36 UP poll candidates fined for flouting code

Aspirant holds public meeting

A mobile court fined 36 candidates in the upcoming elections to the union parishads in Patgram upazila of Lalmonirhat district on Tuesday night for violating election code of conduct and realised Tk 1.12 lakh from them.

Of them, eight are in the election race for chairman posts, 19 for member posts and the rest for women's reserved seats of Bawra and Jongra union parishads.

The mobile court led by Patgram Upazila Nirbahi Officer (UNO) Harunur Rashid, also the executive magistrate, punished the candidates for pasting posters on walls and hanging colour banners in public places, violating the election rules.

Police said the chairman candidates were fined Tk 5,000 each, member candidates Tk 2,000 to 3,000 each and the candidates for women reserved seats Tk 3,000 each.

Our Narail correspondent reported that a chairman aspirant for Noagram Union Parishad under Lohagara upazila held a public meeting at LSJN High School ground

at Satrohajari village on Tuesday afternoon, violating the election code of conduct.

The candidate, Foizul Haque Rome, arranged the rally which was attended by his supporters from Brahmandanga, Kolagachi and Raigram villages.

His supporters then visited different areas of the union on board the vehicles, locally called nasimon, and sought vote for him

Foizul's rival candidates Syed Foizul Amir Litu, also the organising secretary of Lohagara upazilka AL, Munshi Akayet Hossain, Syed Ayub Ali, Saeed Ali and Abdul Alim alleged that Foizul violated the election rules by holding a public rally and bringing out a colourful procession in the union.

A written complaint was submitted to Lohagara Upazila Nirbahi Officer (UNO), Arun Kumar Mondol, also the returning officer, against Syed Foizul Haque Rome for violating election code of conduct.

Contacted, the UNO said he has already started investigation into the allegation against chairman candidate Foizul Haque Rome.

Candidate attacked

A union parishad (UP) chairman candidate was hacked by the supporters of his rival candidate in Madaripur Sadar upazila on Tuesday night.

The ruling party backed candidate, Ezajur Rahman Akand, is vying for the post of chairman of Kalikapur Union Parishad. He is now undergoing treatment at Faridpur Medical College and Hospital (FMCH).

Police quoted locals as saying that the supporters of chairman candidate Abu Taleb Bepari locked in an altercation with Akand while he was campaigning at Dudthkhali village at around 10:00pm.

At one stage, Taleb's men hacked Akand with sharp weapons, leaving him seriously injured. He was admitted to Madaripur Sadar Hospital and then shifted to Faridpur Medical College and Hospital.

2 housewives murdered

Two housewives were murdered early yesterday allegedly by their husbands in Gaibandha and Laxmipur districts.

A woman was killed allegedly by her husband for dowry at Char Ramdaskura village in Sundarganj upazila of Gaibandha early yesterday.

The victim was identified as Shefali Begum, wife of Saju Miah of the village, reports UNB.

Police said Saju married Shefali of the village seven months ago. Her parents promised to give Saju Tk 80,000 as dowry. Failing to get the money from her parents after the marriage, Saju started to torture Shefali.

On the fateful night, he picked up a quarrel with Shefali over the issue and at one stage killed her with the help of his family members.

Locals informed the police early in the morning who recovered the body and sent it to hospital morgue for autopsy. Police also arrested Saju.

In Laxmipur, a housewife was killed allegedly by her husband at Devnagar village in Ramganj upazila early yesterday.

The deceased was identified as Minu Akhtar, 35, wife of Jahangir Alam of the village.

Locals said Jahangir returned home from abroad recently and married another woman as Minu was suffering from a paralytic illness since she gave birth to her third child.

They said Jahangir picked up a quarrel with Minu over a trifling matter late at night and at one stage tortured her to death.

Later, Jahangir hanged the body from the ceiling of his house to prove that she had committed suicide.

Woman strangled after rape, 2 teenage girls violated

A young woman was strangled after rape in Bogra on Tuesday while two teenage girls were violated in Thakurgaon and Nilphamari districts on Monday and the day before.

In Bogra, locals yesterday found the body of an unidentified young woman in a field at Kaichar village, about 7km off the town.

On information, police recovered the body from the open field. The woman, aged about 20, was wearing kameez while her dopatta was tied around the neck, reports UNB.

Police suspected that a gang brought the woman from far away, raped her at a shallow power pump hut and strangled her Tuesday night.

Bodies of two other young women were recovered from the same field of Kaichar village during the last one year. Police could neither arrest the killers nor identify the victims.

In Thakurgaon, a girl, aged about 14, was raped allegedly by a young man at Baharampur-Paschimpara in Haripur upazila on Monday.

She is the daughter of day-labourer Nazrul Islam of the Baharampur.

Locals said, alleged rapist Aminul Haque, 30, son of Amzad Ali of the same village,

forcibly took the girl to a stack of straw and raped her while returning home from work in the evening.

