital (KMCH).

Sathi's father Kazi Rezaul Karim, who works as a peon in Khulna divisional commissioner's office, has appealed to the solvent people of the society to help him bear expenses for medical treatment of his daughter.

## Follow-up

As this correspondent met Sathi at Surgery Ward No-3 of KMCH yesterday, the visibly shaken girl said, "Mathematics teacher Kamalesh Roy often misbehaves in the classroom, particularly with female students."

"The same teacher Kamalesh Roy mercilessly beat my son Rakib Hasan two months ago for being late in his class only by ten minutes. Rakib had to undergo medical treatment for over a month to recover from serious injuries in his

right hand due to the beating," said a woman requesting anonymity. She went to KMCH yesterday to see Sathi. "Kamalesh Sir is a cruel man. He also uses obnoxious to students, no matter male or female," said Tumpa, a classmate of Sathi. Sathi's father Kazi Rezaul Karim, who filed a case against Kamalesh Roy and Liakat Hossain, headmaster of PWD High School, expressed doubt about any progress in the investigation

as the two accused are yet to be arrested.

Asked about the matter, IO of the case, SI Alamgir Kabir said he had raided houses of the accused several times but failed to track them down.

Leaders of Khulna district and city units of Bangladesh Teachers' Association in a press statement yesterday strongly condemned inhuman corporal punishment to Rizia Sultana Sathi.

Woman and Child Rights Watch Team, a wing of NGO Griha Shukhan, has demanded exemplary punishment of the two accused teachers.

## 10 injured in clash over disputed land in Satkhira

At least 10 people, including three women, were injured in a clash between two rival groups over harvesting paddy from a disputed land at Sujanshaha village in Tala upazila on Friday.

Police quoting locals said there was a long-standing dispute between Monsur Sardar and Dalil Uddin of the village over the ownership of the land.

Locals said at around 9:00 am Monsur's daughter along with aides went to the disputed land to cut boro paddy cultivated by Dalil.

Being resisted by Dalil and his family members, Monsur's men equipped with lethal weapons attacked them leaving 10 people seriously injured.

The injured were admitted to Sadar hospital.

## Robbers loot gold, cash from 2 Bogra houses

Robbers looted gold ornaments, cash and other valuables from two houses in Adamdighi upazila headquarters early Friday.

Police quoting locals said, breaking open the collapsible gate, a gang of armed robbers numbering 6/7 entered the house of Ariful Islam at around 2:30 am and took the members of the house hostage at gunpoint.

The robbers looted gold ornaments, cash Tk 10,000, mobile phone set and other valuables worth about Tk 50,000 from the house.

Later, the gang entered the adjacent house of Anwar Hossain and looted seven tolas of gold ornaments, cash and other valuables worth Tk 3 lakh keeping the house members hostage at gunpoint.

## BL College Shibir leaders injured in BCL attack

Three Islami Chhatra Shibir leaders were seriously injured in an attack by Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) injured at BL College in Doulatpur in the city yesterday noon.

The injured are fourth year student of Islamic History Md. Riazul Islam, his classmate Abu Bakar Mamun and Abu Bakar Siddique were admitted to Islamic Bank Hospital.

Siddique and third year student of the same department Farukh Hasan Mamun.

Police quoting general students said armed BCL men swooped on four Shibir leaders when they went to the campus on academic purpose.

The BCL men caught Riazul, Abu Bakar and Mamun and mercilessly

beat them, leaving them critically injured when the other Shibir leaders ran for safety and quickly left campus at noon.

Being informed, police rescued the Shibir leaders. They detained Mamun and took him to Daulatpur police station while Riazul Islam and Abu Bakar Siddique were admitted to Islamic Bank Hospital.

## BCL stops classes at IU

Chhatra League (BCL) activists yesterday forced the Islamic University (IU) authorities to stop classes and examinations protesting a bomb attack on its leader.

BCL general secretary of the university unit Shamsuzzaman Tuhin and three others were wounded as unknown people threw two bombs on him on Friday night at a market adjacent to the university.

The protesters in the morning also brought out a procession on the campus.

The BCL men warned that they will not allow any class or examination at the university until the attackers are arrested.

As a result, no class or examination was held yesterday.

Mahbubul Arefin, proctor of the university, told this correspondent that the situation is calm and additional police forces have been deployed on the campus.

Injured BCL leader Tuhin was shifted to Dhaka Medical College and Hospital for better treatment.

According to police and witnesses, Tuhin came under bomb attack in front of Haji Market of Sheikhpura Bazar near the campus.

The incident took place at about 8:30pm when Tuhin was standing there after ending a campaign for his father Sekandar Mollah who will run in the upcoming Tribeni Union Parishad election.

## Mystery shrouds death of housewife

### Suicide or murder?

Mystery has shrouded the death of Kamona Rani Saha, 23, wife of Bhromor Chandra Saha at Panjankhara village in Sadar upazila of the district.

Kamona's family members said she was killed in a planned was by her husband and in-laws yesterday.

On the other side, family members of Bhromor said Kamona hanged herself from the ceiling of her house.

However, police found some marks of injuries on her body.

Reba Saha, mother-in-law of the victim, said Kamona hanged herself with the help of asari around 8:00am.

Hearing her screams, locals rushed to the spot and took her to nearby Sahera Hasan Memorial Hospital where the on-duty doctor declared her dead.

Family sources said Kamona, daughter of Kalicharan Saha of Dhusar-Kalibari village under Shibaliya upazila was married to Bhromor Chandra

Saha, son of Gobondra Chandra Saha of Panjankhara village in Sadar upazila, seven years ago when she was only 16 years old.

Victim's brother Laxman Saha said, family members of Bhromor including Reba Saha and Chanchal Saha started torturing Kamona after two years of her marriage over trifles issues.

"They killed my sister and later hung her body from the ceiling of the house", he alleged. Laxman said, her sister

called him over cellphone yesterday morning and on Friday night and requested him to take her to her father's house.

Bhromor Saha and Chanchal, however, denied the allegation brought against them and the members of their family.

Contacted, sub inspector Kamal Hossain, also investigation officer in the case said, Kamona's body bore two marks of injuries. The body has been sent to Manikganj Sadar Hospital morgue for autopsy, the IO said.

## 30 shanties, 8 houses gutted in 2 districts

At least 30 shanties and eight houses were gutted in two incidents of fire in Khulna and Kishoreganj yesterday.

A devastating fire gutted at least 30 shanties at Jabusha Uttarpara village under Rupsha upazila of Khulna district, reports our staff correspondent.

Sources said, the fire originated from electric short circuit at 11:00 am at a slum behind New Sea Foods, a shrimp processing factory.

Ten people were admitted to Rupsha upazila health complex and KMCH after they sustained severe burn injuries while trying to save their personal belongings and households from fire.

Fire brigade personnel from Khulna city and Rupsha units brought the fire under control at about 12:15pm.

The extent of loss caused by the fire was estimated at Tk25 lakh.

In Kishoreganj, eight houses were gutted at Beerakatiari village in Hossainpur early yesterday.

Locals said, the fire originated from one Mosharraf Hossain's cowshed and soon engulfed the adjacent seven houses.

On information, the fire brigade personnel from the

town rushed to the spot and extinguished the flame after two hours of hectic efforts.

The owners of the houses put the loss at Tk50 lakh while fire service men estimated it around Tk25 lakh.

In Rajbari, fire gutted five rooms of a house at Doulatdia brothel Friday afternoon.

Fire service sources said, the fire originated from an electric short circuit at the house and soon charred five rooms at around 5:00pm.
