students and 3,746 female students secured GPA-5 under the Madrasa board.

The pass rate of male and female students under the board this year is 85.53 percent and 80.68 percent respectively which was 89.02 percent and 84.09 percent last year.

Contacted, Education Minister Nurul Islam Nahid said creative question system, introduced this year, might be a reason behind the fall in the pass rate of Madrasa board.

The trend of the results under Madrasa board shows

that it had done better than any other boards in the past four years but this year the pass rate of Madrasa education board is lower than the pass rate of Dhaka, Comilla and Jessore education boards.

SSCVocational the pass rate of the SSC vocational exams under the Technical Education Board is 81.37 percent that sees a slight fall from last year's 82.72 percent.

However, the number of GPA-5 achievers in the board leaped to a significant 1205 students from only 72 of the

previous year. Out of them, 850 are male while 355 are female students.

The pass percentage among the female students under the Technical Education Board is 81.18 while it is 81.86 among the male students.

The board has been scoring better SSC results since 2008. The pass rate stood at 70.9 in 2009, higher than 62.88 percent in 2008.

Some 67,521 students passed the SSC vocational exams out of a total of 82,981 candidates that sat the test.

in Chittagong, 18 in Barisal, 42 in Sylhet and 48 in Dinajpur.

Under Madrasa Board, the number of institutions securing 100 percent success came down to 1,150 from 2,308 last year.

This year a total of 117 institutions achieved 100 percent pass under the Technical Education Board.

Education ministry officials said the reason behind the fall in number of institutions having 100 percent success rate is because a number of institutions under Madrasa Board did not do well in the examina-

tions as madrasa teachers could not get training on creative question method, which was introduced in two subjects this year.

The number of schools having 100 percent success rate in eight general education boards increased to 750 this year from 561 last year.

This year the number of institutions having 100 percent pass has increased in Dhaka, Comilla, Jessore, Chittagong, Dinajpur and Technical Education boards while the number has decreased in four boards--Rajshahi, Barisal, Sylhet and Madrasa.

In Rajshahi board, the number of institutions with

cent percent pass rate has declined from 141 to 76 while from 32 to 18 in Barisal, 43 to 42 in Sylhet and 2,308 to 1150 in Madrasa.

Eight general education boards except Barisal have no institution with zero pass rate.

One institution under Barisal board has failed to have any successful student while 22 institutions under Madrasa board and five institutions under Technical Education Board could not secure a single success.

However, Comilla board has seen no educational institutions going without a success for the fourth consecutive year this year.

Singh, Uttar Pradesh party unit chief Rita Bahuguna Joshi and film actor-turned-politician Raj Babbar, said Sheetal Verma, Gautam Budh Nagar's acting district magistrate.

Gandhi was arrested for violating section 144 of CrPC (Criminal Procedure Code), headed.

At Kasna Police Station in Uttar Pradesh, about 80km from Delhi, Rahul had a heated exchange of words with police officers when he demanded documents for his arrest. The police officers told him that he was held under a law that required no document.

Gandhi, the elected lawmaker from Amethi in Uttar Pradesh, refused to sign a

bail bond. The police later freed him around 2:00am yesterday and he was driven back to New Delhi.

Uttar Pradesh Cabinet Secretary Shashank Shekhar Singh told reporters in state capital Lucknow that Bhatta Parasaul, the main site of farmers' agitation since Saturday last, was calm and attempts were being made to vitiating the atmosphere there.

Congress attacked Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister Mayawati for Gandhi's arrest. Congress General Secretary Janardan Dwivedi alleged the state has witnessed "the cruelest rule of several imperialistic regimes".

"UP government's action in arresting Rahul Gandhi proves that Mayawati is

digging her own grave," he said.

On Wednesday, Gandhi slipped into Batta Parsaul village in the early hours riding pillion on a motorcycle with a helmet on. He sat with the agitating farmers throughout the day in scorching heat.

"I feel ashamed to call myself Indian after seeing what has happened here. The (state) government here has unleashed atrocities on its own people," Gandhi told the farmers.

Gandhi said he associated with the farmers who were demanding their "right" and there was "nothing wrong" in it.

"I want to tell you that I am with you till your demands are met. Till your

work is not done, the Congress party will not desert you," he said to a thunderous applause from the gathering which chanted slogans hailing him.

Last Saturday, police and farmers fought a pitched battle at the village leaving four dead including two policemen.

The farmers are protesting against land acquisition and demanding higher compensation for the land acquired for the 156-km Yamuna Expressway linking New Delhi with Agra.

Dodging heavy police presence, the Congress scion sneaked into the village where politicians and outsiders were not allowed. He spent nearly 18 hours with the villagers before his arrest.

Quoting the ASF records Monira said incidents of acid violence in the country has reduced significantly within the last eight years, i.e. from 367 in 2002 to 115 in 2010.

Though the government has formulated laws to punish the offenders and to control acid selling, implementation of those laws is still very poor.

The legal process is often lengthy which allows the offenders to slip between the fingers, she said.

The judiciary will lose people's confidence if it fails to address the backlog of cases related to acid violence, said Prof Mizanur Rahman, chairman of National Human Rights Commission.

Expressing his willingness to work as a partner with the ASF, he said violence against women gets top priority in the action plan of the HRC in 2011-2012.

"We will be able to eradicate acid violence from the country and can raise awareness in the society if the judicial system works smoothly," said Shaheen Anam, executive director of Manusher Jonno Foundation.

ASF pledged to continue their efforts in eliminating acid violence from the country by 2015.

Chairman of ASF Dr Iftekharuzzaman and Canadian High Commissioner Robert McDougall also spoke among others.

Mementos were awarded to the representatives of different donor organisations whose continuous support helps ASF to work for humanity.