Hearing screams, people from the neighborhood rushed to the spot and rescued the victim. The rapist however managed to flee the scene.

Victim's mother Maleka Begum filed a case with Haripur PS under the Women and Children Repression Prevention Act.

In Nilphamari, a teenage girl was raped by a young man at a village on Tuesday afternoon, reports our correspondent.

The victim was daughter of Shahidur Rahman of Batultali village under Sadar upazila and a student of class five at Jadur Hat Dakhil Madrasa.

Locals and police sources said, the incident took place when the victim was staying alone at the house as her parents went to Nilphamari 100 bed hospital to visit her ailing elder sister there.

They said alleged rapist Motaharul Islam, a father of two, entered the victim's house, forcibly took the girl to nearby jute field and raped her.

Hearing her screams, Swapan Mia, the brother-in-law of the victim along with two local women, rushed to the jute field and found the girl in unconscious state. The rapist however fled the scene.

Two abducted girls rescued in Satkhira, Khulna

Police rescued two abducted young girls, one from the district and the other from Khulna on Monday.

A 17-year-old girl, abducted by criminals while going to college in Assassuni upazila of the district on May 5, was rescued by police from a house at Bagularchak village in Paikgachha upazila in Khulna on Monday.

Police also arrested alleged abductor Manirul Islam Karikar, 20, son of Abdul Hakim Karikar of Basudevpur village in Assassuni upazila.

The victim is daughter of Abdur Rahim Gazi of Basudevpur village and a first year student at Acharya Prafulla Chandra College in Paikgachha upazila.

Quoting relatives of the victim

police said, the girl was abducted by a gang led by Manirul Islam while going to college from Garali sluice gate area in Paikgachha upazila at about 10:30 am on May 5.

They took her to Bagularchak village and confined her to the house of Mosharrar Hossain at Bagularchak village.

Victim's father Abdur Rahim Gazi filed a case with Assassuni PS on May 6. Acting on a tip-off, a police team led by sub-inspector (SI) Asgar Ali raided the house at Bagularchak village on Monday night, arrested Manirul and rescued the girl.

In another drive, police rescued another girl, abducted from Goaltali village in Chowgachha upazila in Jessore, from a house at Keragachhi

village in Kalaroa upazila on Monday.

They also arrested three people, Khorsheed Ali, 35, son of Abdullah, Billal Hossain, 28, son of Syed Ali and Laltu, 26, son of Lutfar Rahman of Keragachhi village in Kalaroa upazila on charge of abduction.

The victim is a 12-year-old daughter of Abdul Alim of Goaltali village. She was abducted by criminals while going to Goaltali Dakhil Madrasa on May 19.

The criminals later brought her to Karagachhi, a bordering village in Kalaroa upazila, and demanded Tk 2 lakh ransom from the victim's parents.

But the victim's parents informed the matter to police who raided the village, rescued the girl and arrested the alleged abductors.

Tiger kills 1 in Sundarbans

A fisherman was killed by a tiger in the Sundarbans yesterday morning.

Victim Hemayet Sheikh, 32, was a resident of Dhangmury village in Dakope upazila of neighbouring Khulna district.

Hemayet was attacked by the tiger while he and his brother were catching fish at a canal in Ghaghramari camp of Dhangmury station at around 10:00am, Mihir Kumar De, divisional forest officer of the eastern range of Sundarbans said.

12 shops gutted in Bhola

A devastating fire gutted 12 shops at Muripatti in Chakbazar area of the town early yesterday causing a loss of about Tk 25 lakh.

Police said the fire broke out from an electric short circuit at a shop and soon spread to other shops. The damaged business enterprises include puff rice shops, hotels and other establishments.

The fire service men rushed to the scene and doused the flame.

Death of two kids in road mishaps sparks protest

Death of two children in road accidents in Thakurgaon and Panchagarh triggered violent protest Tuesday afternoon.

Agitated locals set fire to a tractor in Thakurgaon and blocked Panchagarh-Thakurgaon highway for

two hours protesting the accidents.

A six-year-old boy was killed in a road accident at Fakhdanpur village under Sadar upazila of Thakurgaon on Tuesday at about 3:00pm.

The victim was identified as Jibon Roy, son of Dinesh Roy of the village. Officer-in-charge of Thakurgaon police station Gopal

Chakraborty said the boy was standing in front of his house alongside the village road. Suddenly a tractor came from behind and crushed the boy under its wheels.

Agitated locals held the vehicle and set fire to it. They also caught its driver Azaharul Islam and gave him a good beating before handing over to police.

In Panchagarh, another boy was killed in a road accident at Vimpukur village under Boda upazila Tuesday afternoon.

Victim Arif, 10, son of Khademul Islam of the same village was crushed under the wheels of a Dhaka-bound speeding bus coming from Panchagarh while he was crossing the road at about 4:00pm.

After the accident, agitated locals barricaded Panchagarh-Thakurgaon highway for two hours protesting the incident and demanding arrest of the driver.
